- ◉ Serbian nationalist named Gavrilo Princip shot him and his wife while they were driving through Sarajevo.



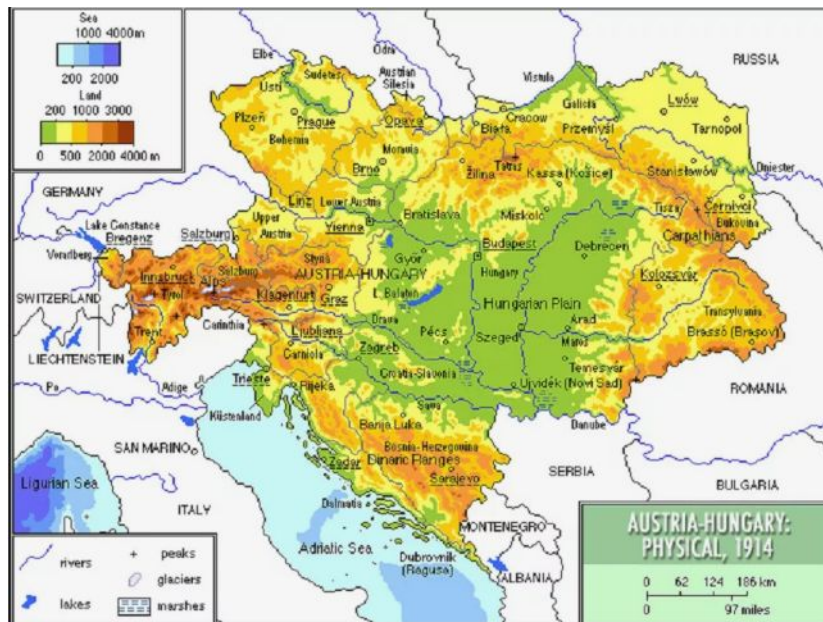
IMPERIALISM

- Increases their power and wealth

- An increase in confrontation



NATIONALISM

- The desire of the Slavic peoples be part of Austria-Hungary.
- Nationalistic and ethnic revolt led directly to the assassination of Ferdinand



THE INFLUENCES OF THE WAR ON UK.

- It became known as the Great War because it affected people all over the world (and Great Britain, of course) and was the biggest war anyone had ever known.
- It even came to be known as 'the war to end all wars', as no conflict before World War I had caused destruction on this scale before. People wanted to believe that nobody would ever want to go to war again after it.
