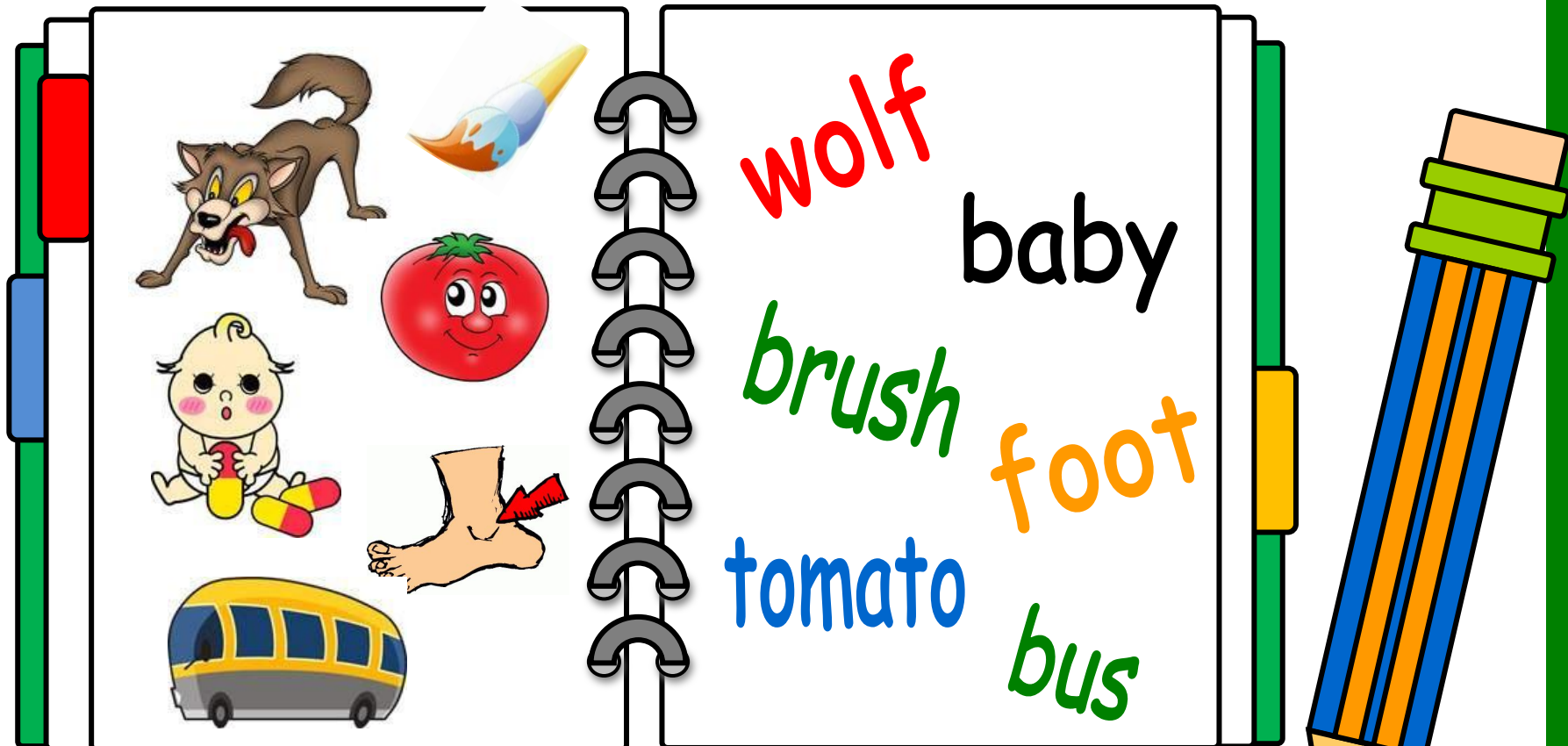

Plural of Nouns

Rules

To make the **plural** we usually add **-s** to the noun.

book □ **books** pen □ **pens**

With nouns ending in **-s**, **-sh**, **-ch**, **-x** or **-o**, we add the suffix **-es**.

class □ **classes**
box □ **boxes**
arch □ **arches**
tomato □ **tomatoes**

With nouns ending in a consonant and **-y**, the **-y** goes and we add **-ies**.

country □ **countries**
baby □ **babies**

With nouns ending in **-f** or **-fe**, the **-f** or **-fe** goes and we add **-ves**.

knife □ **knives**
leaf □ **leaves**



Plural of Nouns

Rules

Irregular nouns do not follow the rules above. We make their plurals in various ways.

- child □ **children**
- foot □ **feet**
- mouse □ **mice**
- fish □ **fish**
- person □ **people**
- sheep □ **sheep**
