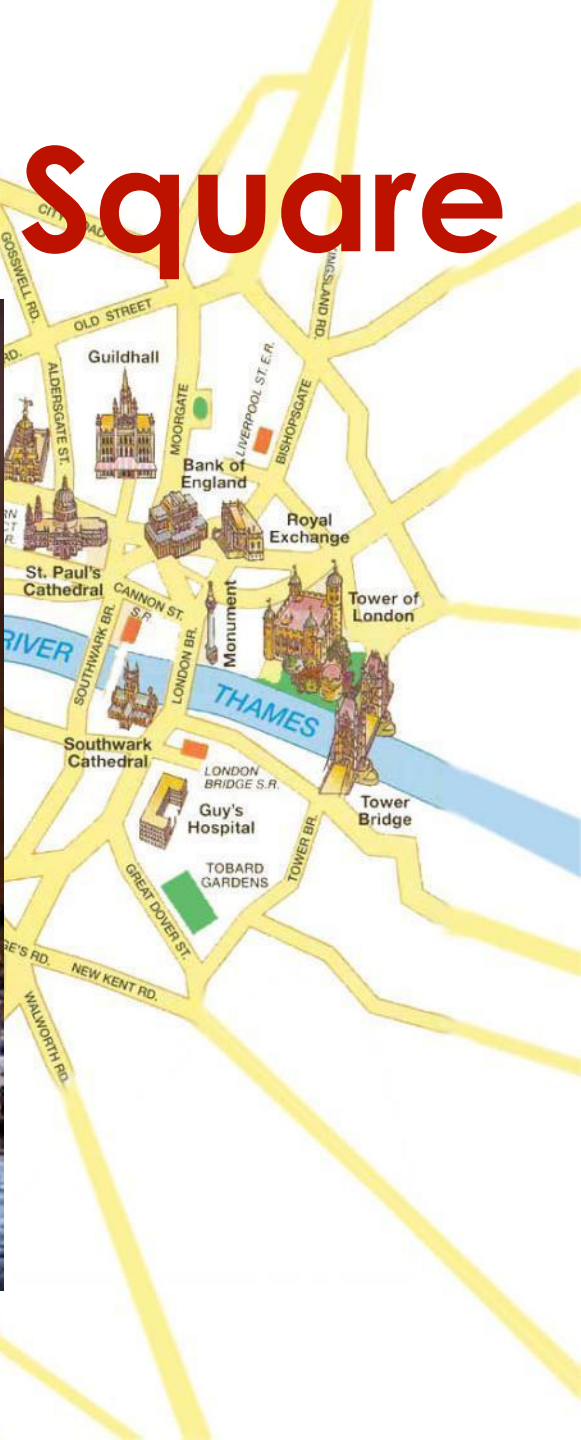
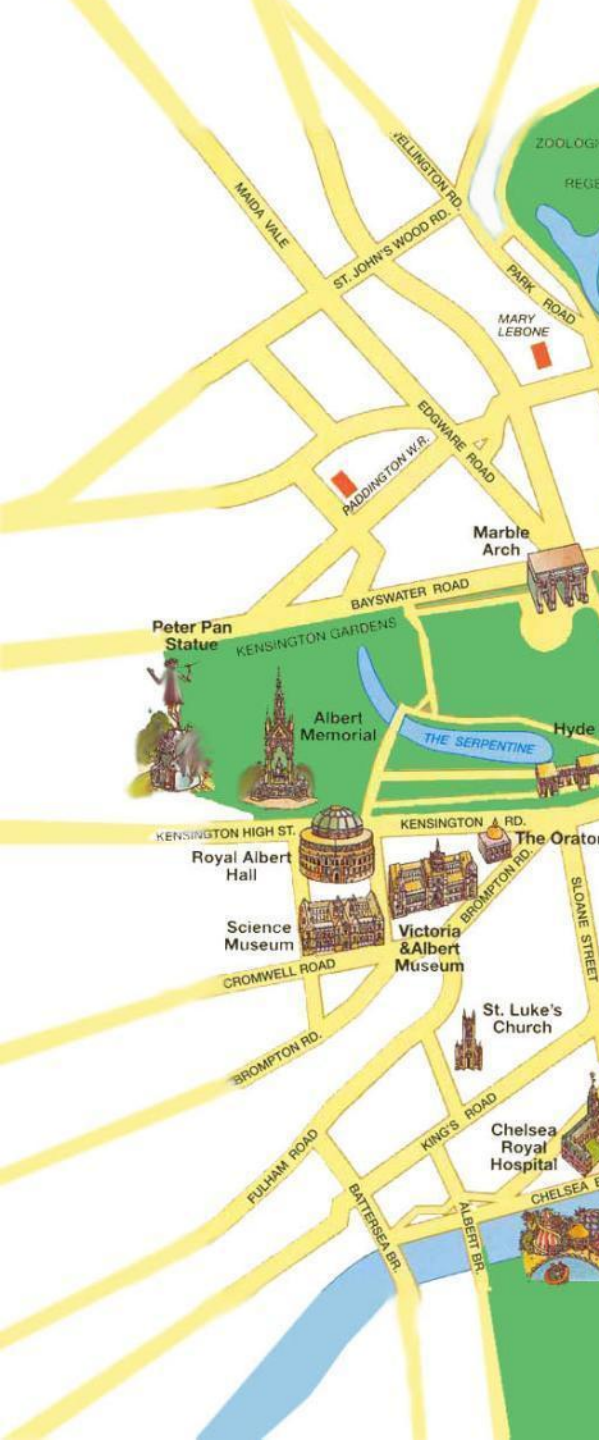
Westminster Palace and Big Ben
