








Grandpa, Ben, and Rosie are at the beach.

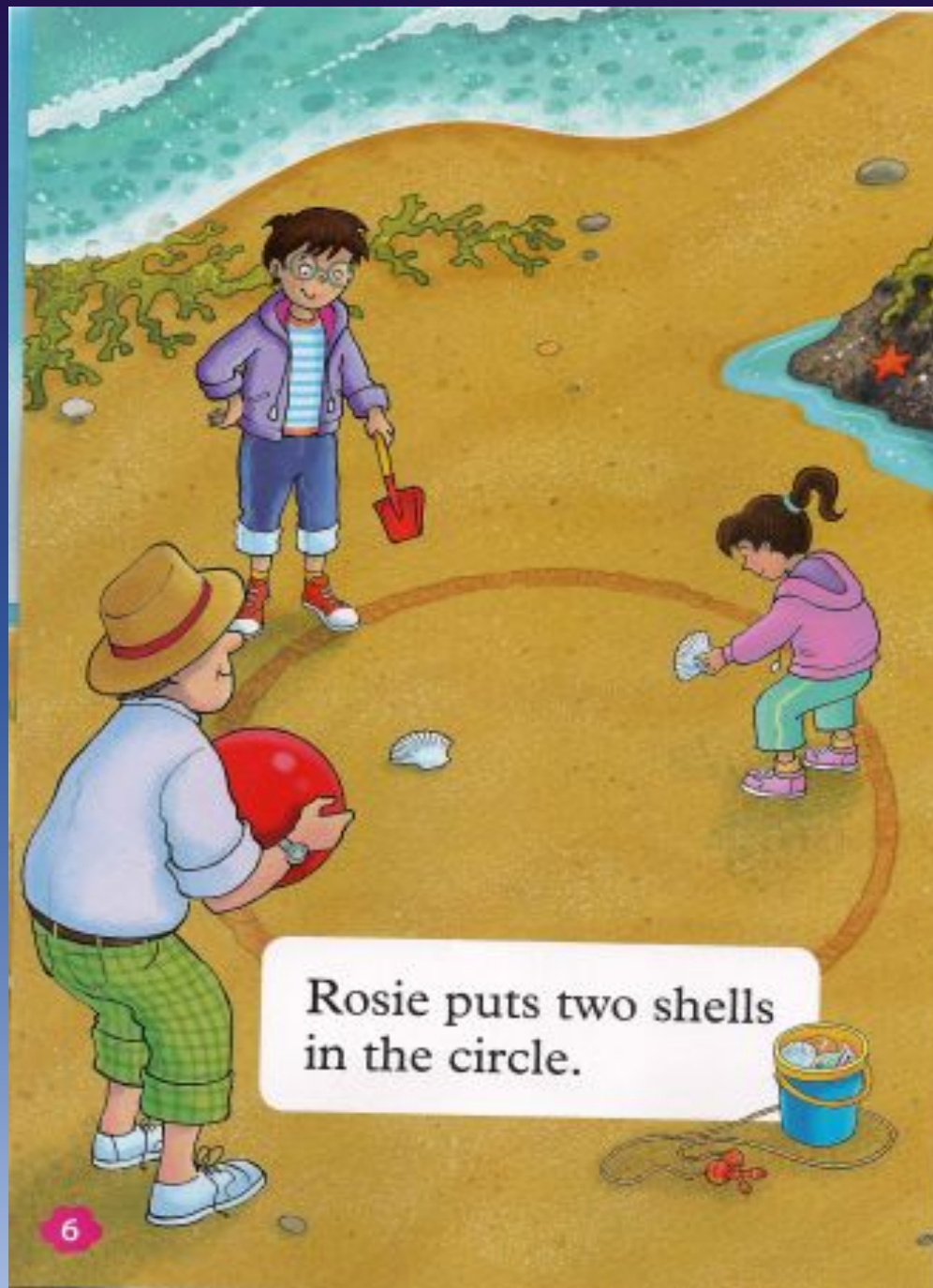




Look, Grandpa, says Ben.

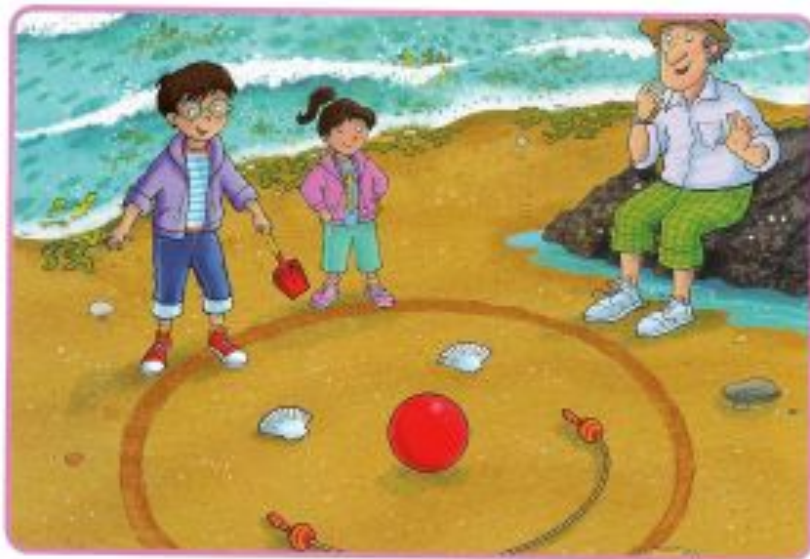
