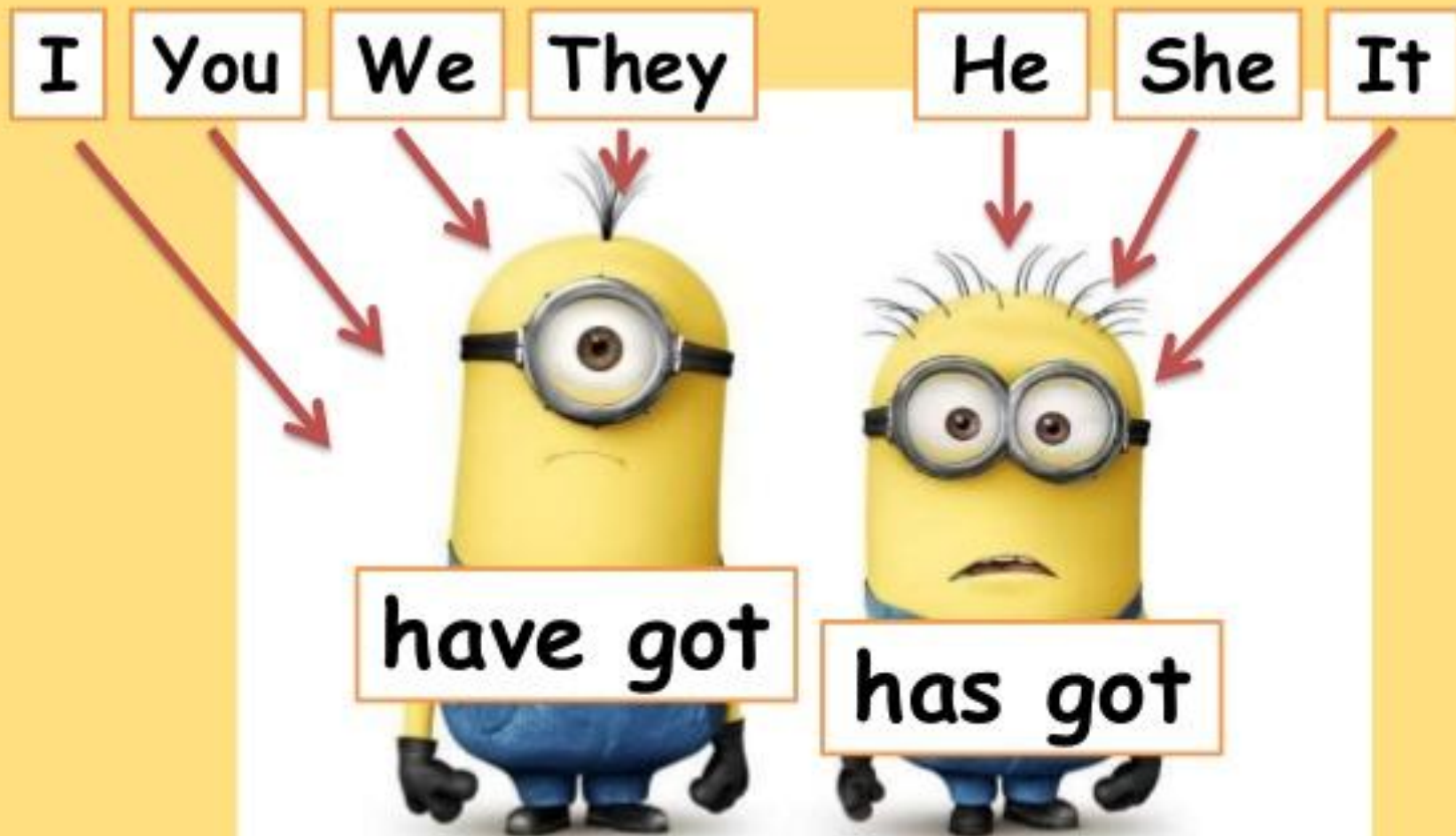

AFFIRMATIVE



He **has got** a
skateboard.

VERB

HAVE GOT

AFFIRMATIVE

I have got

You have got

He has got

She has got

It has got

We have got

You have got

They have got



NEGATIVE

I haven't got

You haven't got

He hasn't got

She hasn't got

It hasn't got

We haven't got

You haven't got

They haven't got

HAVE GOT NEGATIVE

I haven't got
a saxophone.



HAVE GOT

AFFIRMATIVE

They **haven't got** a saxophone.



HAVE GOT INTERROGATIVE

Have you got
a skateboard?

No, I
haven't.
