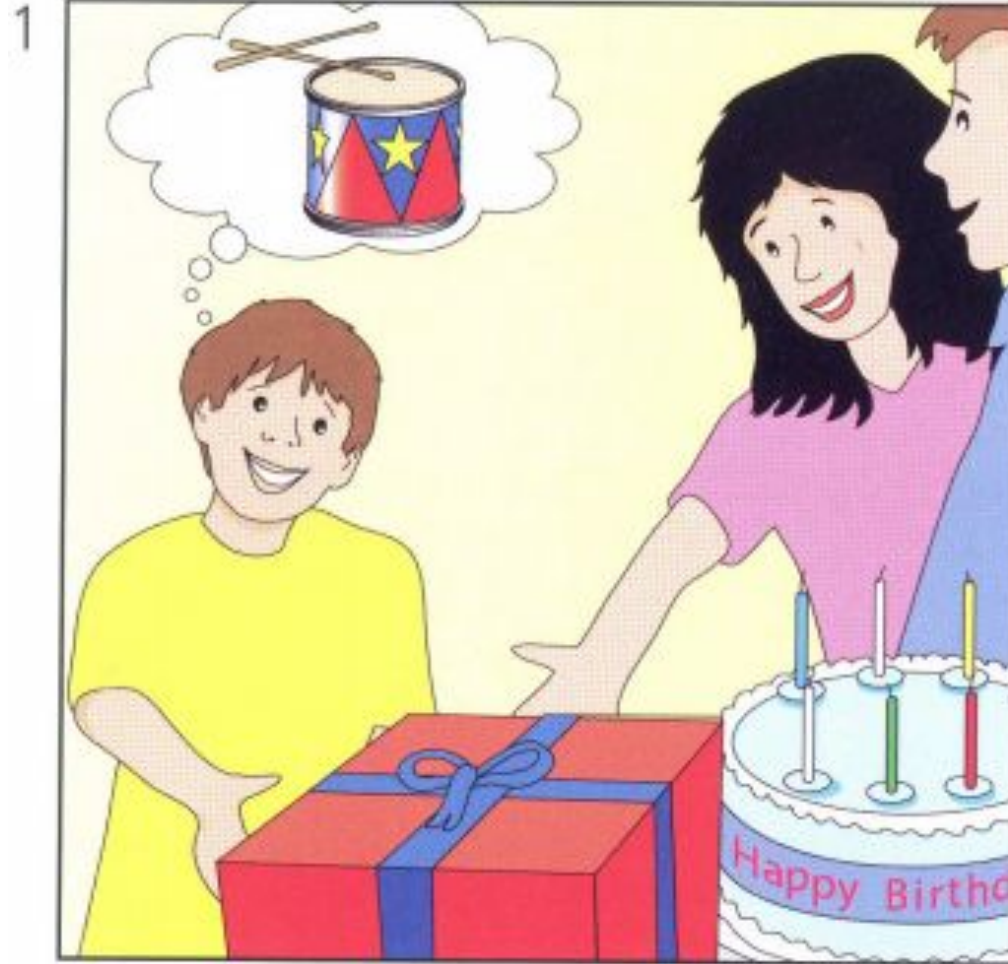

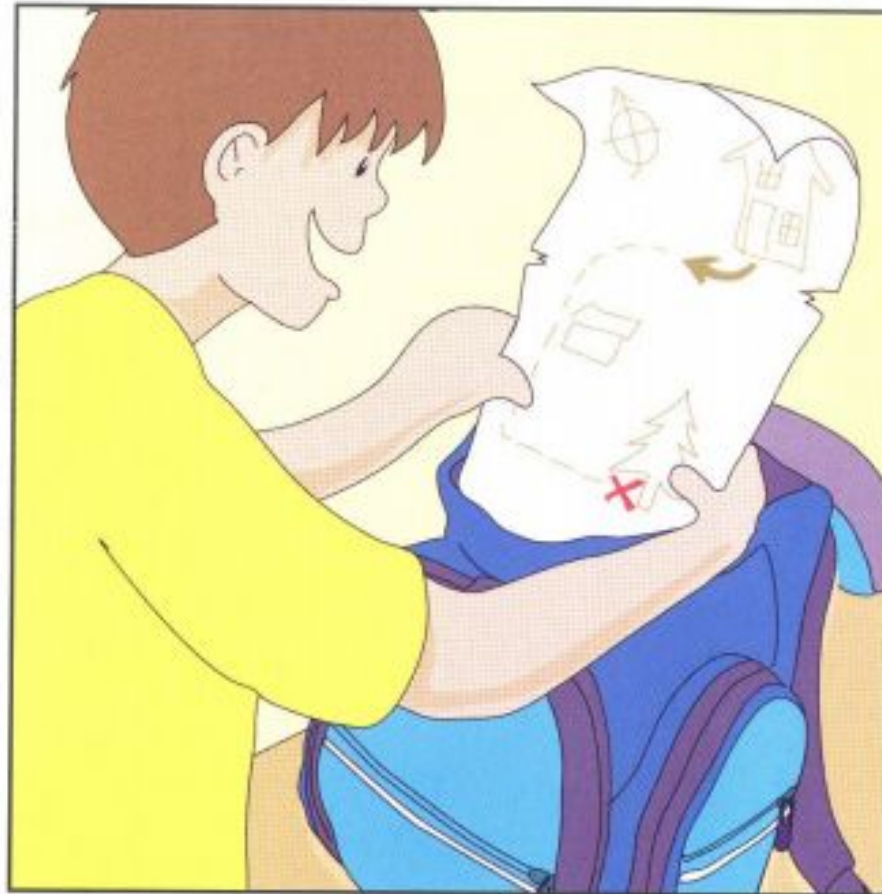

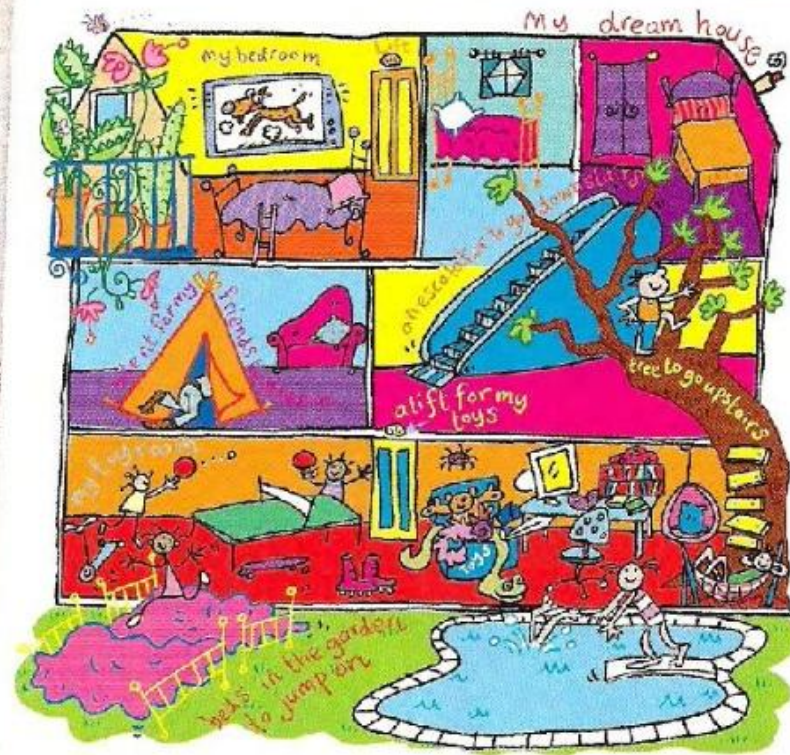

The Ugly Sisters from Cinderella

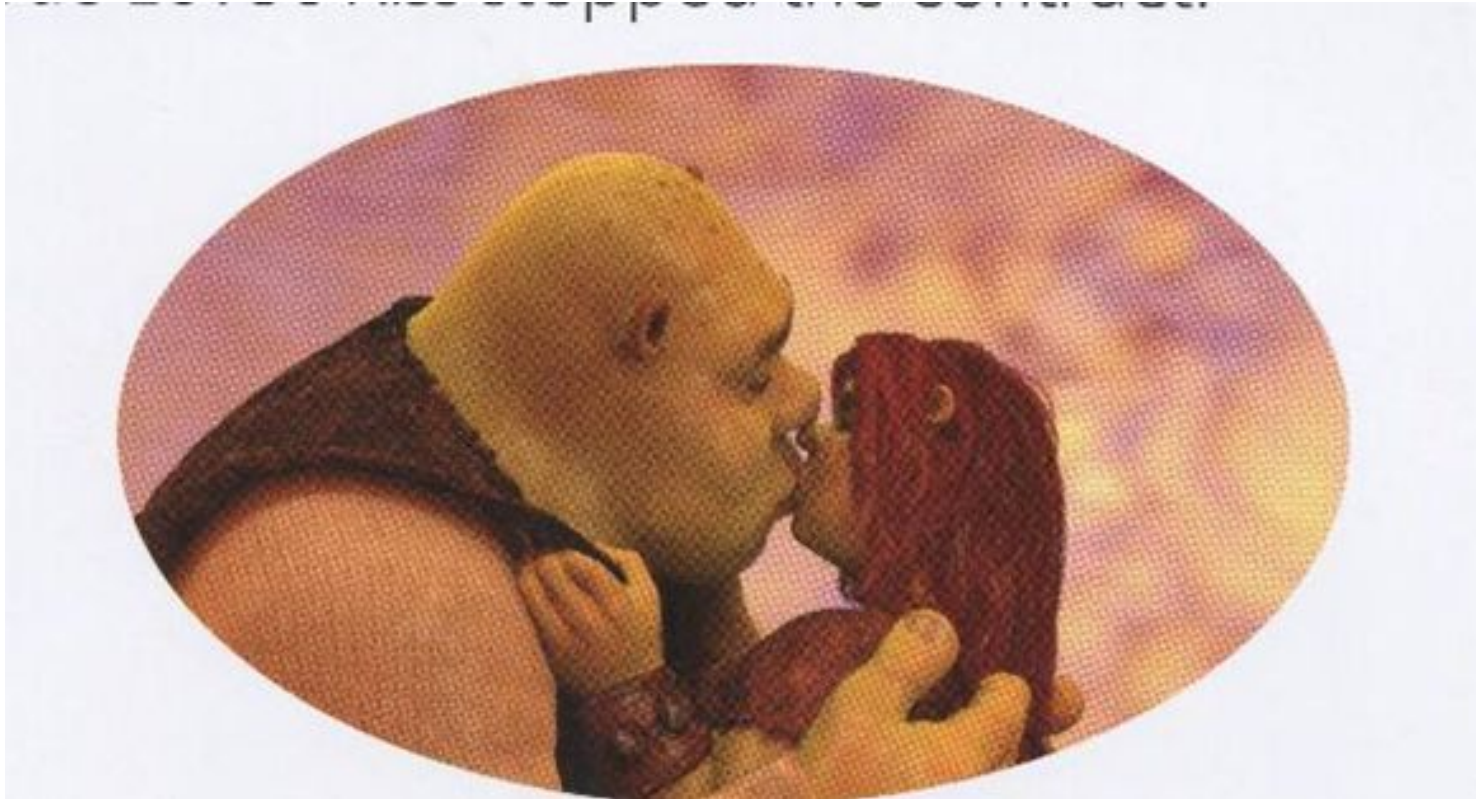
