



Polar bears need sea ice to hunt, rest and travel. But the ice in the Arctic is melting because of global warming. Scientists believe that some time between 2059 and 2078 there will be no sea ice in summer in the Arctic Sea. The polar bear's habitat will become smaller and smaller. We use will/won't to make predictions based on our opinions, feelings or experiences:

I think people will travel in time.

The future form of can/can't is will/won't be able to: Sixteen-year-olds will be able to vote in elections. Cars won't be able to fly.

We use will + get/become + comparative adjective to say that a situation is going to change:

Rail travel will become more popular.

Things won't get better.

REMEMBER THIS

The future form of can is will be able to. The negative form is won't be able to.

Female bears won't be able to feed their young.
