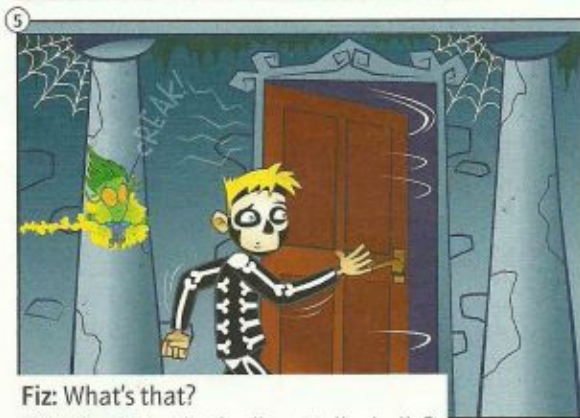
Fiz: Why are you wearing strange clothes?

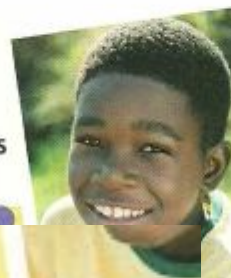

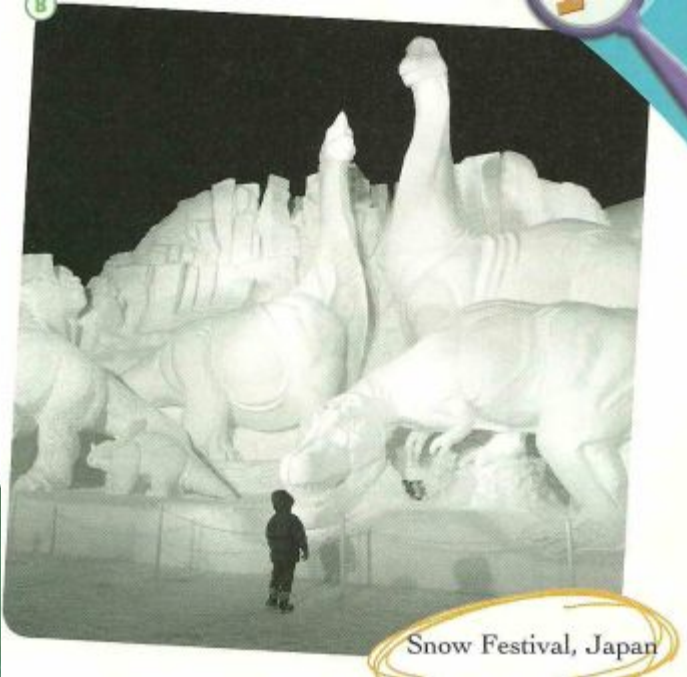
