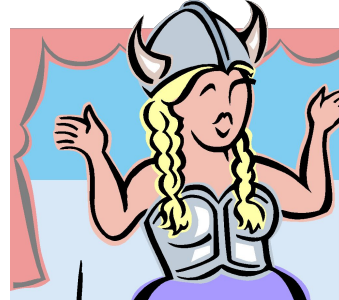
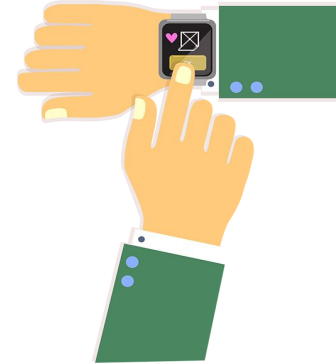

He **Can** play the guitar ?



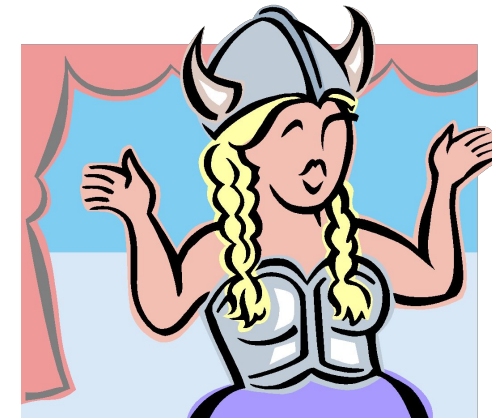
Yes, he **can**.

No, I **can't**.



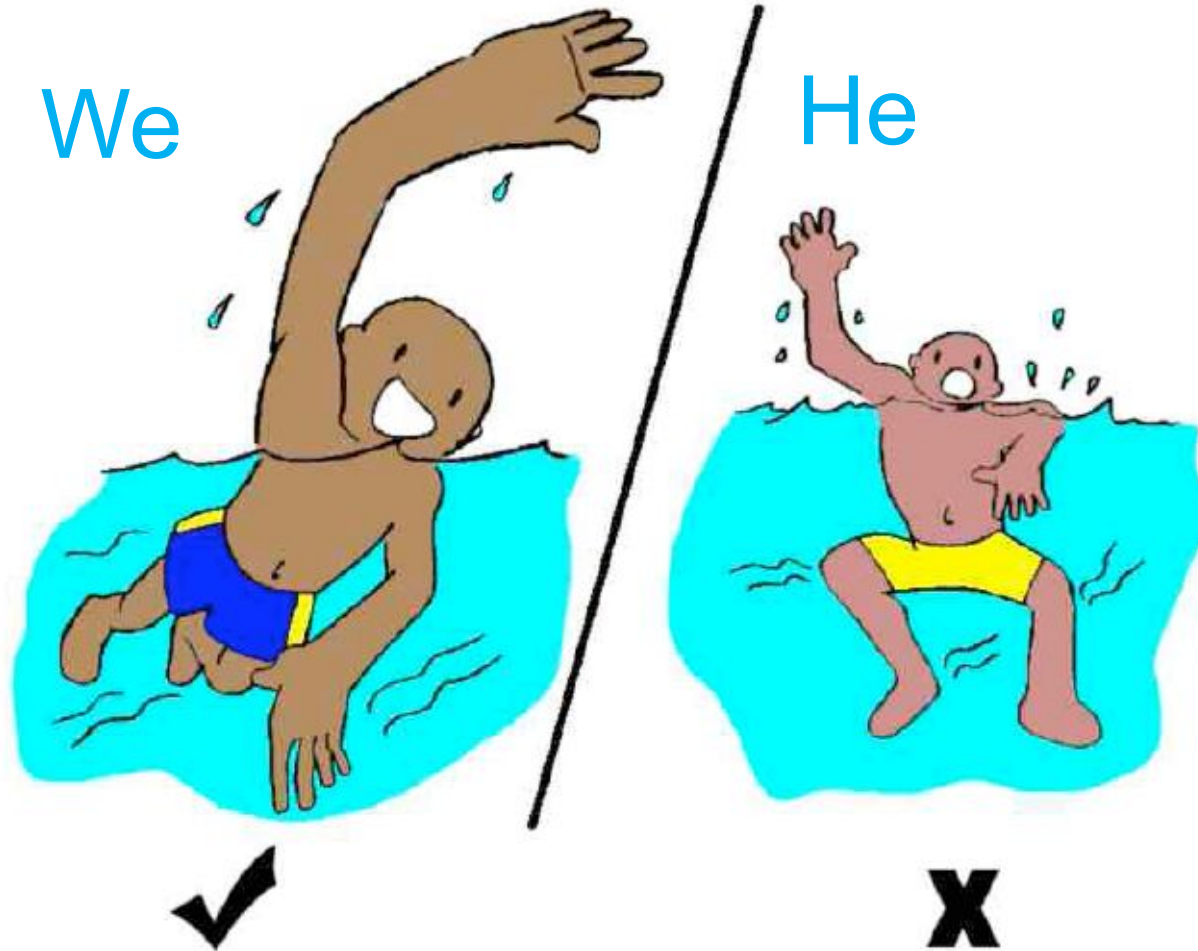

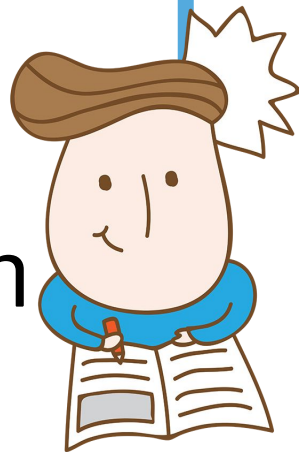
can for present possibility

He **Could** play the guitar ?



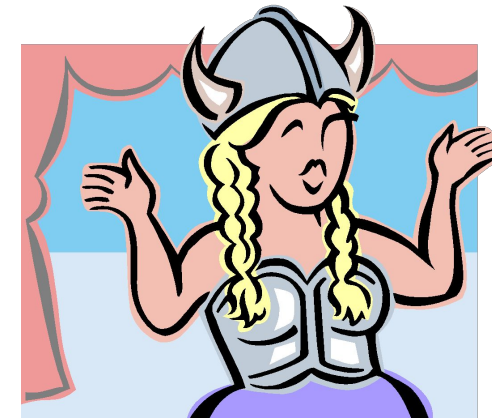
Yes, he **could**.

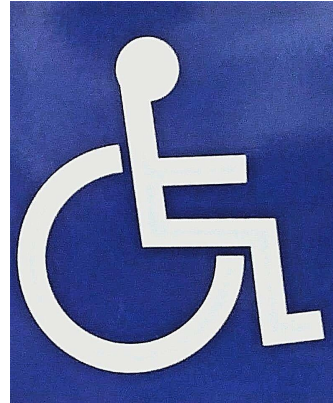
