

# Present Simple



- *Daily routine or habit* (регулярные, повседневные действия; привычки)

Sarah **starts** school at 8 o'clock.

He **likes** coffee in the morning.

- *Permanent state* (постоянные состояния)

He **lives** near the hospital.

## Употребление Present Simple

Present Simple употребляется, если действие в предложении происходит **регулярно, всегда, иногда, часто, обычно.**

Слова-спутники Present Simple: **usually, often, every day (week, year), regularly, always, sometimes.**



I **go** to school **every day**.

It **often** **snows** in winter.

**Usually** he **watches** TV in the evening.

We **always** **do** our homework.

# Simple Present Tense

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I work	Do I work?	I don't work
You work	Do you work?	You don't work
He works	Does he work?	He doesn't work
She works	Does she work?	She doesn't work
It Works	Does it Work?	It doesn't work
We work	Do we work?	We don't work
You work	Do you work?	You don't work
They work	Do they work?	They don't work

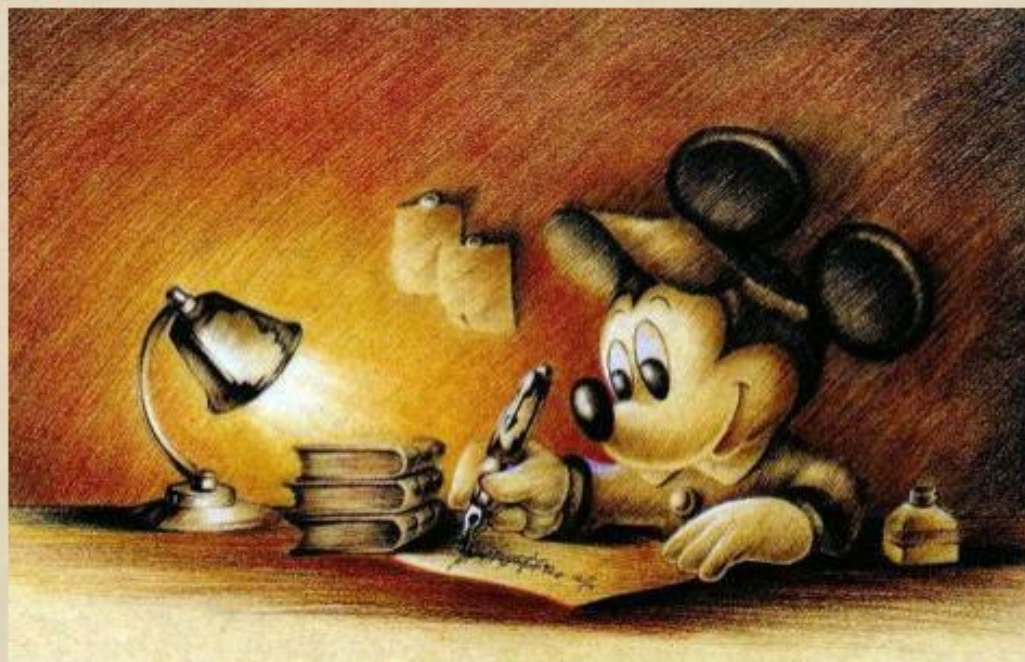

## My day

*In the morning (ymptom)*

*Usually* I get up **at seven o'clock.**

*Every day* I do morning exercises and make my bed. *Then* I go to the bathroom and wash my face and hands. I comb hair. *Sometimes* I have a shower. *After that* I get dressed and have breakfast in the kitchen. I *always* eat sandwiches and drink tea. After breakfast I brush teeth, take my bag and I go to school.

**When do** you usually get up?- Usually I get up at 7 o'clock.  
(at 7.30 at seven thirty)

**What time do** you usually go to school?- I go to school at 8 o'clock.

(at 8.15 at eight fifteen)

**Where do** you do morning exercises?- I do morning exercises in my bedroom.

**Where do** you have breakfast?- I always have breakfast in the kitchen.

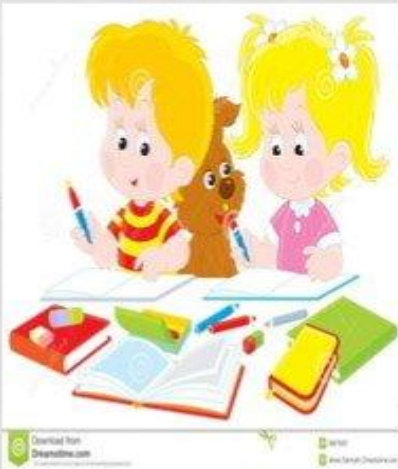

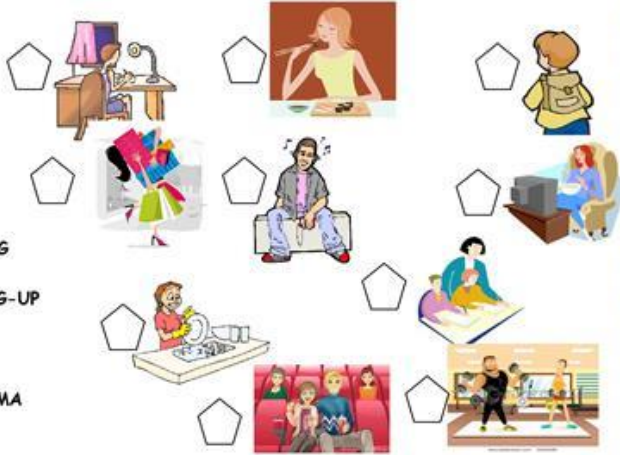

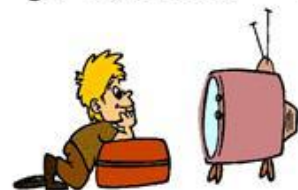
