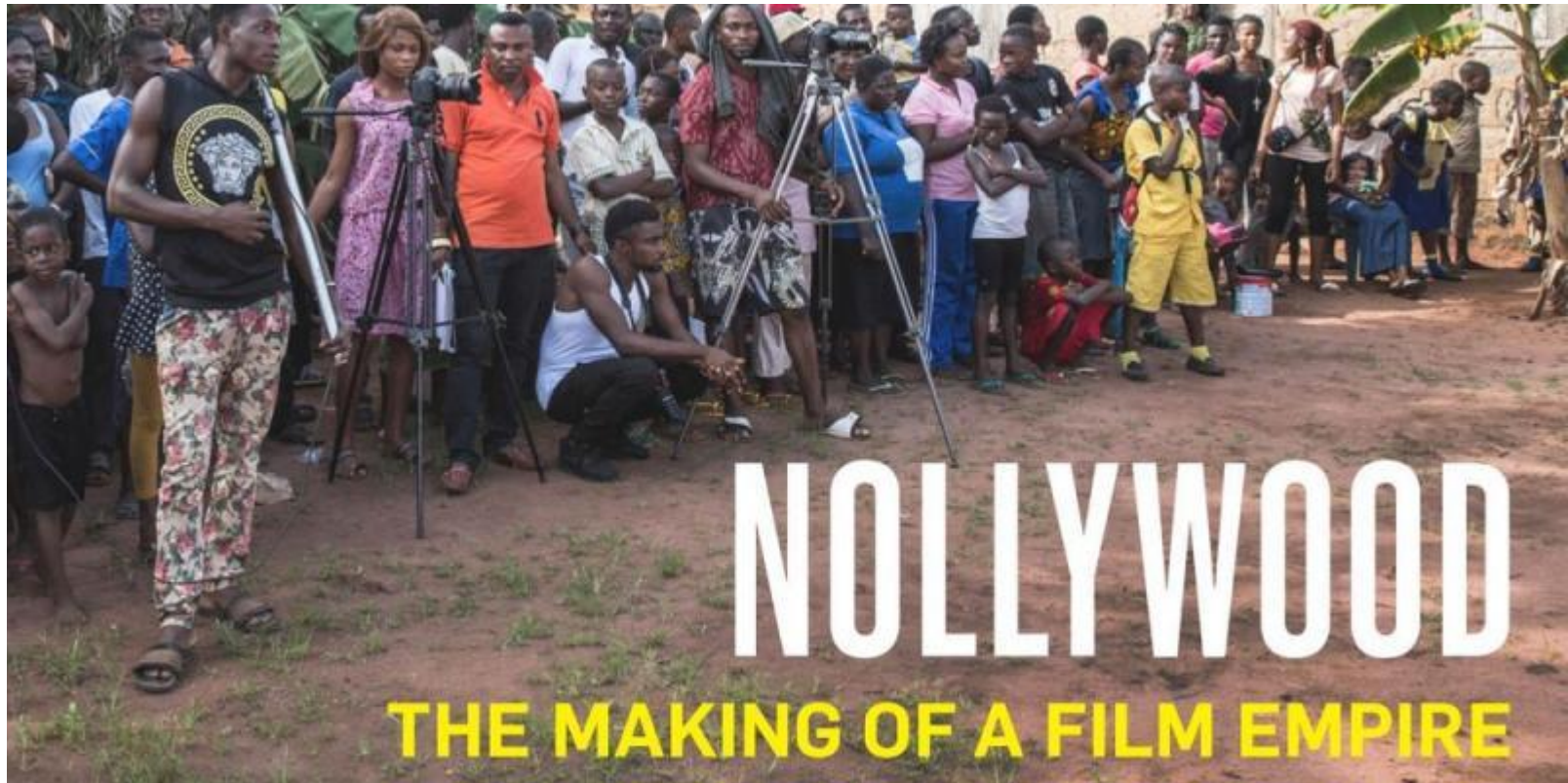

- Nigeria's cinema began to flourish in the 1990s and 2000s, eventually becoming the second-largest film industry in the world in the number of annual premieres, beating the United States of America and second only to the Indian film industry



- Nigeria earns \$ 250 million in film production by producing around 200 videos per month



- Now Nollywood is an industry that provides jobs for more than a million Nigerians. The country's population is over 173 million people



- The main themes of the films: AIDS, corruption, women's rights, the occult, bloodthirsty police and prostitution.
