FASHION IN THE PAST

USED TO + infinitive

things that happened in the past (actions/states) that no longer happen now.



Present Equivalent

present simple + frequency adverb
(usually, always, often, never, etc.)

- (+) When I was at school, I **USED TO** wear a uniform.
- (-) When I was at school, I **DIDN'T USE TO** wear a uniform.
- (?) **DID** you **USE TO** wear a uniform when you were at school?

BE USED TO + V-ing / noun

Something you find normal, not unusual.

Maria is used to dealing with children. She has three younger brothers.

I'm not used to the weather here yet. I'm finding it very cold.

GET USED TO + V-ing / noun

You are becoming accustomed to it.

Something is in the process of becoming normal.

I'm getting used to eating the food in England
I'm getting used to the food in England.
