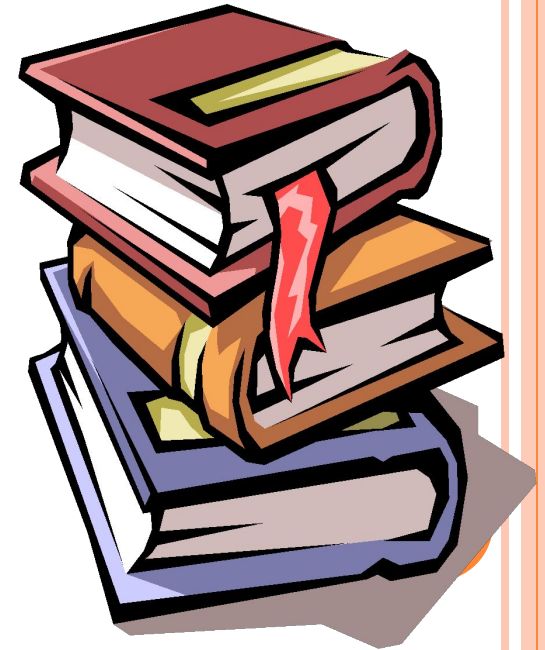

# FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE (БУДУЩЕЕ ПРОСТОЕ ВРЕМЯ) - УПОТРЕБЛЯЕТСЯ ДЛЯ ОБОЗНАЧЕНИЯ КАКОГО-ЛИБО ДЕЙСТВИЯ В БУДУЩЕМ.



Для времени Future Simple характерно употребление следующих маркеров времени:

**tomorrow** – завтра

She **will read** this book tomorrow

**in a year** – через год

I'll **go** to school in a year

**in two days** – через два дня

They **will watch** TV in two days

**next week** – на следующей неделе

year

hour

summer

autumn

winter

spring

We **won't go** to the school next week
