Now, at the moment, nowadays, today. Listen! Look!

Present Perfect

- +have/has + V3/Ved
- haven't/hasn't + V3/Ved
- ? Have/has subject V3/Ved...?

Just, already, yet, for, since, ever, never, this morning
Have gone to/Have been to

Present perfect Continuous

- + have/has been Ving
- haven't/hasn't been Ving
- ? Have/Has subject been Ving...?

- -al: digit-digital, form-formal, herb-herbal
- -ish: black-blackish, short-shortish
- -ous: danger-dangerous, poison poisonous
- -y: boss-bossy, cloud-cloudy, dirt-dirty
- -ed: interest interested

Word formation

- To form adjectives from verbs, we use:
- -ive: effect effective
- -ing: excite-exciting
- -ed: excite-excited
- -less: end endless
