Types of Sentences	I / You / We / They	He / She / It
Positive Statement (+)	I / you / we / they work	He / she / it works
Question Statement (?)	Do I / you / we / they work?	Does he / she / it work?
Negative Statement (-)	I / you / we / they do not work	He / she / it does not work

Short note: (+) I usually **go** to work by car.
 (?) Where **do** your parents **live**?
 (-) We **don't watch** television very often.

| He **speaks** four languages.
 | **Does** Ali often **play** football?
 | She **doesn't drink** coffee.

Present Simple Spelling Rules

Most verbs takes -s in the third person singular. (He/ She/ it)

1 - ss, -sh,  -es

-ch, -x, -o

I miss- he misses
I finish- he finishes
I watch- he watches
I mix- he mixes
I go- he goes

2 a consonant + y



I study - he studies
I cry- he cries

3 a vowel + y



I play- he plays

30%	Occasionally	I occasionally go to bed late
10%	Seldom	I seldom put salt on my food
5%	Hardly ever / Rarely	I hardly ever get angry
0%	Never	Vegetarians never eat meat

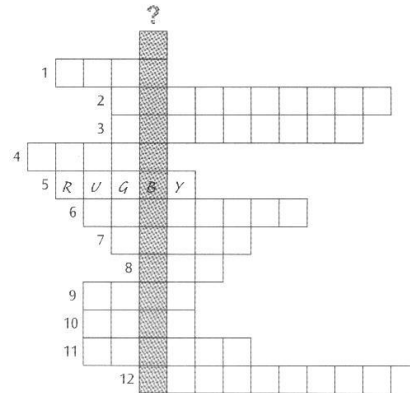
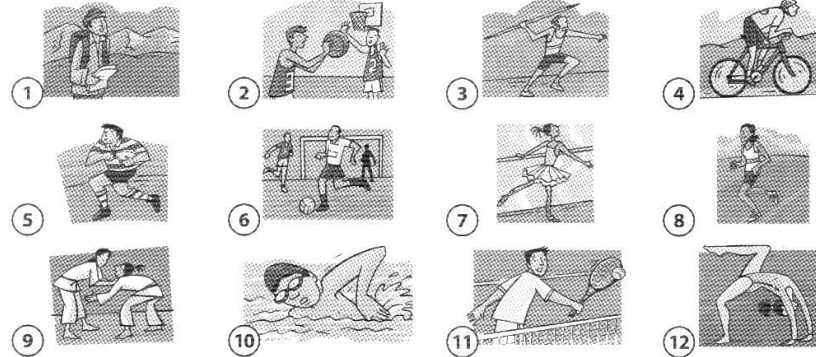

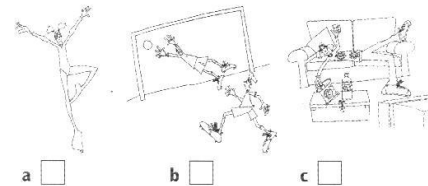
