Я учу английский 5 лет.

**= я начала учить его 5
лет**

назад и до сих пор

продолжаю.

**I have been studying English
for 7 years.**

Показатели времени PPS

- For (на протяжении)
- Since (с какого-то времени)
- How long (в вопросах = как долго)
- All day (весь день)
- Quite a while (довольно долго)

PRESENT PERFECT

Действие закончилось! Нужен результат! Сколько длилось действие – не важно!

She has bought a car.

PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS

Действие либо закончилось, либо еще длится, но нам важен процесс, как и сколько по времени это действие длилось (6 лет, неделю, месяц...). Поэтому, эту длительность мы передаем формой глагола с окончанием –ing.

I have been waiting for you for 5 hours. (Я жду тебя уже 5 часов).
