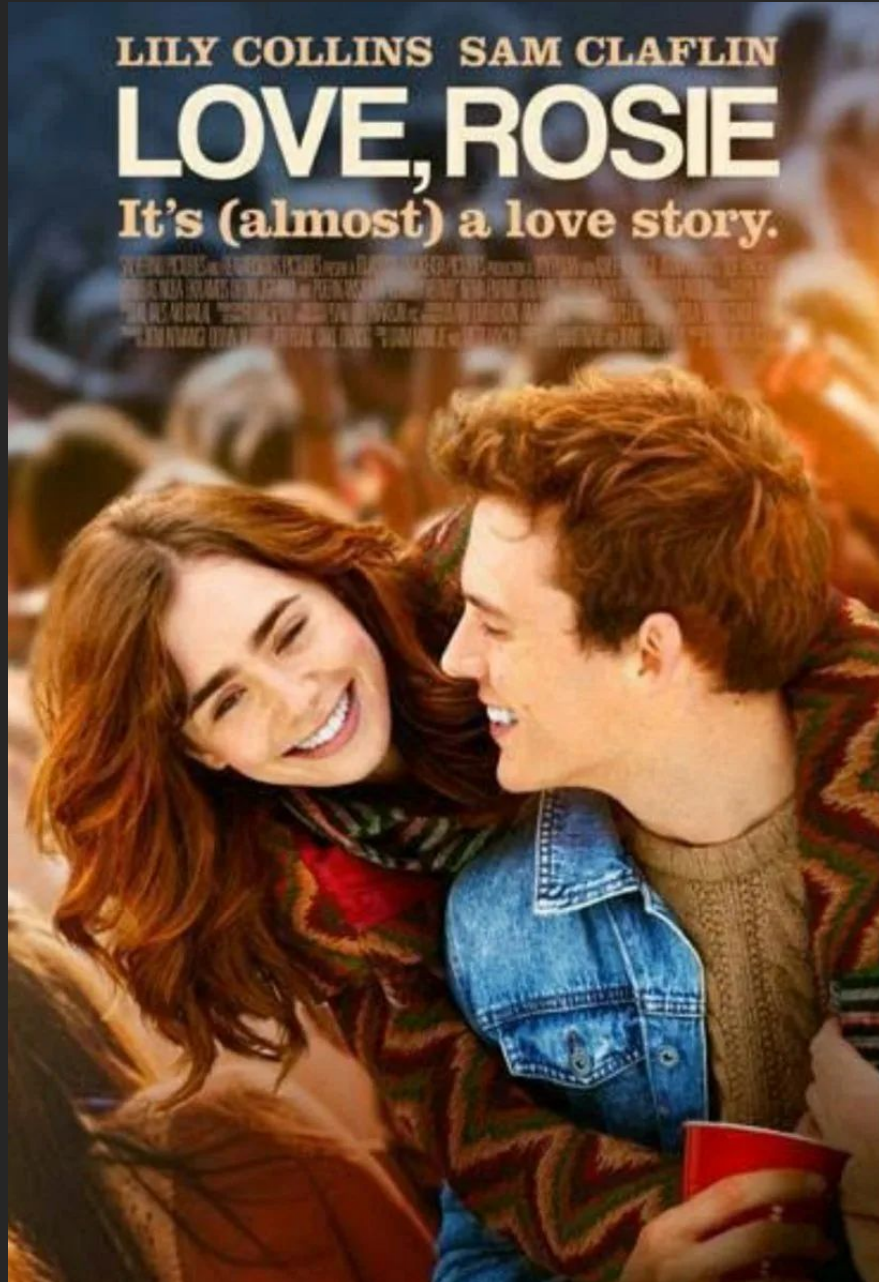


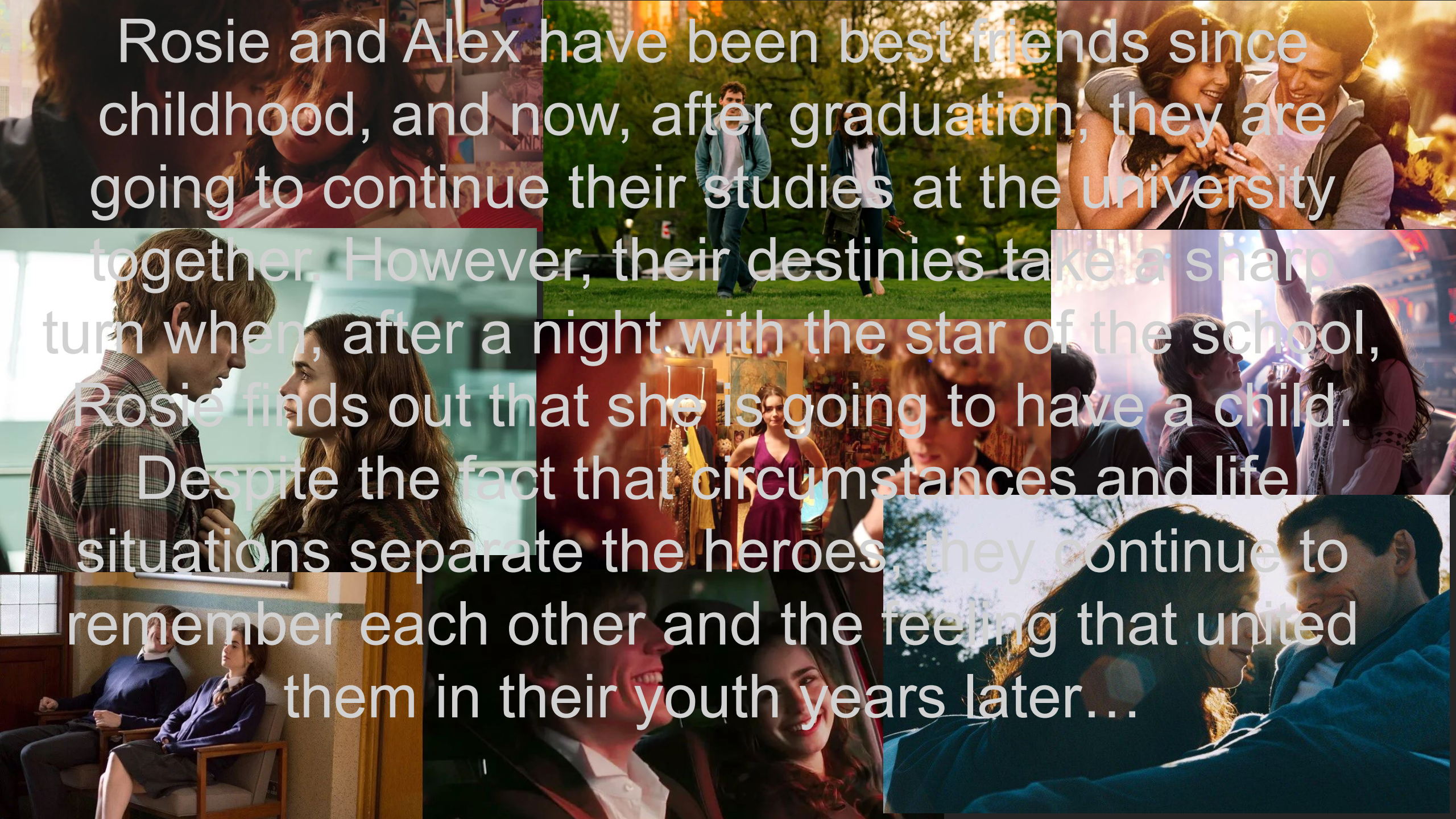

My favorite movies starring Sam Claflin are "Love, Rosie" and "Me Before You "

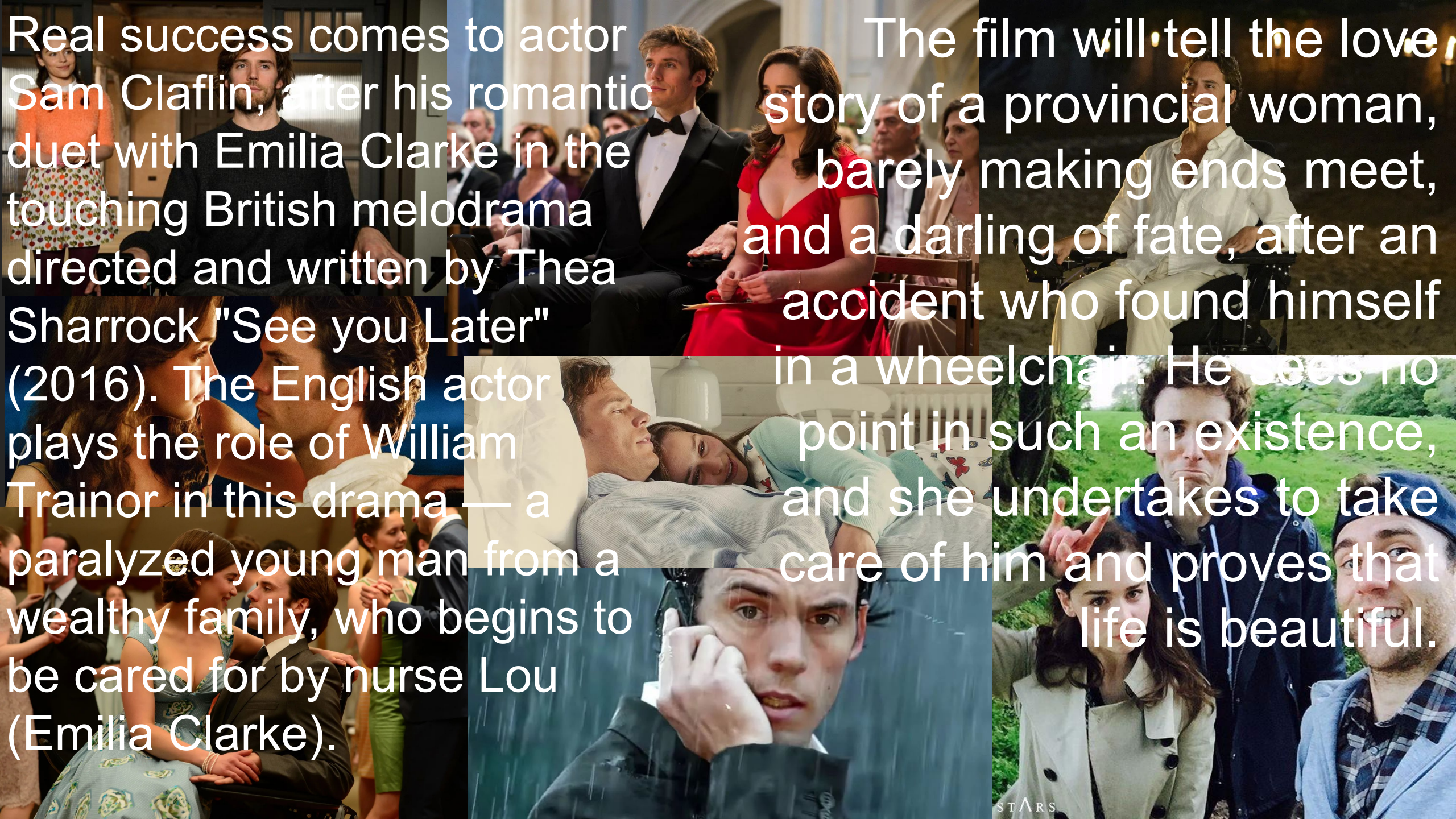
