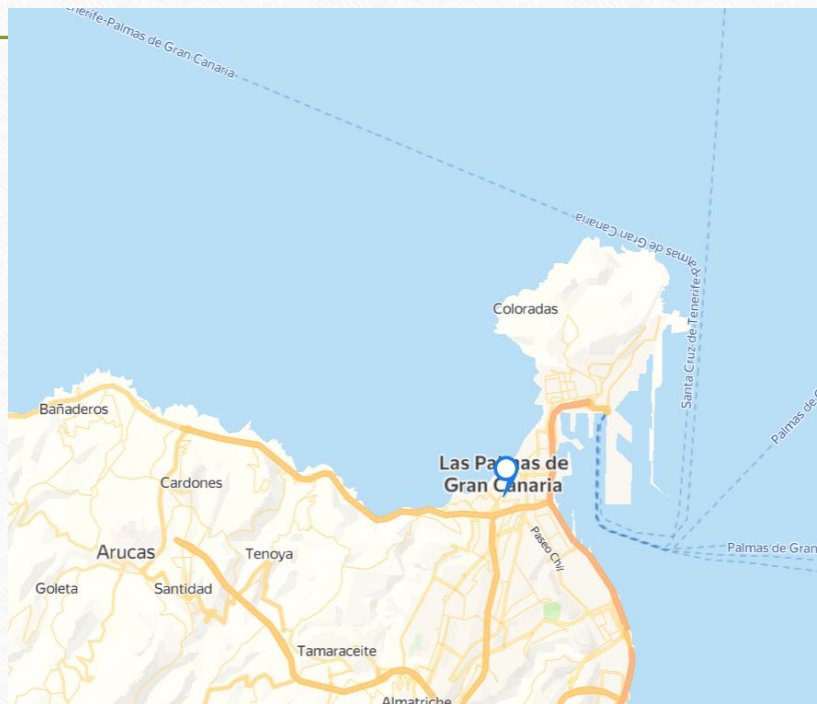


Port of Las Palmas

Port of LAS PALMAS is located at West Africa, West Africa in Spain at coordinates N 28° 08' 27.59" - W 015° 24' 58.85".
The port in Las Palmas was built for more than 20 years (from 1883 to 1903), using the most modern technologies of its time.
Later, it was repeatedly rebuilt and improved.



The length of the berth is more than 11 km with depths up to 16 m. The total turnover of sea cargo transportation of the port of Las Palmas is 6.4 million tons. Oil is mainly imported. It is possible to repair ships and ships of small displacement. Las Palmas, as an important transit port, is visited annually by 15-17 thousand vessels, including Russian fishing vessels, for replenishment and repair.



The port consists of Portal cranes , gantry loaders , etc.
