the cold weather (noun), because I lived in Siberia for 30 years.

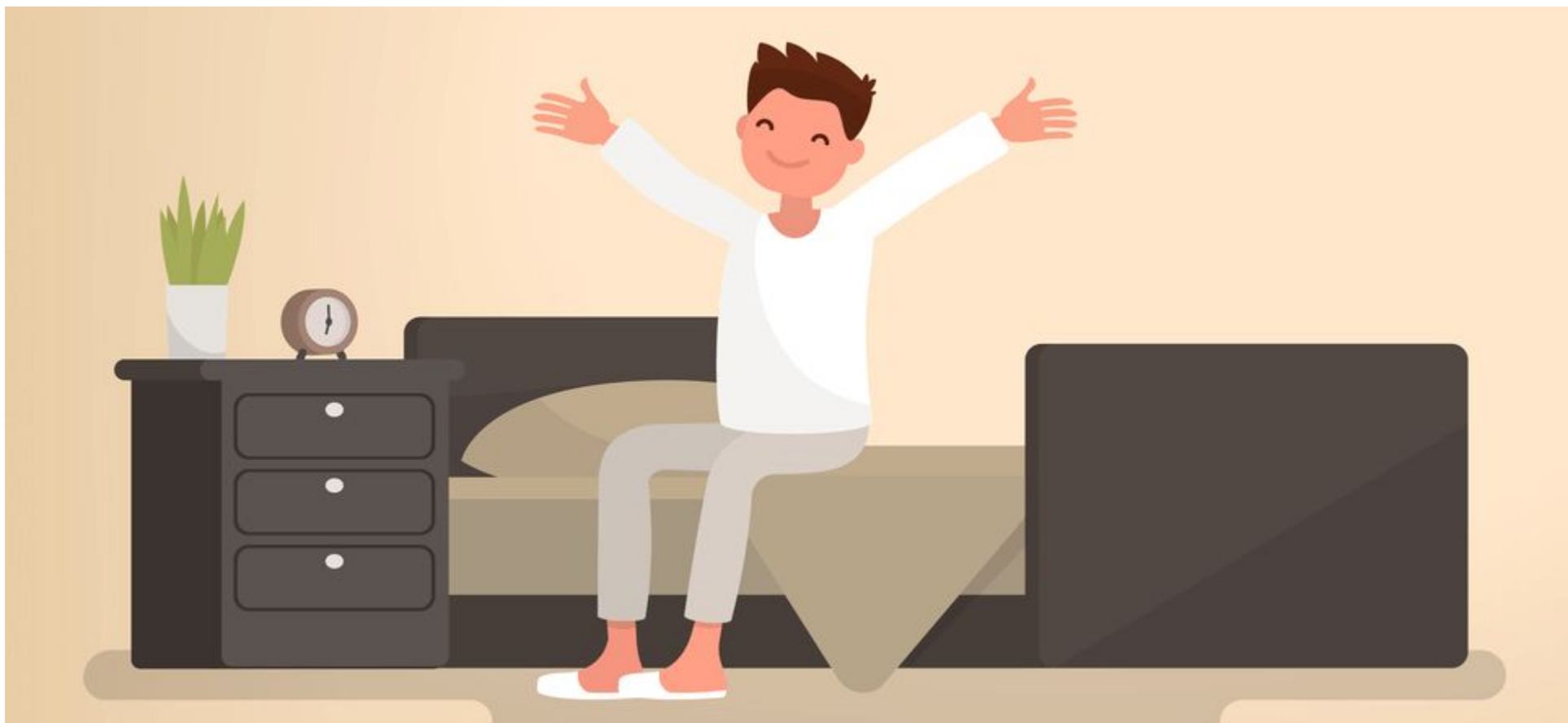
cigarette smoke (noun), because my father always smokes at home.
