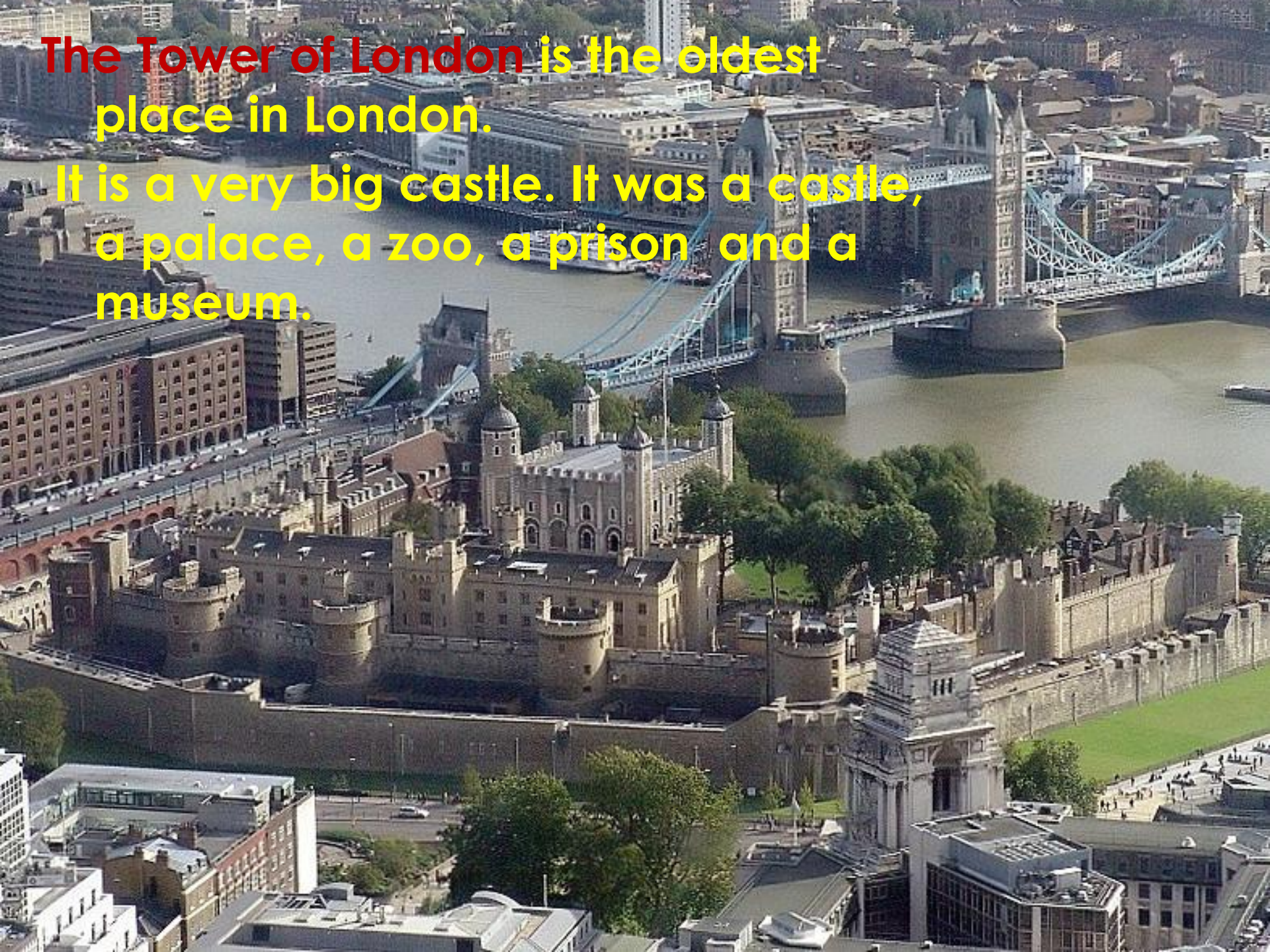
# Tower of London

The Ravenmaster feeds the ravens in the tower.

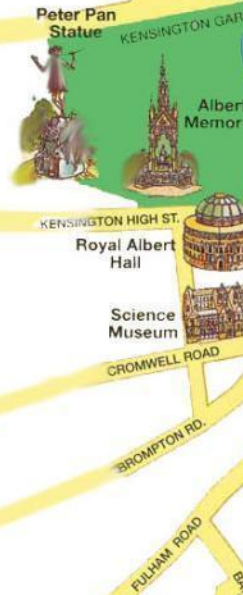
It is believed that if the ravens leave the Tower, the monarchy will fall.
