

### This church <u>was</u> built in 1995. (unimportant agent)



1. When the agent (=the person who does the action) is unknown, unimportant or obvious from the context.

### The car <u>hasn't been</u> <u>cleaned</u>. (more polite)

2. To make more **polite** or **formal** statements.

### You haven't cleaned the car. (less polite)



### 30 people <u>were killed</u> in the earthquake.

3. When the action is more important than the agent, as in processes, instructions, events, reports, headlines, news items, and advertisements.




Bread <u>is baked</u> in an oven for 45 minutes. (process)





### to have + been+ $V_3$

A bomb has been discovered in an old lady's garden.
