National symbols of Ukraine

National symbol tryzub (trident)

The traditional Ukrainian symbols — trident and blue-and-yellow flag (proportions 3 by 2) — were officially adopted during Ukrainian independence in 1917–1920 and again after the Declaration of independence in 1991. The trident dates back to the Kievan Rus' as a pre-heraldic symbol of Volodymyr the Great. The national flag of Ukraine colors are commonly believed to represent blue skies above yellow wheat fields. National anthem «Shche ne vmerla Ukraina» (Ukraine Has Not Yet Perished).



Flag of Ukraine

Combination of blue and yellow as a symbol of Ukrainian lands comes from the flag of the Kingdom of Galicia–Volhynia used in 12th century. From the earliest times Ukraine was considered as an agricultural country with fertile ground, so the blue color symbolizes clear sky and the yellow color symbolizes fields of wheat.

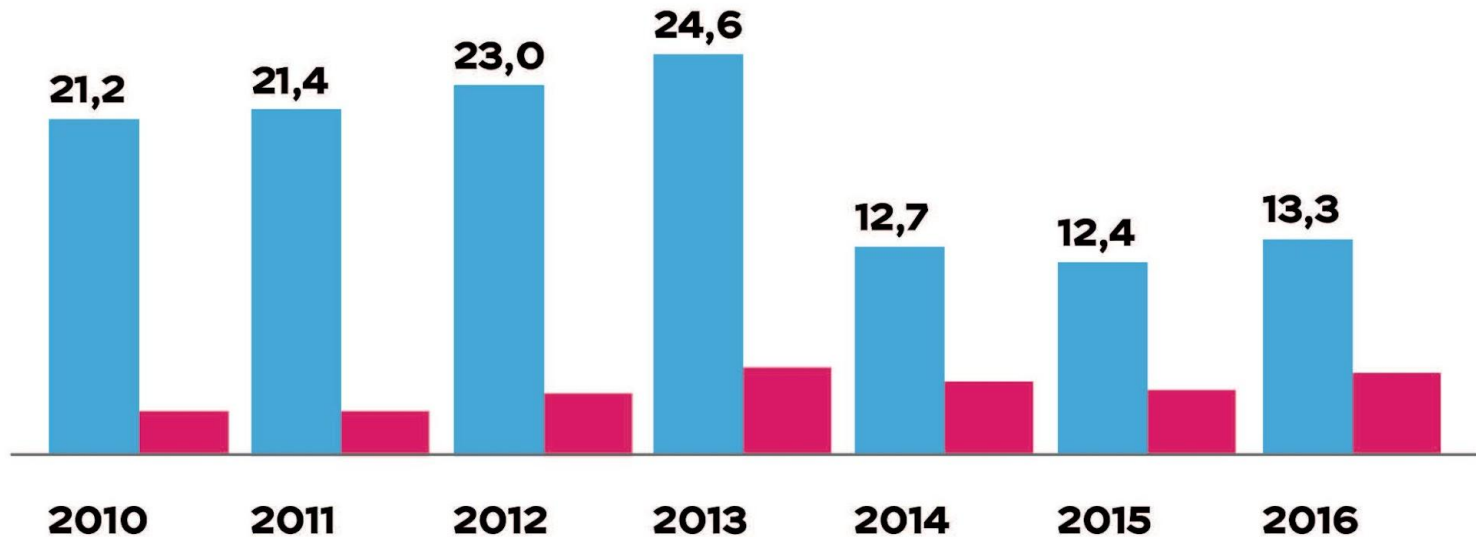
Ukraine and Turkey signed an Agreement on mutual travels of citizens with ID-cards

During the official visit of Prime Minister of Ukraine Volodymyr Groysman to the Turkish Republic there has been inked an Agreement between the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine and the Government of the Republic of Turkey amending the Agreement between the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine and the Government of the Turkish Republic on conditions of mutual trips of citizens.

The Agreement provides for the travel of citizens of both Ukraine and the Turkish Republic using passports in the form of identity cards (ID) with contactless electronic media. The citizens of the two states will be eligible to enter, leave, transit and stay without visas on the territory of Turkey and Ukraine, respectively, for a period up to 90 days within 180 days.

The implementation of provisions of the Agreement will promote the development of bilateral relations between the two countries, intensification of contacts in the socio-economic, cultural-humanitarian and other spheres.

Tourist flow to Ukraine 2010-2016



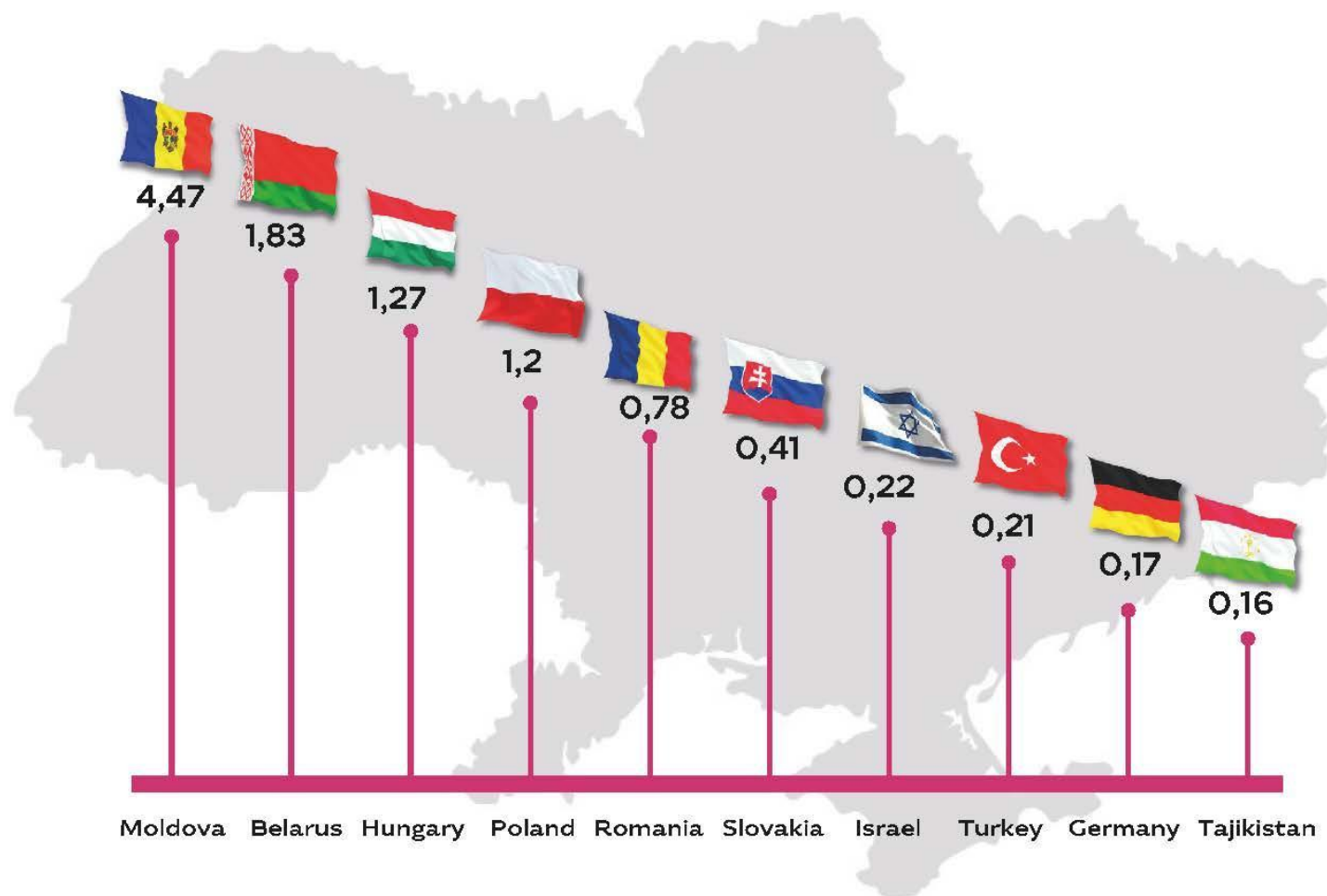
■ Foreign citizens who visited Ukraine, total

■ Number of visitors who served tourist firms of Ukraine, total



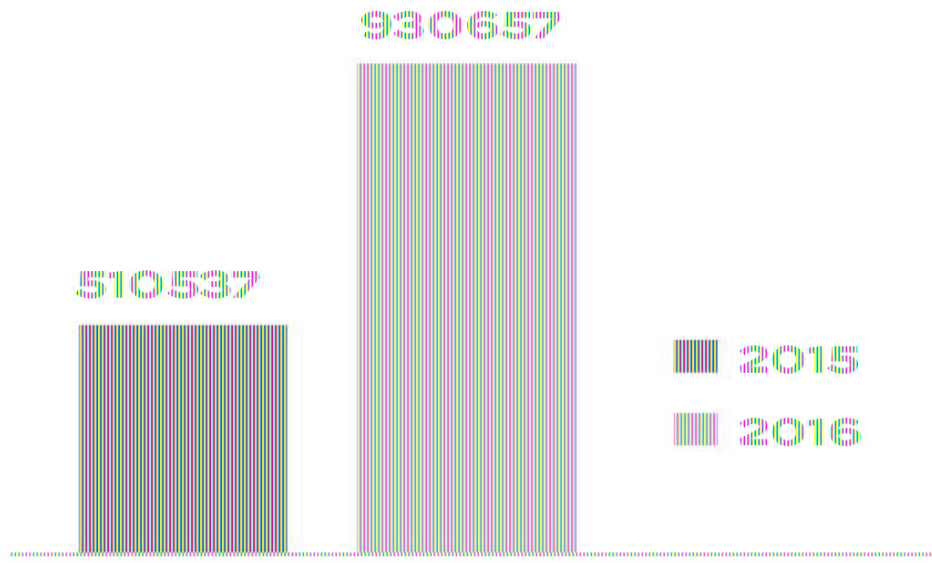

(according to the Administration of the State Border Guard Service)

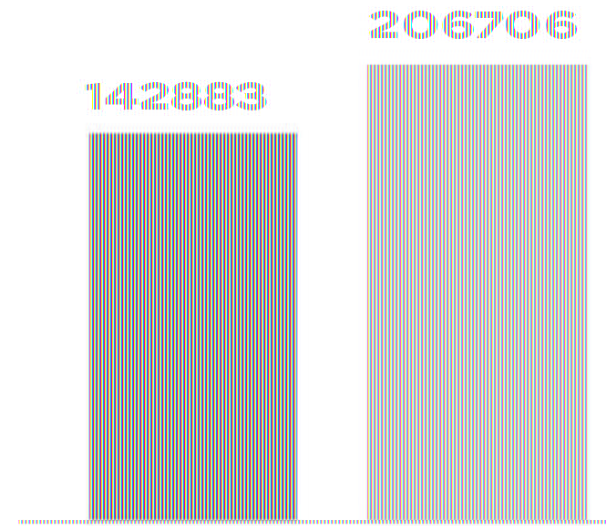

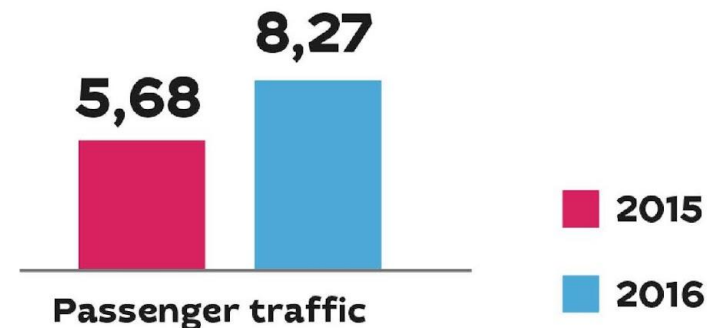

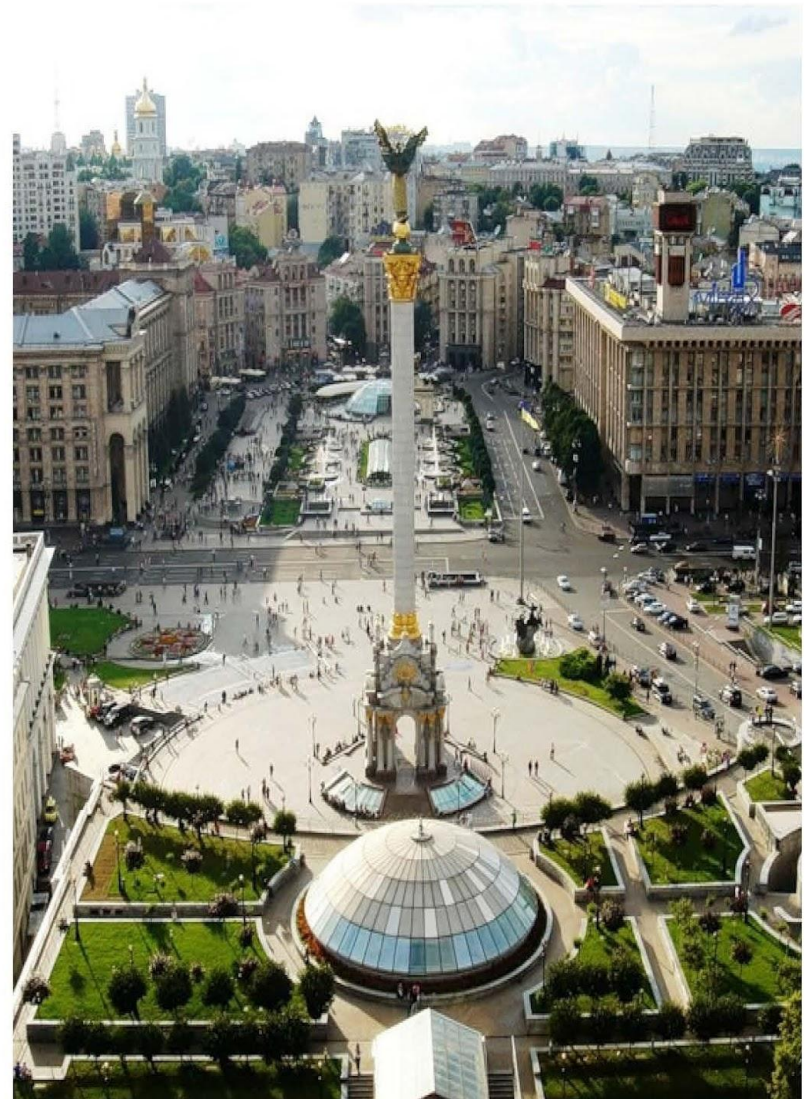

On the 28th of April 2009, Lviv has been recognized as the cultural capital of Ukraine. The main reasons of such obtaining is the conducting of more than 100 festivals annually, 60 museums, 100 churches of different confessions, and the big tourist interest in Lviv.

- **Scientific Heritage**

American journal «R&D Magazine» put the inventions of Lviv's scientists together with inventions of NASA to the rating «Top 100 best developments in the world». KPMG recognized Lviv as a top emerging IT-BPO destination in Europe, the Middle East and Africa.

- **Europe's last hidden gem**

2 600 000 tourists visited Lviv in 2016. Lviv is a place to return to: 83% of foreign tourists want to come back to Lviv. Safe city: 85.8% of foreign tourists feel totally safe.

- **Smart city**

Kharkiv, the second largest city in Ukraine, has been the major scientific and technological hub of the country. Over 22,000 IT professionals work for 300 small and medium enterprises in Kharkiv

- **Young and Education city**

Kharkiv and the Kharkiv region have the world record in terms of the number of cosmonauts. More than 20 of them flew into space. Such a large number of cosmonauts is explained by the fact that in Soviet times there were five higher aviation schools and one aviation institute in the city and the region.

- **Historical and important sights**

Svobody (Liberty) Square is one of the largest squares in the world (11.9 hectares).

Kharkiv National University named after V. Karazin - one of the oldest and largest universities in Eastern Europe, founded in 1805.

Kharkiv Zoo is the oldest zoo in Ukraine. Founded in 1896.

Maxim Gorky Central Park for Culture and Recreation - the central park of Kharkiv laid in 1893-1895 (130 hectares). Today, it is one of the main centers of recreation and entertainment.

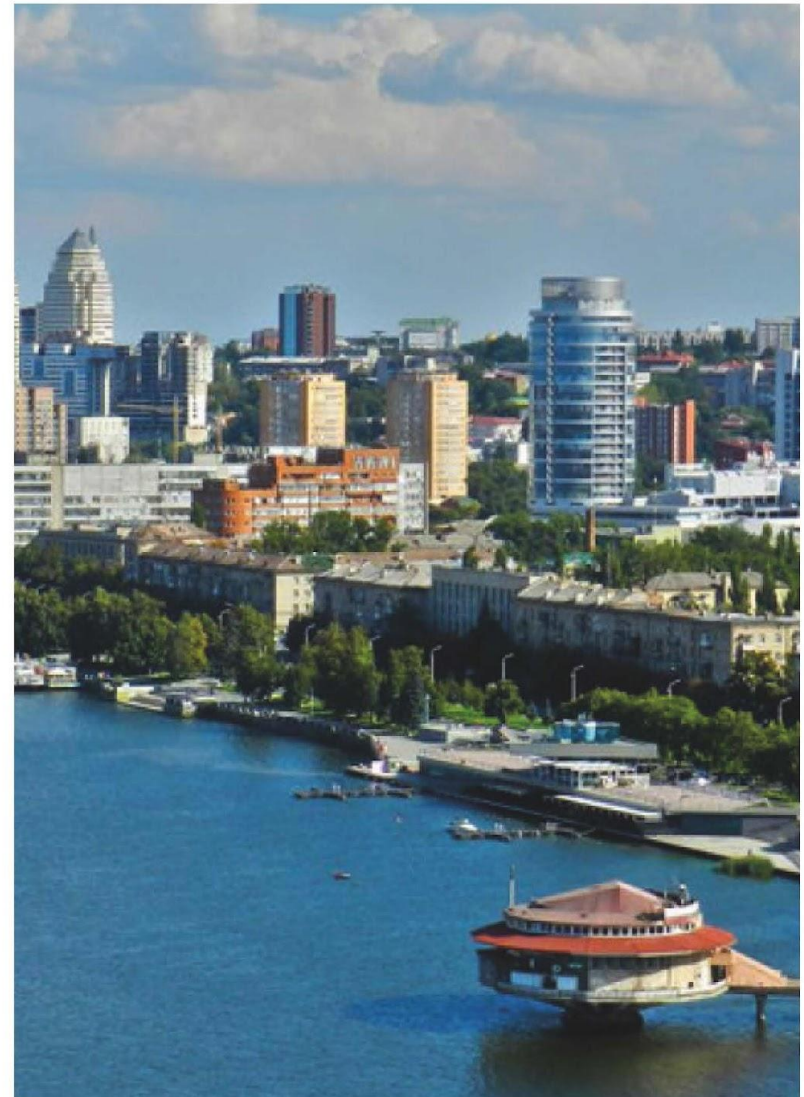

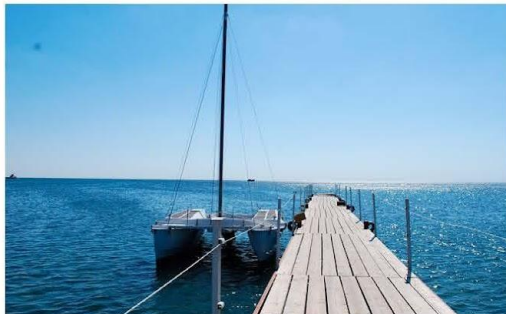

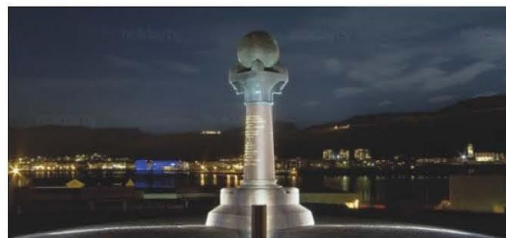
