# Tsarskoye Selo Fraternal cemetery of Heroes of the first world war.



For the burial of the war dead in 1914, at Tsarskoe Selo near St. Petersburg was organized by the Fraternal cemetery. During the war, about 17,500 fighters were buried here. It was a majestic all-Russian monument-Pantheon. But in Soviet times the memorial was destroyed. As the memory of the heroes.



# The revival of the memory.

**Miraculously surviving the tomb of Georgian cavalier of Sergei Schlichter is all that remains of the Fraternal cemetery of heroes of the First World War.**



**In 2008, a seven-meter granite stele was installed on the site of the cemetery in the present city of Pushkin. It will remind descendants of the perfect feat of compatriots.**

# Monuments to the 100th beginning of the first world war. Moscow.



**In modern Russia continue to revive the memory of the soldiers of the war 1914-1918. In 2014, on Poklonnaya Gora in Moscow Monument to The heroes of world war I.**

**The first part of the composition is a Russian soldier who went through the war and became a Georgian cavalier . Behind the soldier is the second part of the monument – the officer who raises the attack of the soldiers on the background of the national flag.**



**The monument on Frunzenskaya embankment is dedicated to three main battles of the Russian army in the First World War, such as Brusilov breakthrough.**

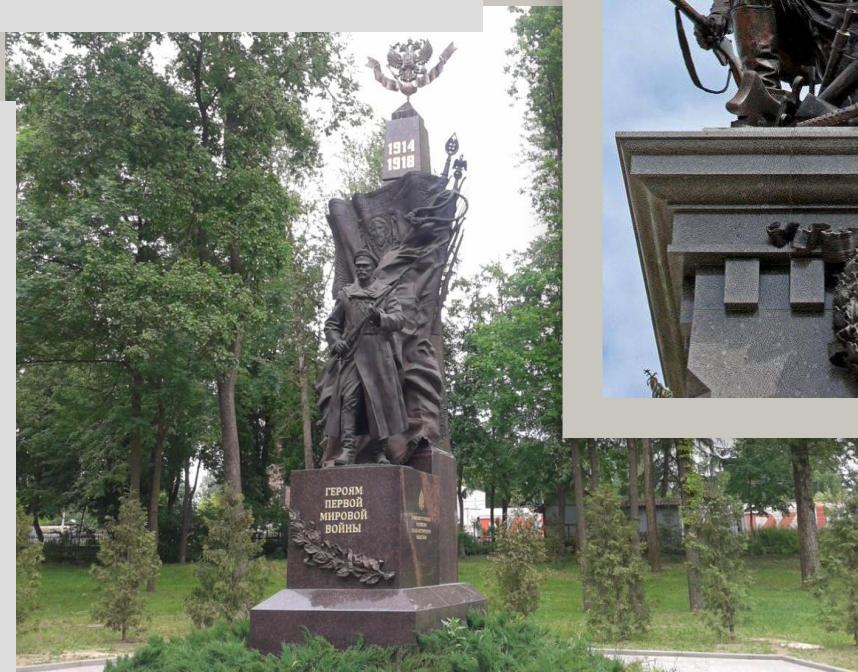


# Monuments to the 100th beginning of the first world war. Kaliningrad. Pskov

**Kaliningrad. According to unofficial data, in the Kaliningrad region there are almost a thousand graves of Soldiers of the first world war. On the Western borders of fierce fighting. According to the plan of the sculptor, three five-meter figures of the military of different classes represent a single contribution of the people in defense of Russian interests.**



**Pskov. The monument was erected at the place where the 24th infantry division was stationed during the First World War. The monument is a figure of a Russian soldier, going on the attack with a rifle. The figure flying the banner of the Pskov infantry regiment.**

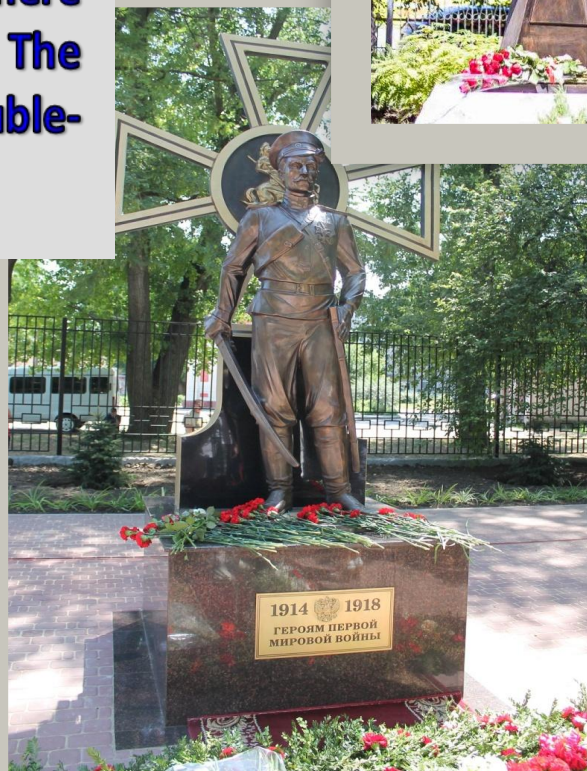


# Monuments to the 100th beginning of the first world war. Azov. Volgograd.

**Volgograd. In 1914 Tsaritsyn (Volgograd) on the front left 120 thousand of the don Cossacks. In the city there was a hospital, the military order was carried out. The monument is a bronze George cross with a double-headed eagle, a soldier's overcoat and a rifle.**



**Azov. The basis of the sculptural composition is a bronze Cossack during The First World War. Cossack stands against the background of St. George's cross-the highest award for soldiers for military service and courage.**



# Monuments to the 100th beginning of the first world war. Tula. Saransk.

**Tula. The monument depicts Tula gunsmith and soldiers in uniforms of the early twentieth century.**



**Saransk. At the base of the monument – a bronze figure of an officer of the Royal army. According to the creators, this monument is the personification of all the inhabitants of Mordovia, whose blood was shed in the great war. The first world claimed the lives of more than 10 thousand natives of Mordovia.**

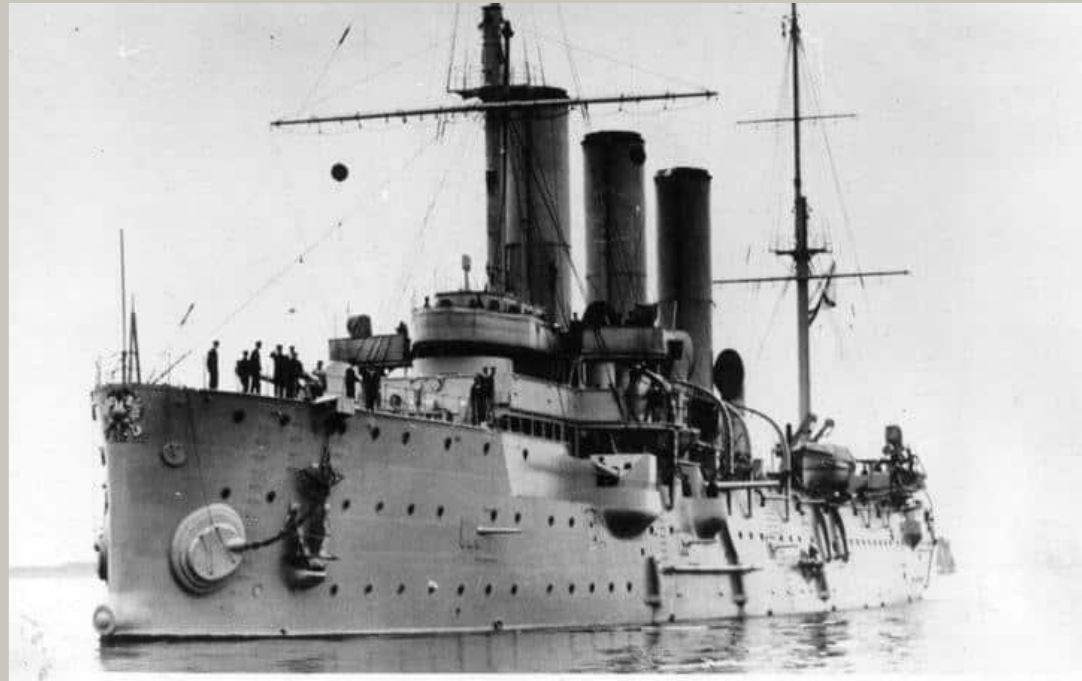




# "Living" monument. The legendary cruiser.



**During the First World War, the cruiser Aurora took an active part in the hostilities in the Baltic sea. In the Gulf of Riga "Aurora", together with other ships, supported by artillery land units...**
