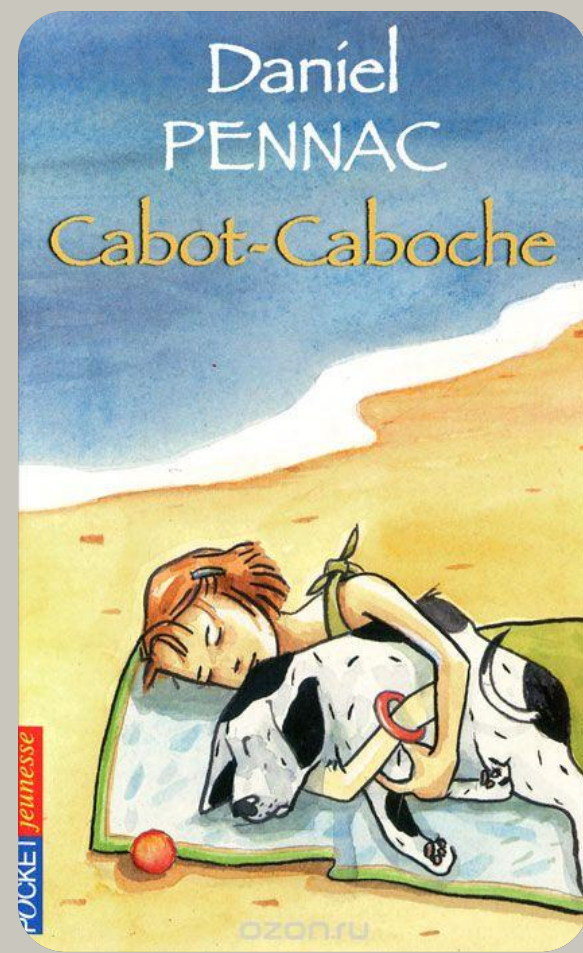
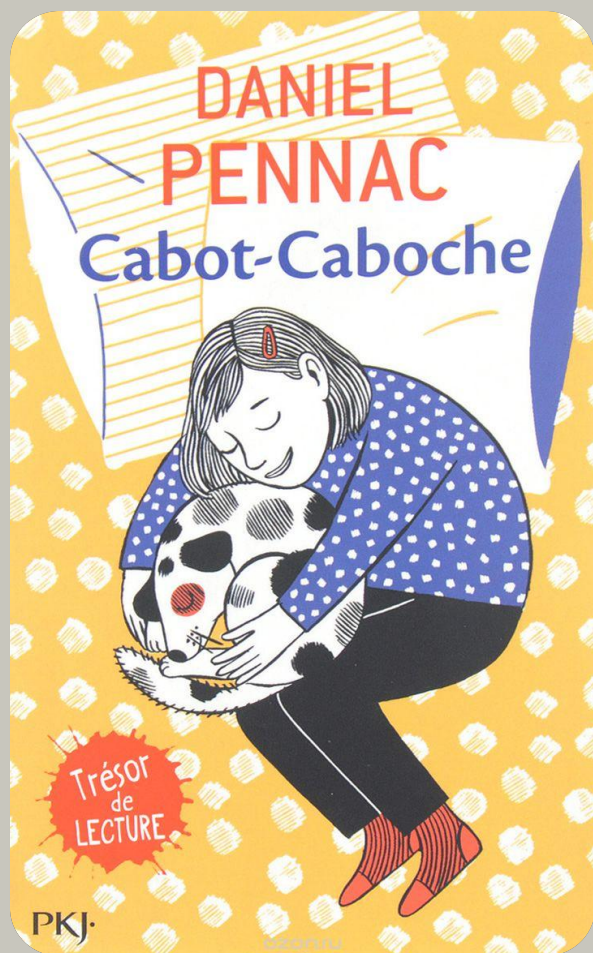

- ❑ Curiosity

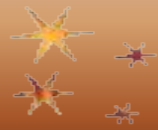




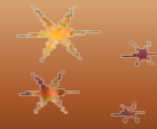
# Adult:
