St. Paul's Cathedral

- St. Paul's Cathedral-the Cathedral, dedicated to St. Paul. Located on the top of the hill of Ludgate hill, the highest point of London is the seat of the Bishop of London.



The Royal Canadian Regiment Museum

- **The Royal Canadian Regiment Museum** is a military museum located at [Wolseley Barracks](#) (the former [CFB London](#)) in [London, Ontario, Canada](#), the historic home of [The Royal Canadian Regiment](#) (RCR).



Banting House

- Known as “The Birthplace of Insulin.” Located at 442 Adelaide St. N. in London, Ontario, it is the house where Sir Frederick Banting woke up at two o’clock in the morning on October 31st, 1920 with the idea that led to the discovery of insulin.

- The **Sifton Bog** is a wetland jointly administered by the city of [London, Ontario](#), and the [Upper Thames River Conservation Authority](#). It is located west of Hyde Park Road and south of Oxford Street inside the city limits of London, Southern Ontario, Canada. It is a Class 2 provincially significant wetland.
