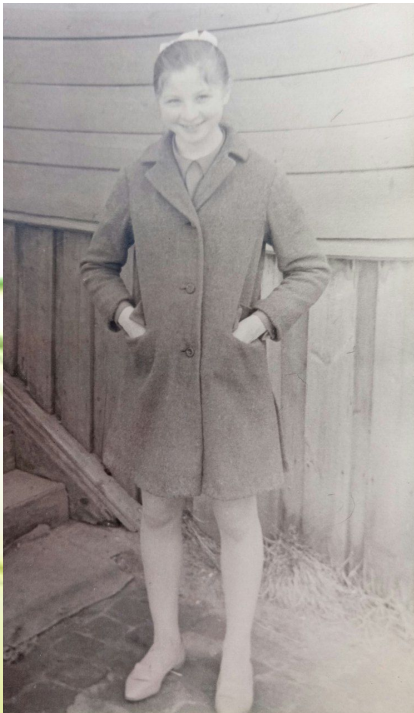




# MY GRANNY

At school granny was a very creative and active pupil.

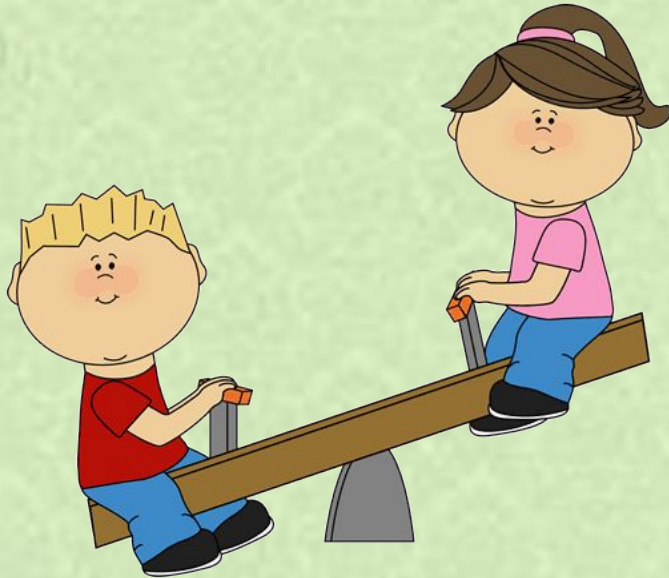


She took part in sports competitions, enjoyed painting and was a member of a music group.
