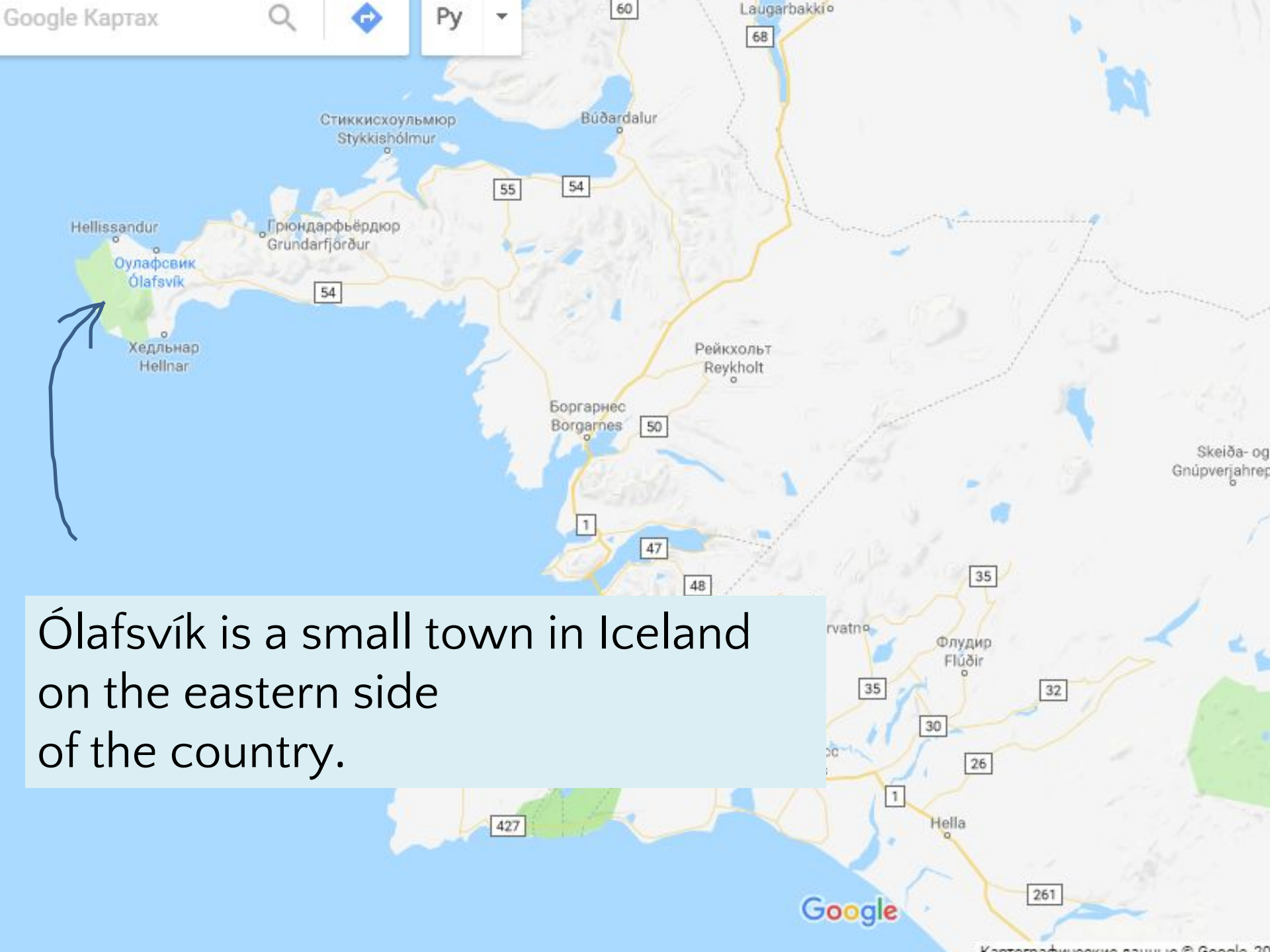


Ólafsvík
