1. GENERAL RULE: REGULAR PLURALS

SINGULAR NOUN + S = PLURAL NOUN


SINGULAR NOUNS ENDING IN -CH, -S, ,-SS, -S, -O,-X + ES = PLURAL NOUN

3. Plural of Nouns

But **NOUNS OF FOREIGN ORIGIN** ENDING IN **-O** JUST ADD **-S**

EXAMPLE:



PIANO



PIANOS



4. Plural of Nouns

Singular noun ending in a consonant + -Y
change the -Y to -I + -es = Plural Noun

EXAMPLE:









Country

Countries

Baby

Babies



Plural of Nouns

Singular Nouns ending in a vowel + y just add -s = Plural Noun

EXAMPLE:











Deural of Nouns

SINGULAR NOUNS ENDING IN **-F** or **_FE** change the **-F** or **-FE to -VES**.

EXAMPLES:



LEAF



LEAVES



WOLF



WOLVES

JRRREGULAR PLURALS

SOME NOUNS ARE irregular AND THEY DON'T FOLLOW THE RULES ABOVE.




