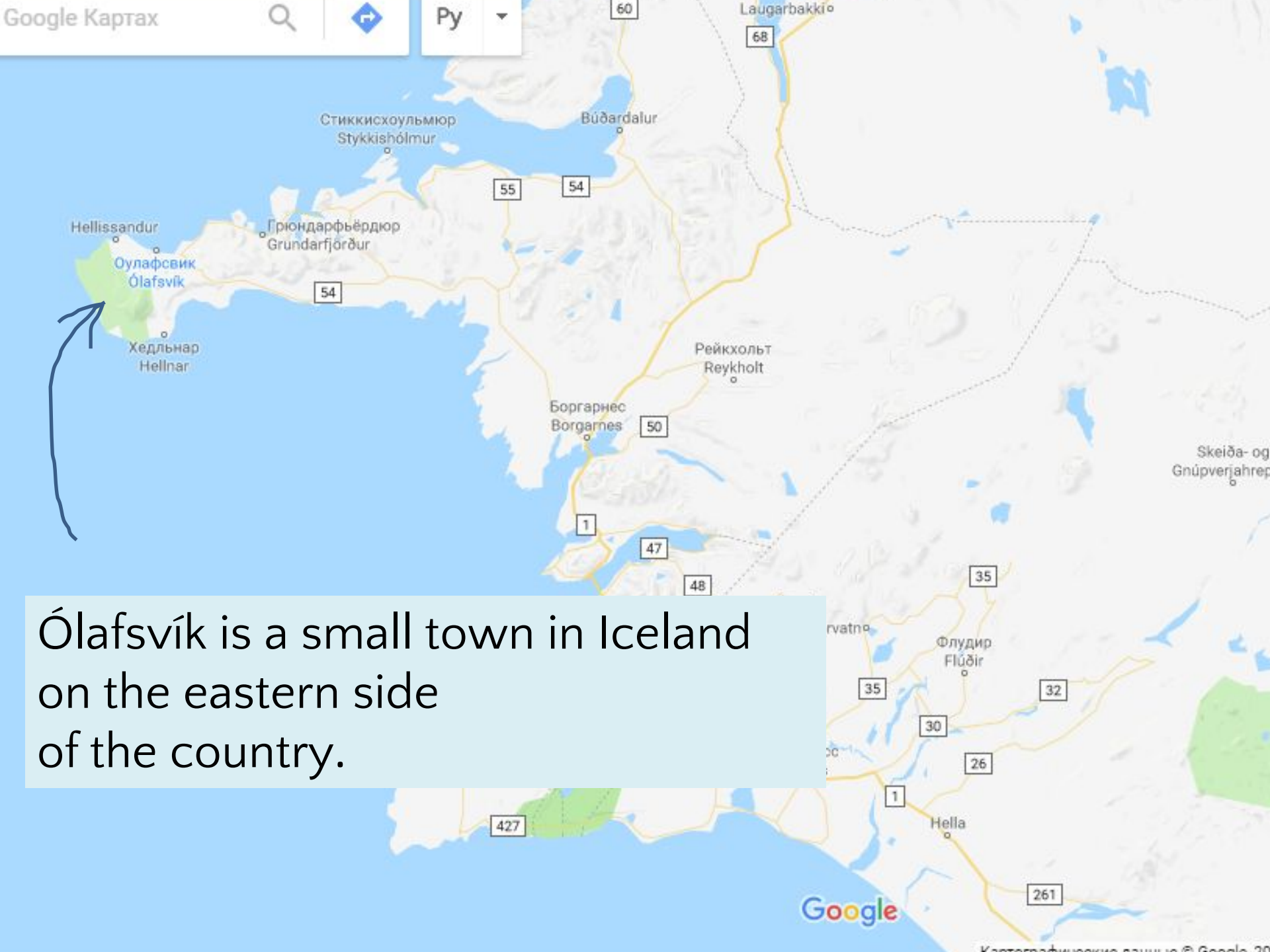


Ólafsvík
