The UK is the **78th**-largest sovereign state in the world and the **11th**-largest in Europe.

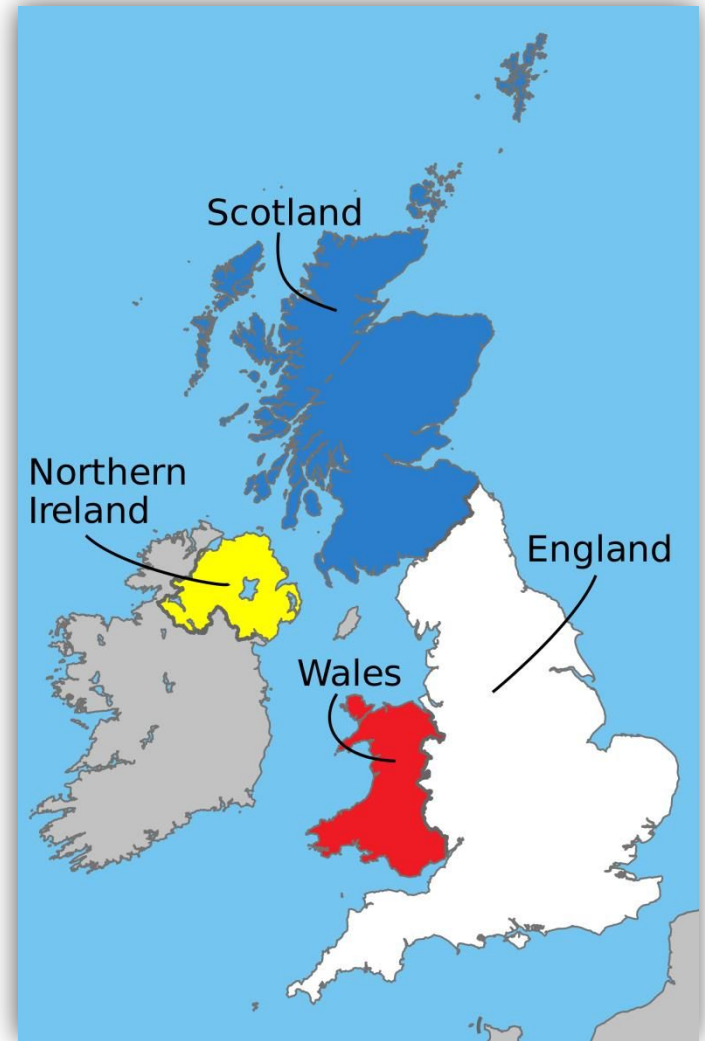
It is also the **22nd**-most populous country, with an estimated 65.1 million inhabitants (2016).

Unitary parliamentary constitutional monarchy

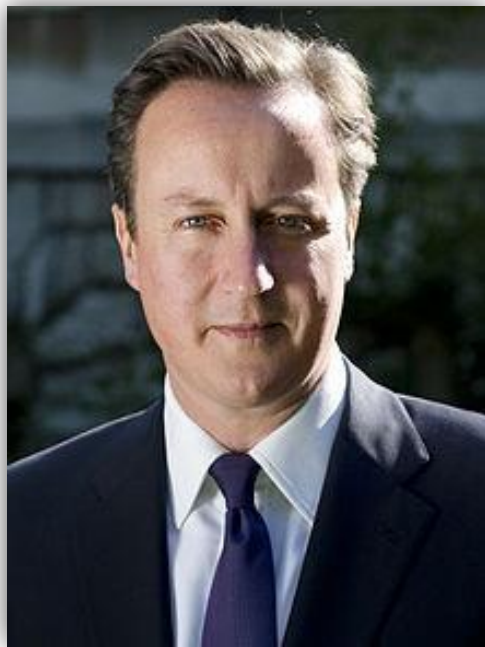
- Monarch – Queen Elizabeth II

The United Kingdom is a developed country and has the world's **fifth-largest** economy by nominal GDP and **ninth-largest** economy by purchasing power parity.

Influence

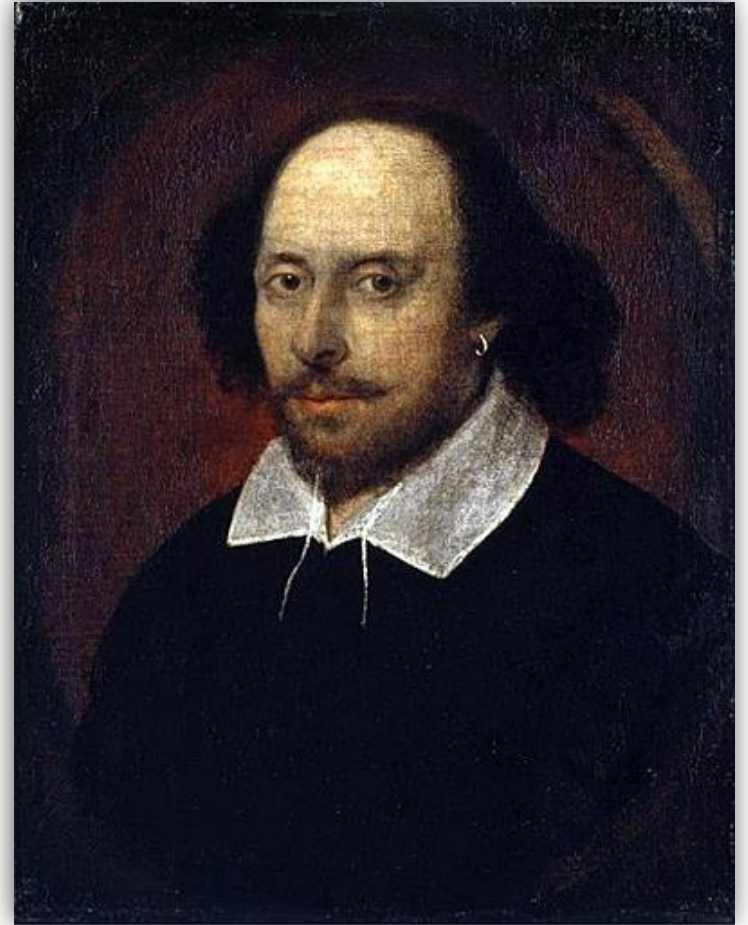
