- Late in doing sth
- To be behindhand with
- I worked late last night because I was behindhand with my accounts

## Behindhand

- Coming later than expected
- A belated apology
- Belated birthday greetings!
- To make a belated attempt to do sth

Belatedly

#### belated

- Until the last moment that it is possible to do sth
- I think the election will **go** right down to the wire (= be won at the last moment).
- As with the rest of my life, it all came down to the wire.

## Down to the wire

• If you say it's getting on, or time is getting on, you mean it is becoming late (informal)

• It's getting on - we'd better be going.

## Be getting on

.

#### • someone who becomes good at something after people usually become good at it:

• At <u>school</u> she was a late developer, and it wasn't until she went to university that her talents became apparent.

# Late developer

- someone who starts using a new product, especially a new piece of <u>technology</u>, later than many other people
- For a long <u>time</u> I didn't have a smart phone, being a late adopter.

## Late adopter

- Too late to be useful
- It's too late in the day to start studying your final exams are next week.

# Late in the day

- Not done when expected
- She feels she's overdue for promotion

#### Overdue

- To close the stable
- To close barn door after the horse has bolted
- To be so late in taking actions to prevent sth

## To shut the stable

#### used to say that something happened when it was almost too late:

• Help <u>arrived</u> - and not a moment too <u>soon</u>.

#### Not a moment too soon

- Slow or late in happening
- Rather tardy arrival
- tardiness

#### Tardy

- NFORMAL
- An unearthly time is not at all convenient because it is too early in the morning or too late at night:
- UNCIVILIZED HOUR
- a very early or very late time in the day:
- Sorry to <u>call</u> you at such an uncivilized <u>hour</u>.

#### Unearthly

Very late (disapproving)

## Until all hours

- The latest possible opportunity to do sth
- At the last minute, we found our tickets.
- A last-minute cancellation
- A last -minute reprieve
- The last-minute rush
