- **Dear Mr. Black,** - обращение к мужчине
- **Dear Mrs. Black,** - обращение к женщине
- **Dear Miss Black,** - обращение к незамужней женщине (раньше)
- **Dear Ms. Black,** - обращение к женщине независимо от семейного положения (сейчас)

- *I am happy to learn about your news-* я рад УЗНАТЬ твои НОВОСТИ

Apology

ИЗВИНЕНИЕ

- *I must apologize for not writing you earlier-* я должен извиниться за то, что не написал раньше;
- *I really should have written sooner-* мне правда стоило написать тебе раньше;
- *I am sorry I have taken such a long time to reply to your last letter-* мне жаль, что это заняло так много времени на то, что бы ответить тебе

The main part of the letter/ body

- *You asked me about-* ты спросил меня о...;
- *As you are interested in... I'd like to tell you that...* - так как тебе интересно...я бы хотел рассказать тебе...;
- *I see you had a great time-* понимаю, ты прекрасно провел время;
- *I'm glad that you had a good result...* - я рад, что у тебя хороший результат...

Linking words/Phrases Фразы, слова-связки

- *Actually*- на самом деле
- *As for me*- что касается меня(как по мне)
- *To tell the truth*- по правде говоря
- *As far as I know*- насколько я знаю
- *However*- однако
- *Unfortunately*- к сожалению
