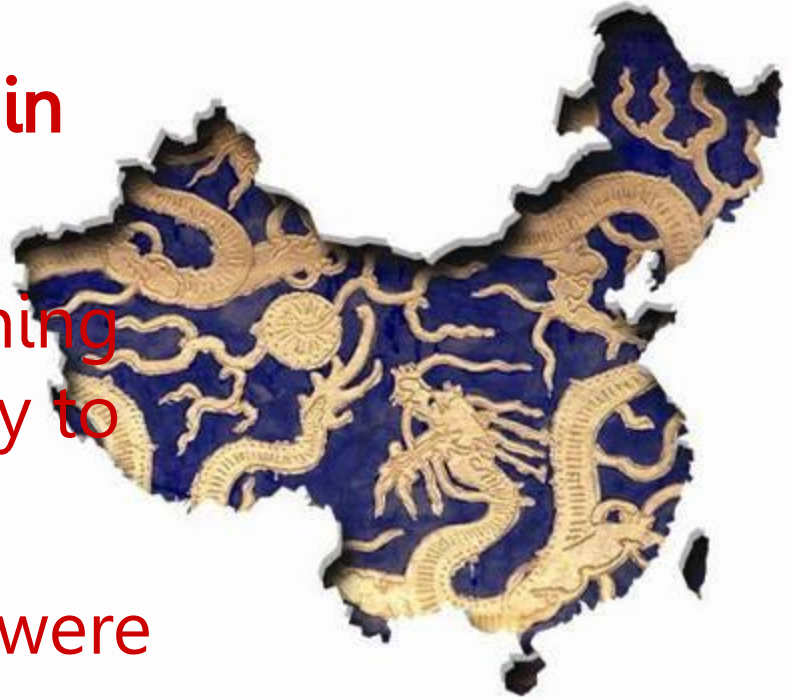

First month in China. What you should know.

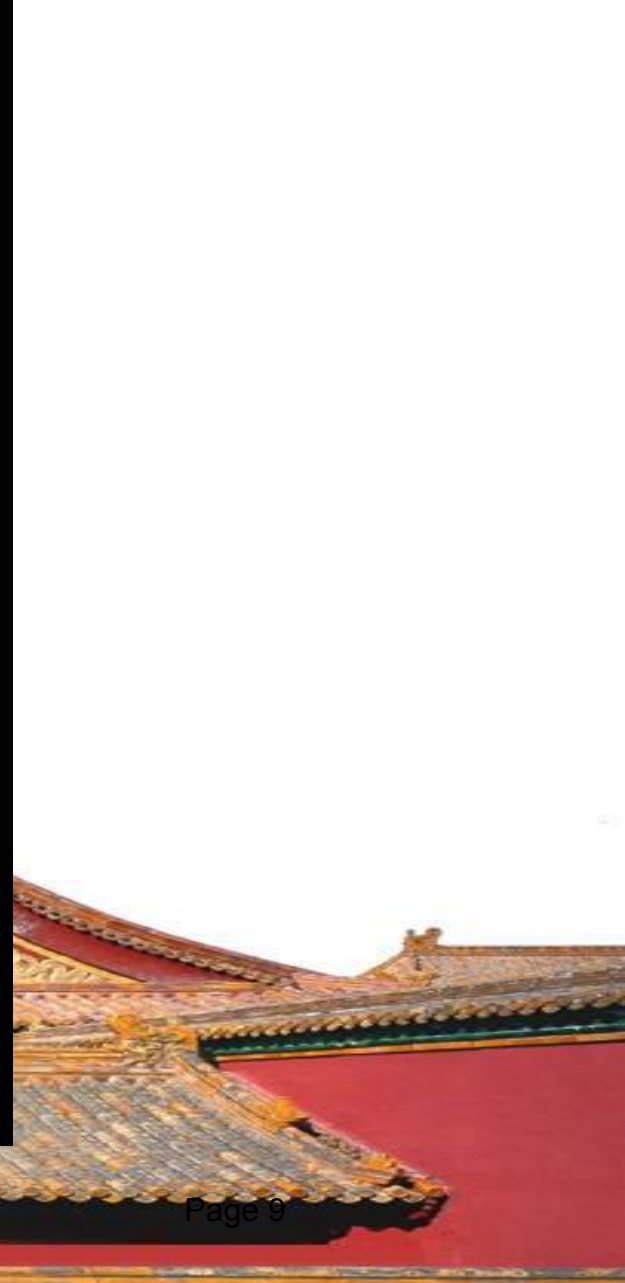

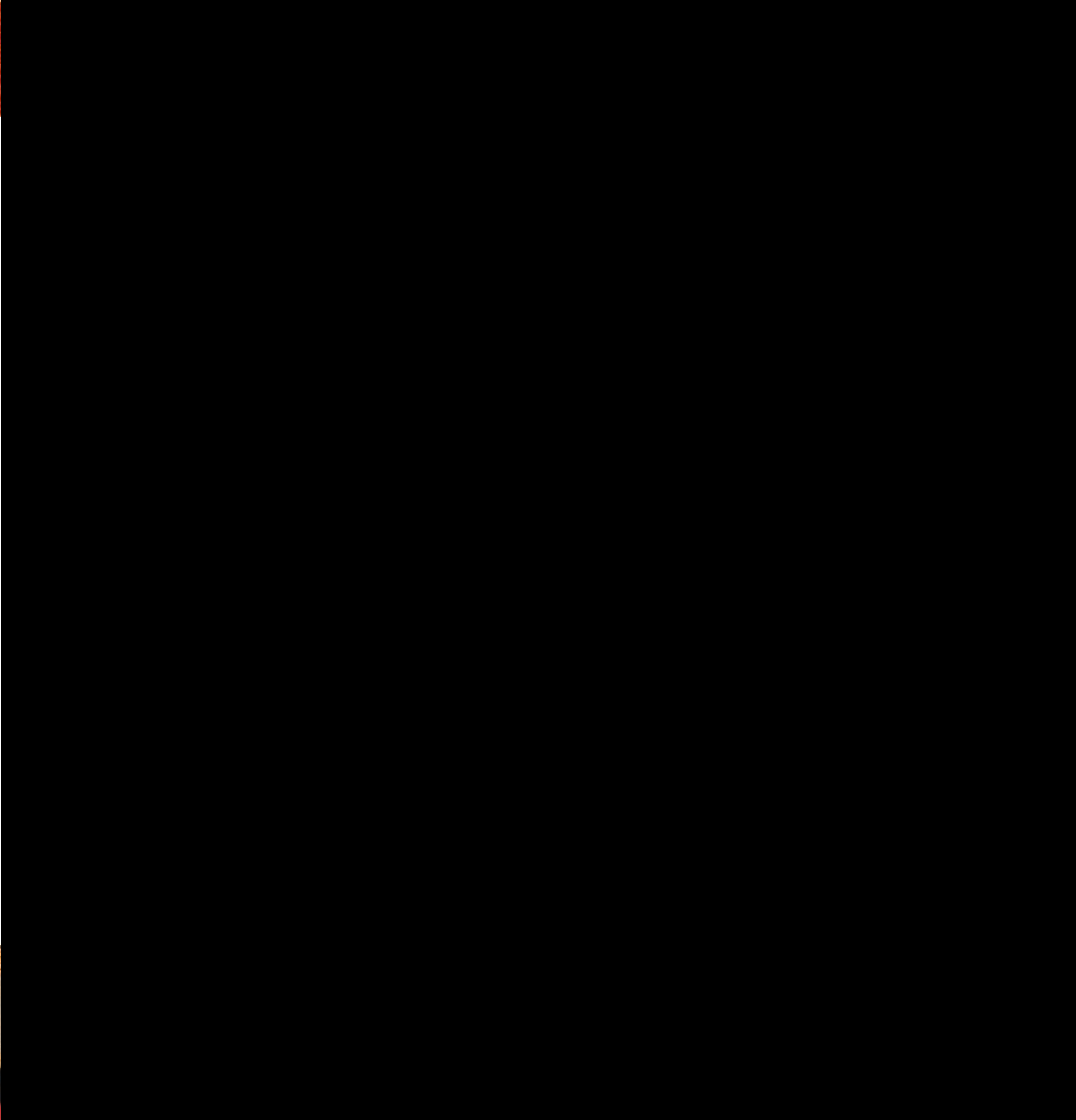
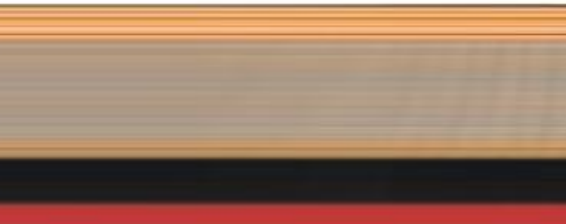


First month in China. What you should know.

The type of schools.

There are 4 types of schools in China:

- kindergarten,
- training center,
- school,
- university.

Your level of language is as good as your expected position

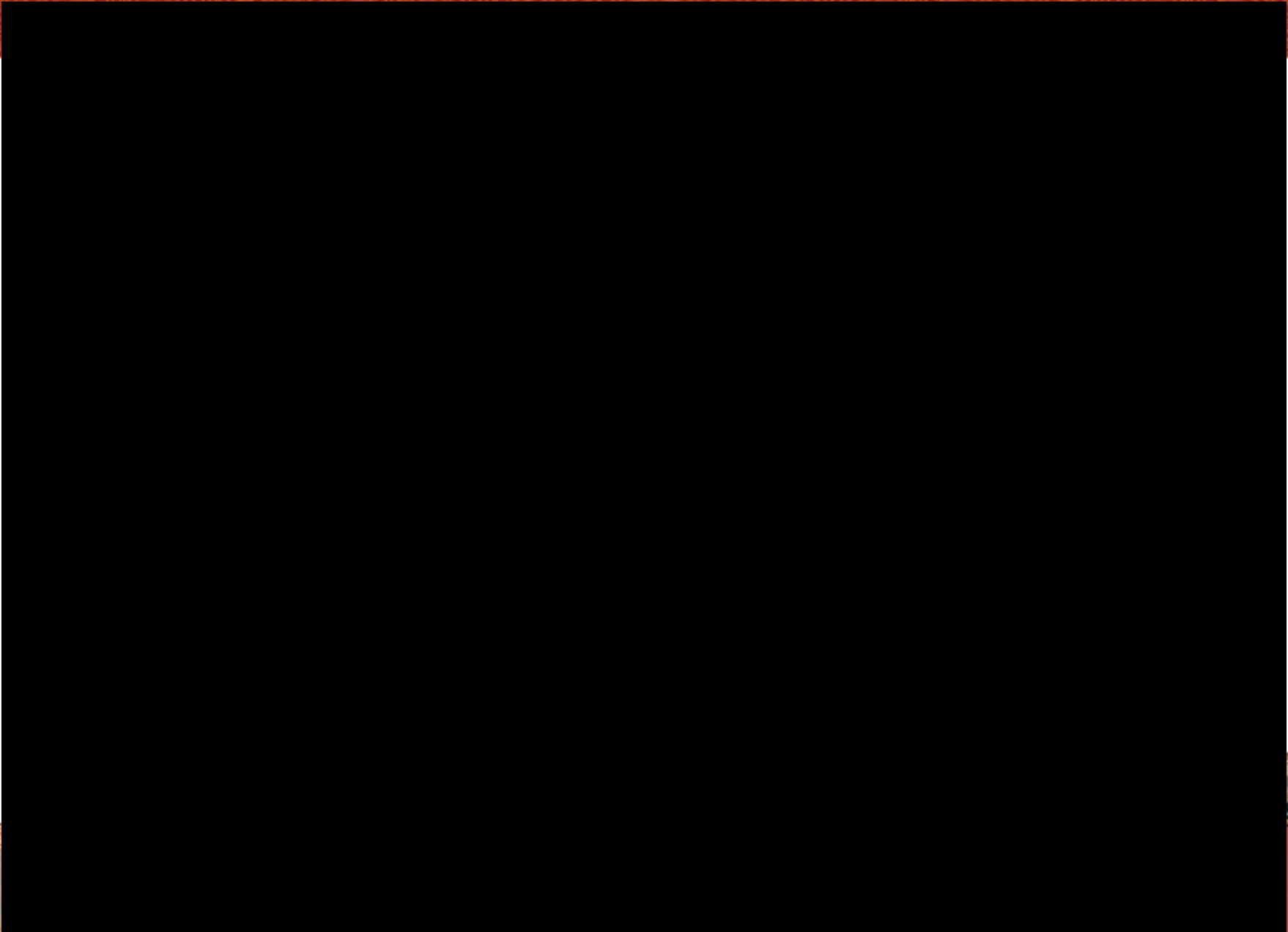


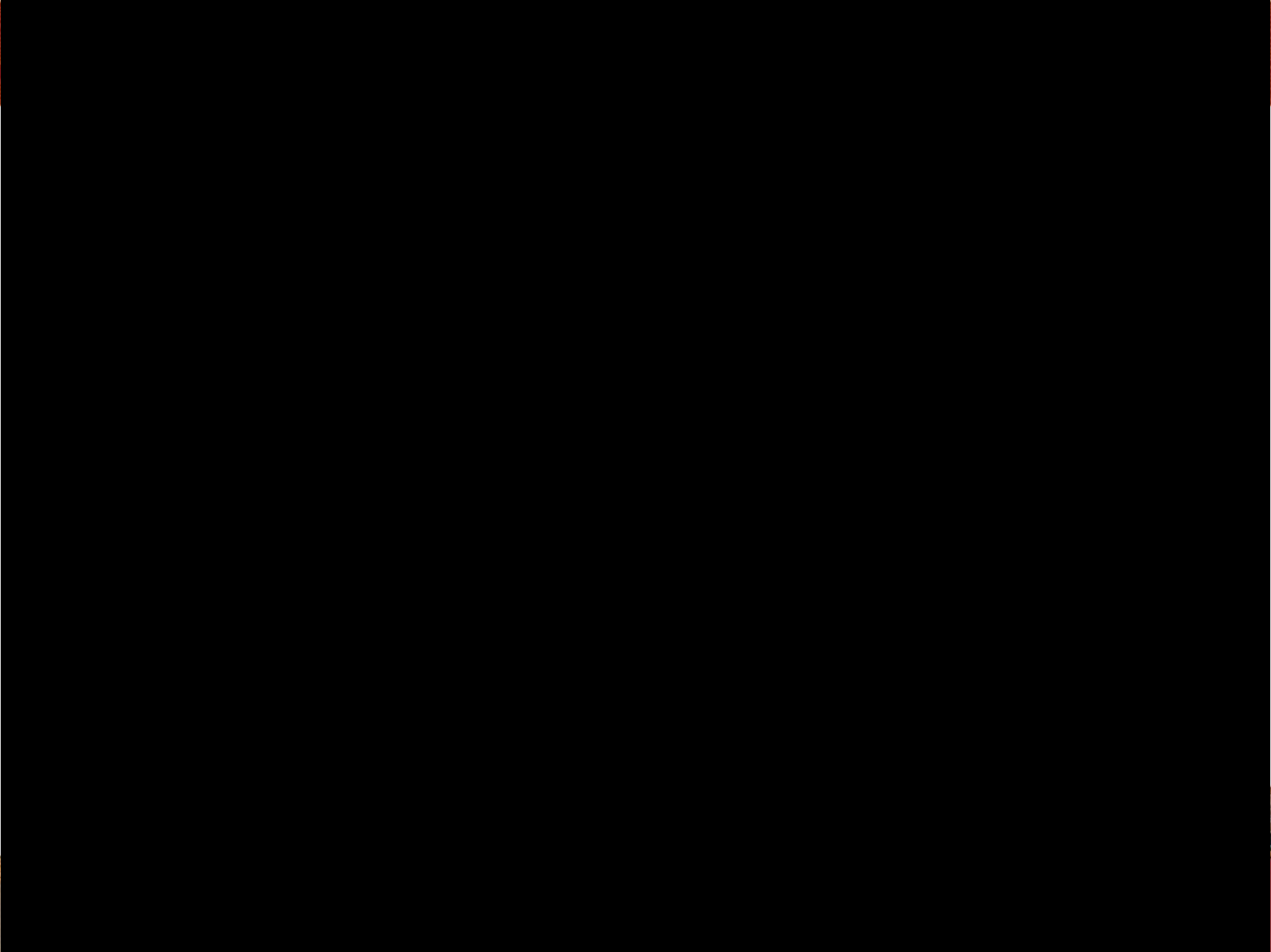
Kindergarten: children of 2-6 years old.
Working hours Monday-Friday 9-18.
With a break of 2 hours and free meal.
There you will play with children,
the required vocabulary is less.



Training center: children 4-12 years old.
It is better to consider this type of school for people who have good language level, the salary is higher and you have more classes than in kindergarten, Wednesday to Sunday.







School. Classes are about 50 kids, terrible plus your English should be very good.

University. To be honest, most of them only need native speakers, so it's really a cool salary from \$ 3,000 to \$5,000.

Okay, let's make a **conclusion**.

The Chinese want to learn English. This is open territory. They focus on an American or British Accent and they want their children to be able to read, listen, understand and copy it.

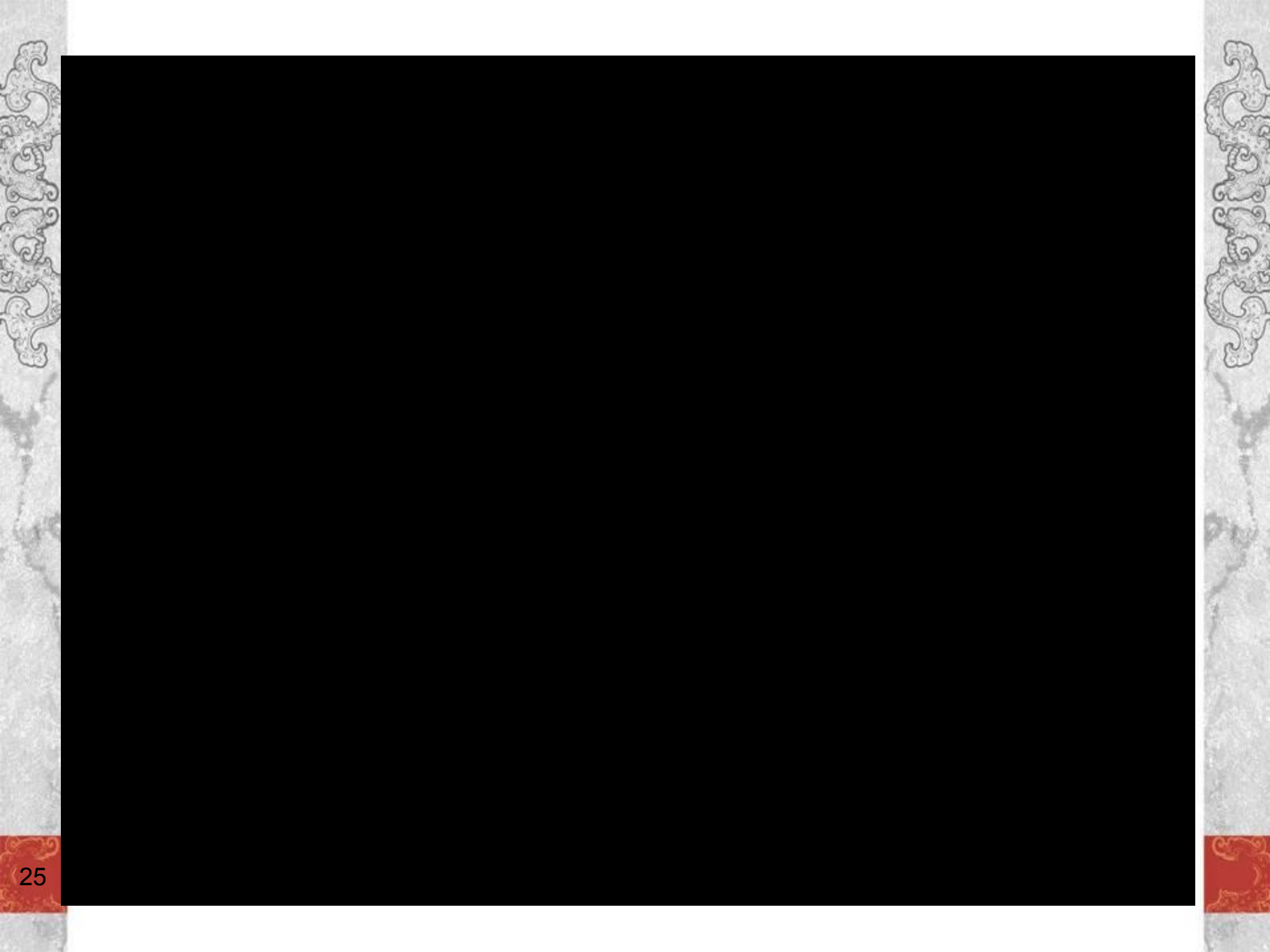
For and against working in China as an English teacher.

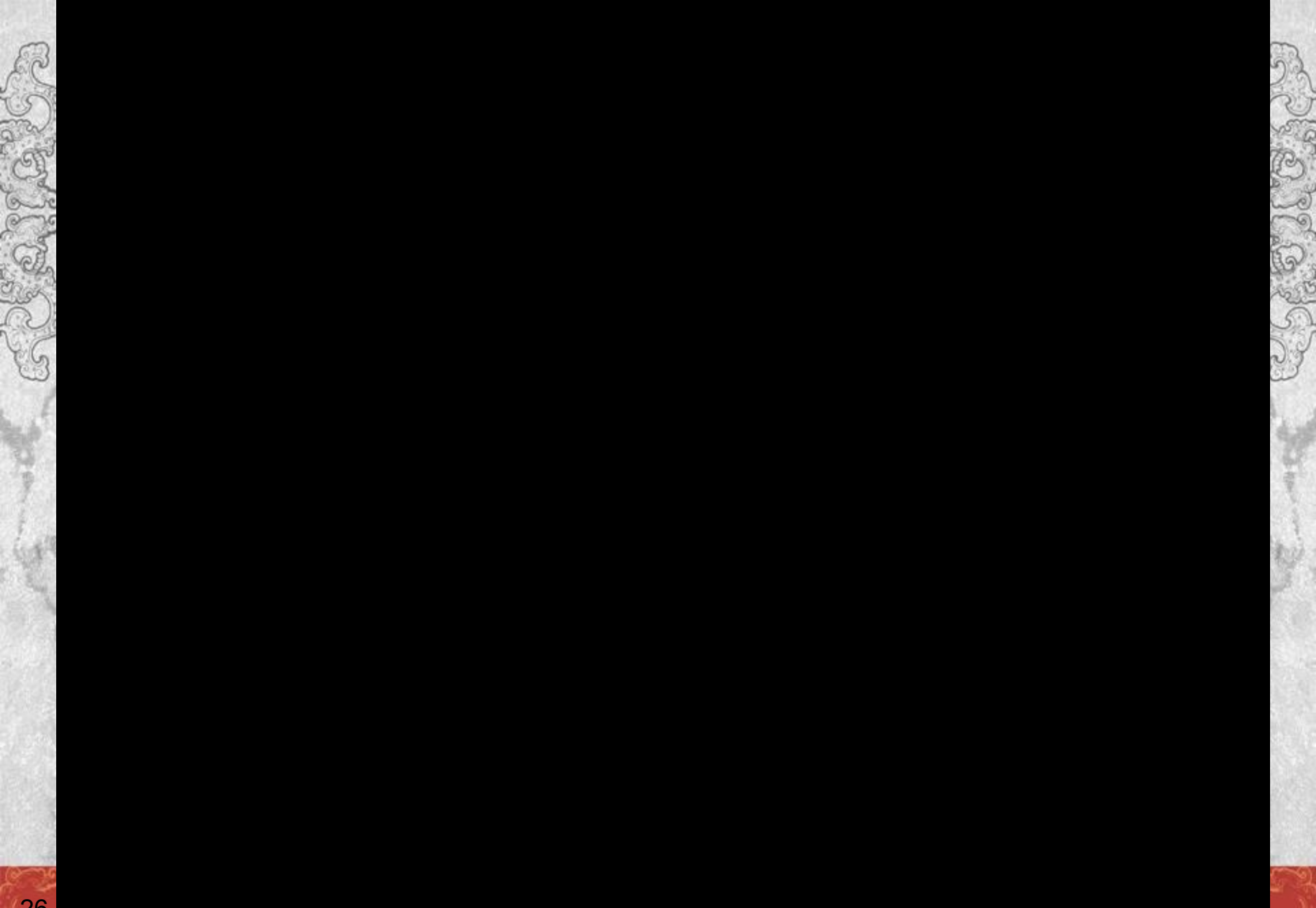
pros: salary, a lot of free time, positive work, an opportunity to learn Chinese
