- ◉ In June 1914, a Serbian-nationalist terrorist group called the Black Hand sent groups to assassinate him.
- ◉ Serbian nationalist named Gavrilo Princip shot him and his wife while they were driving through Sarajevo.



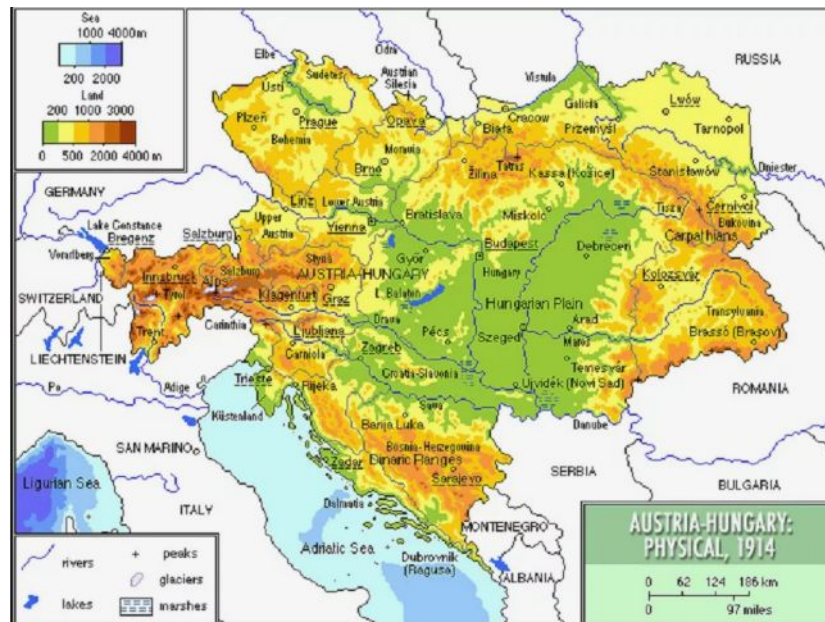
# IMPERIALISM

- The desire of the Slavic peoples be part of Austria-Hungary.
- Nationalistic and ethnic revolt led directly to the assassination of Ferdinand

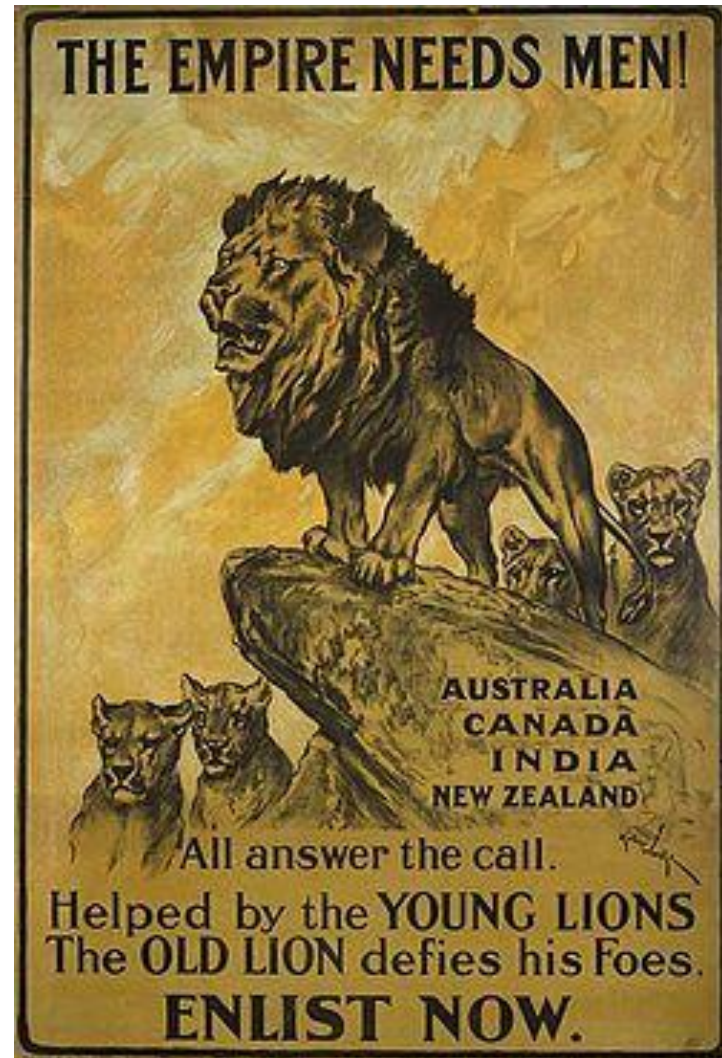


# THE INFLUENCES OF THE WAR ON UK.
