HAVE GOT**AFFIRMATIVE****I have got****You have got****He has got****She has got****It has got****We have got****You have got****They have got****NEGATIVE****I haven't got****You haven't got****He hasn't got****She hasn't got****It hasn't got****We haven't got****You haven't got****They haven't got**

HAVE GOT NEGATIVE

I haven't got
a saxophone.



HAVE GOT

AFFIRMATIVE

They **haven't got** a
saxophone.



HAVE GOT INTERROGATIVE

Have you got
a skateboard?

No, I
haven't.
