This artifact is glowing. Has it been taken (*it, take*) to Earth by an alien race?

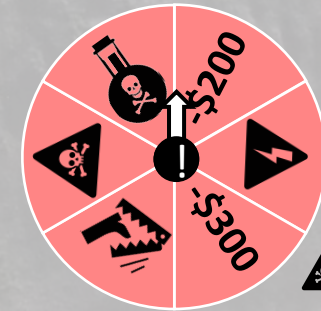
When was this musical instrument invented (*musical instrument, invent*)?

First this vase was cleaned (*clean*), then it was sent (*send*) to us.

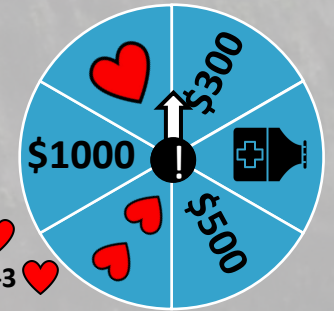
How long ago were symbols decrypted (*symbols, decrypt*) on this Aztec plate?
