# PRESENT SIMPLE



- ▣ это настоящее простое время
- ▣ используется, когда действие повторяется регулярно, постоянно, всегда, каждый день/каждую неделю/каждый месяц, часто, обычно
- ▣ в 3 лице единственного числа к глаголу добавляется окончание **-s** или **-es**
- ▣ Вспомогательные глаголы - **do/ does**
