Didn't need to / needn't have done.

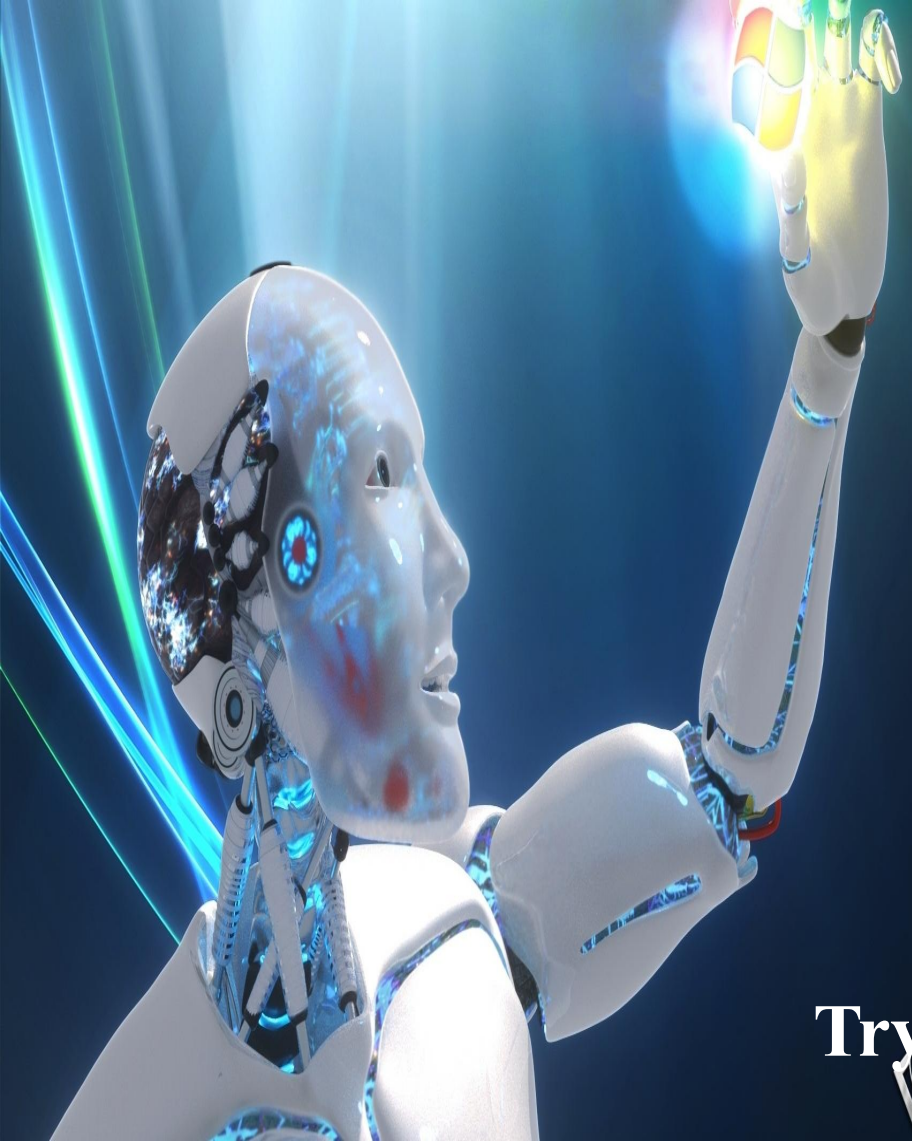
Rule:
