

#### Introduction

The territory of Korea is 220.8 thousand km2. The total population of both Korean states exceeds 70 million people, 98% of the population are Koreans.





Korea is usually called a beautiful, prosperous country located on the eastern edge of Asia, in the southern part of the Korean peninsula. It is washed by the waters of the Yellow Sea, in the east by the Sea of Japan. It occupies a number of coastal islands. The total length of the coastline is 2,413 km. The capital is Seoul.

### Climate



Average January temperatures are 0-4 °C. Absolute minimum temperatures reach -15 in most of the country..-25 °C and decrease to -5..-15 °C in the subtropics. Average August temperatures from +24 °C.





## Getting around





Public transport in Korea is well developed. There are 8 international and 6 domestic airports. There are regular buses. As a rule, they work at intervals from 15 minutes to 1 hour. The country has one of the largest merchant fleets in the world. The most popular method of transportation is undoubtedly the subway.
