- ◉ The lesson hasn't begun yet, you're not late.



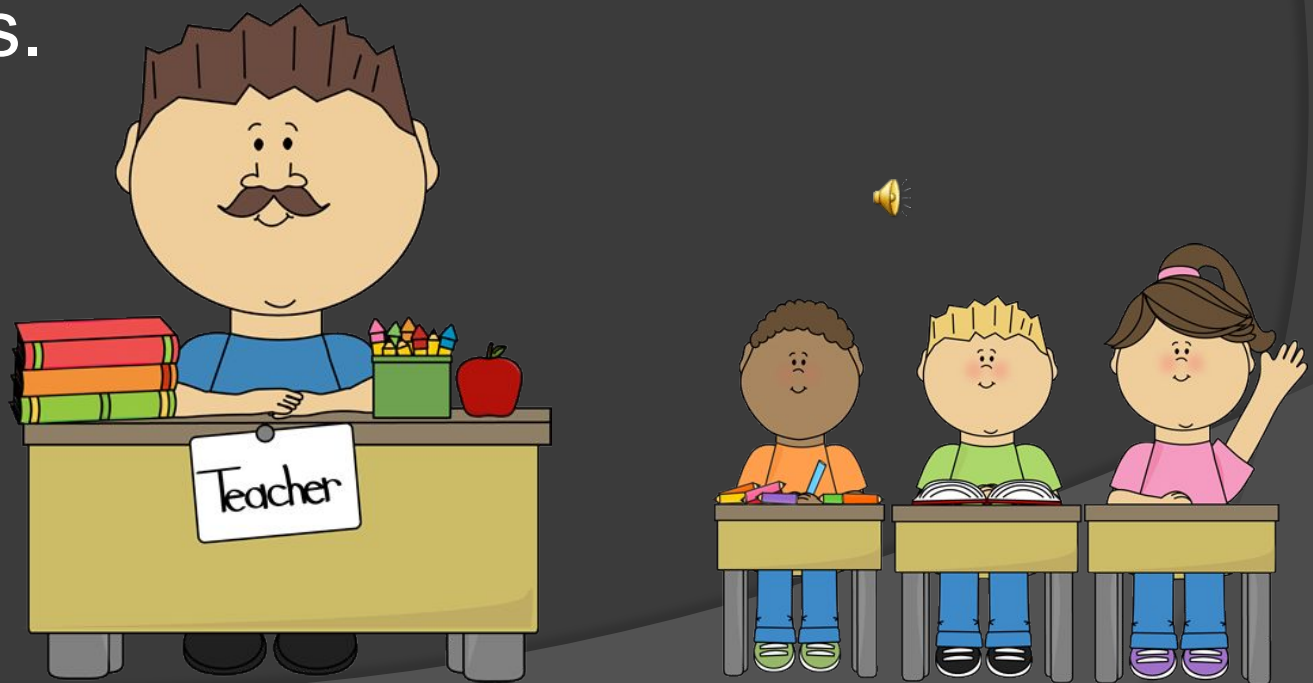
My mother **makes** delicious pizza.

- ◎ It is the first time that I have ever made pizza.



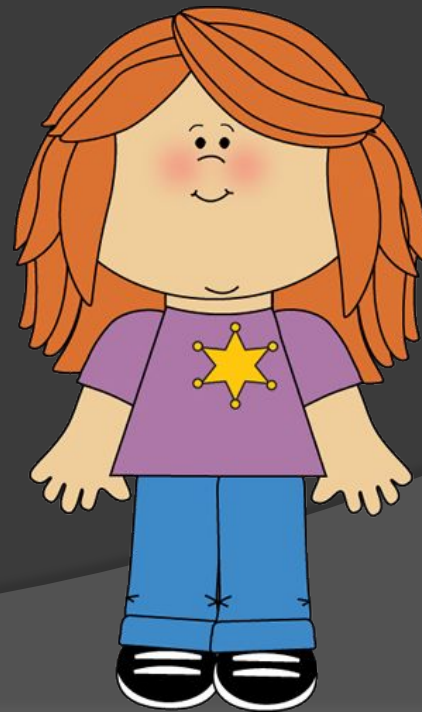
My English teacher **teaches** us grammar.

- My teacher has **taught** English for 10 years.



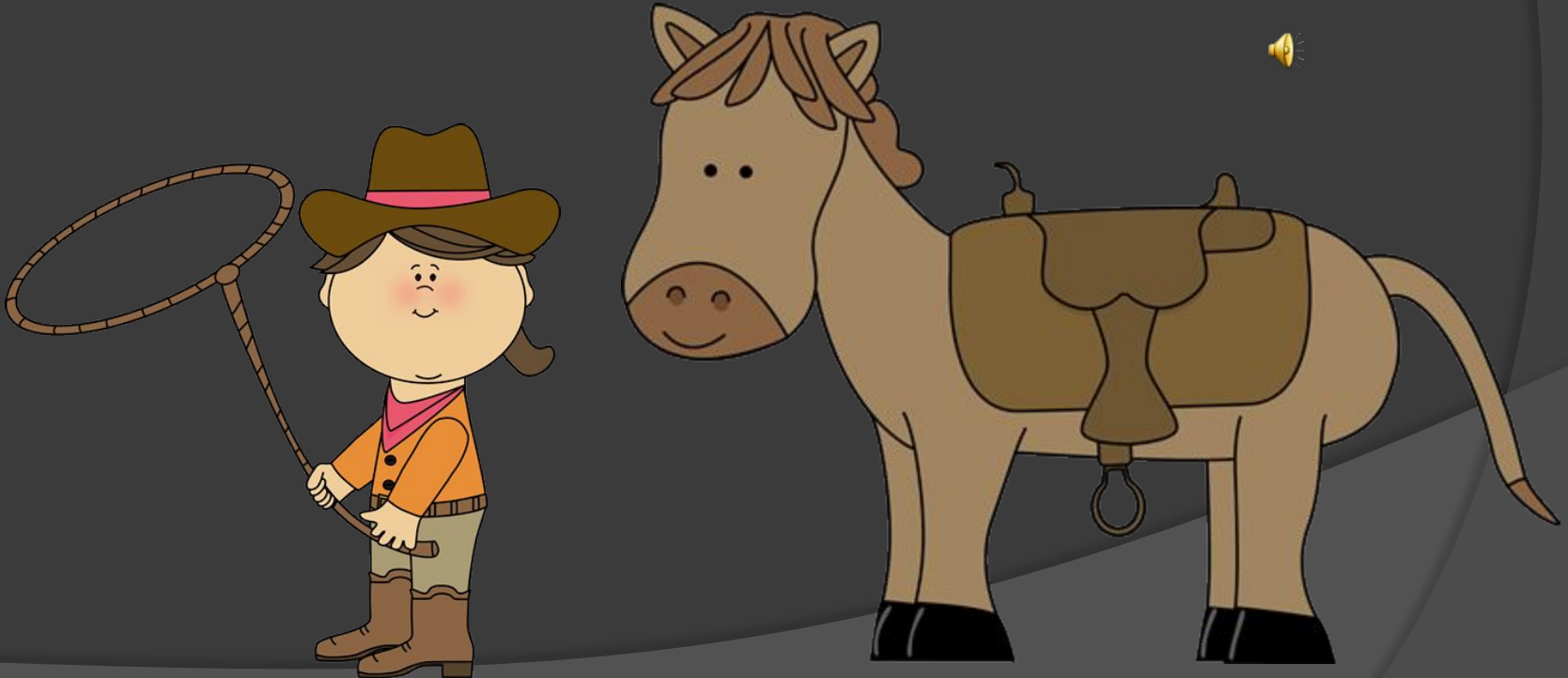
I always **wear** T-shirts in the summer.

Jonathon is a basketball player.

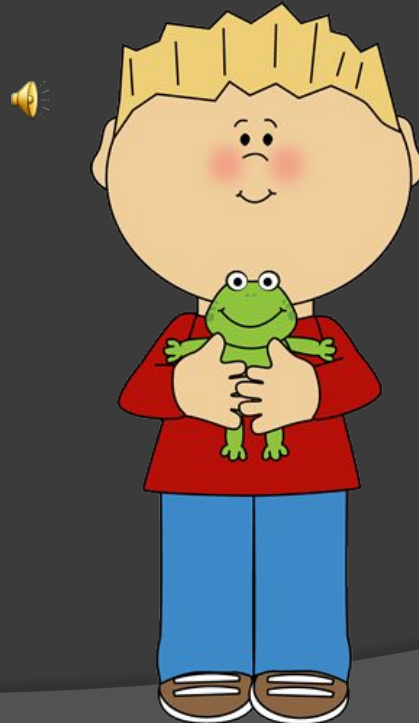
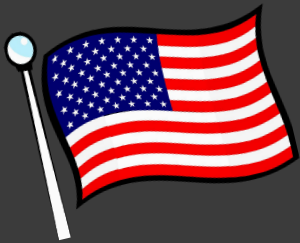
⦿ He has been a basketball player for 2 years.

Jayden **speaks** Spanish and English.

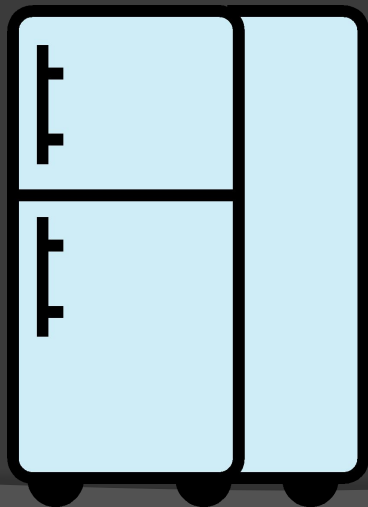
- I didn't **spe**ak English last year.

How are you guys?

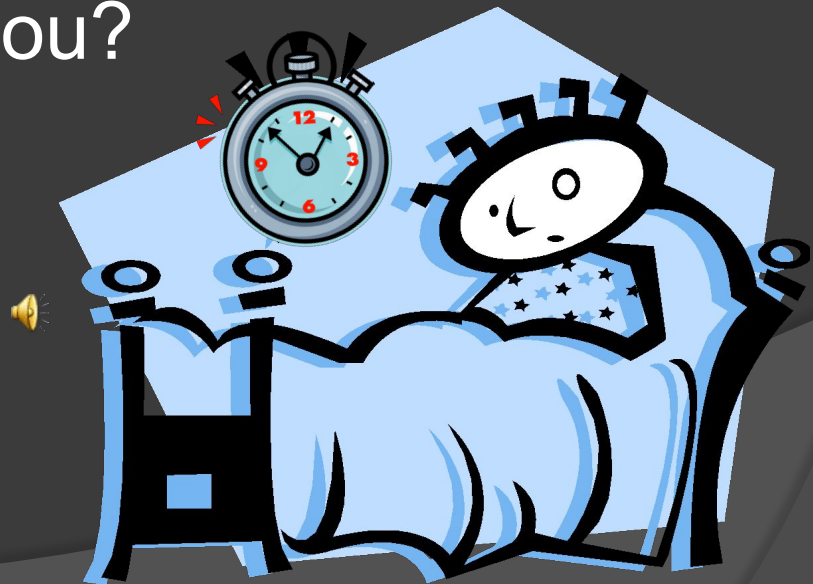
I always **put** my keys on the table.

- ◉ Who **put** my keys in the fridge?



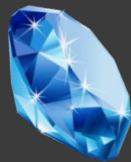
Sophia **wakes up** at 7 o'clock.

- ◉ He has always swum 2 kilometers every morning since he was 18 years old.

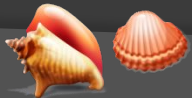
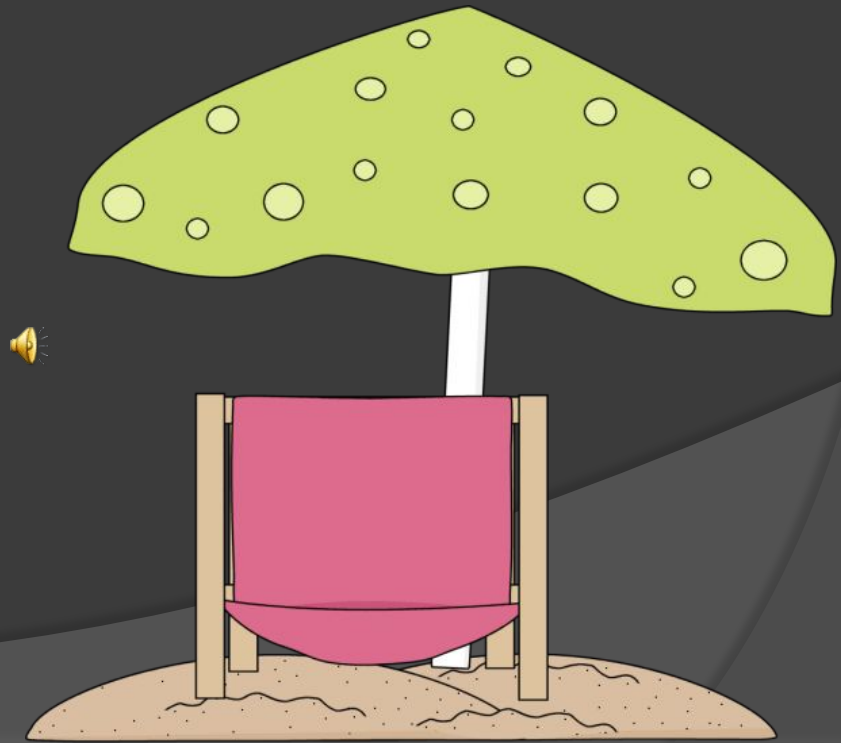




She **sells** sea shell by the seashore.

- ◎ She has **sold** many seashells this year.




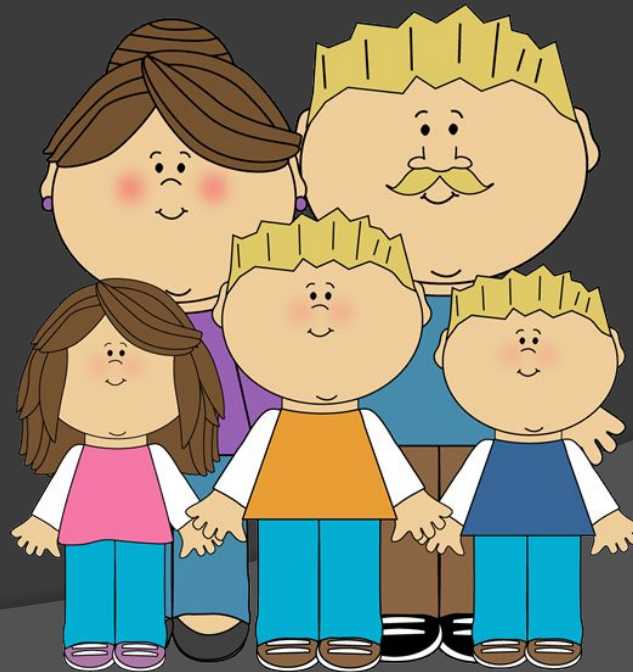
Mom **buys** us birthday presents every year.

- The Miami Heat have won the championship for 2 years in a row.



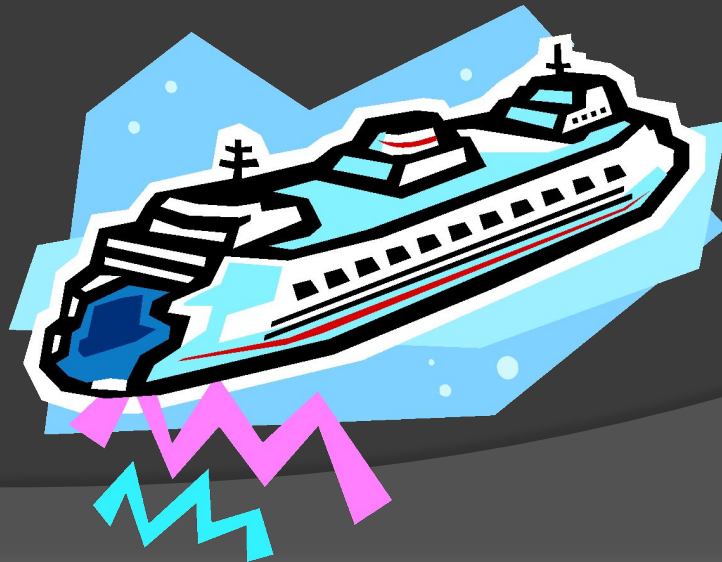
Peter **leaves** home at 8 o'clock.

- ◉ Have you ever **left** the cinema before the end of the movie?



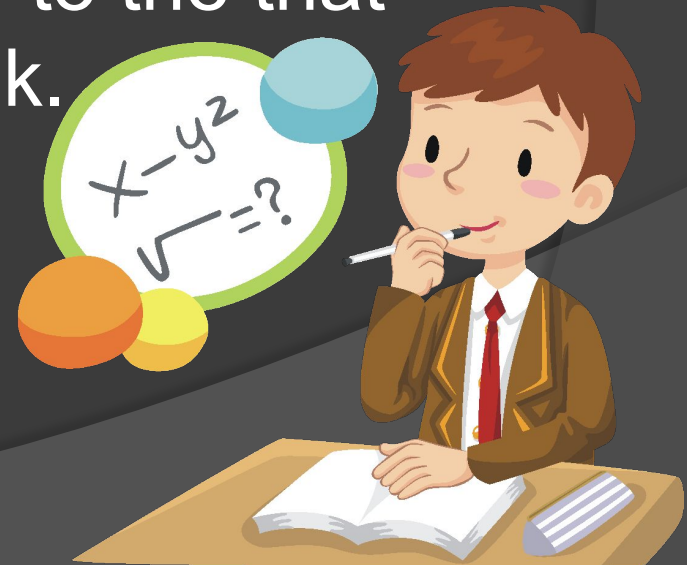
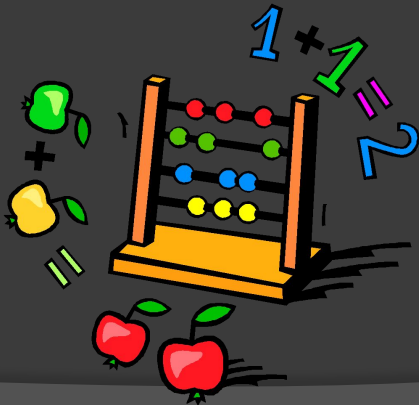
We **take** the ferry to the island.
