Moscow *is the capital of Russia.*



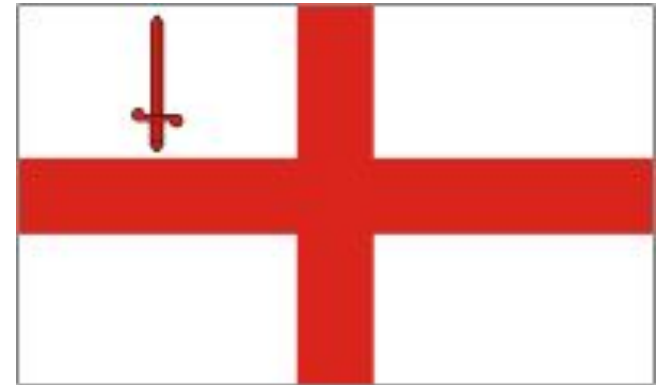
London *is the capital of England and the United Kingdom.*

The first Kremlin wall was built in 1156.



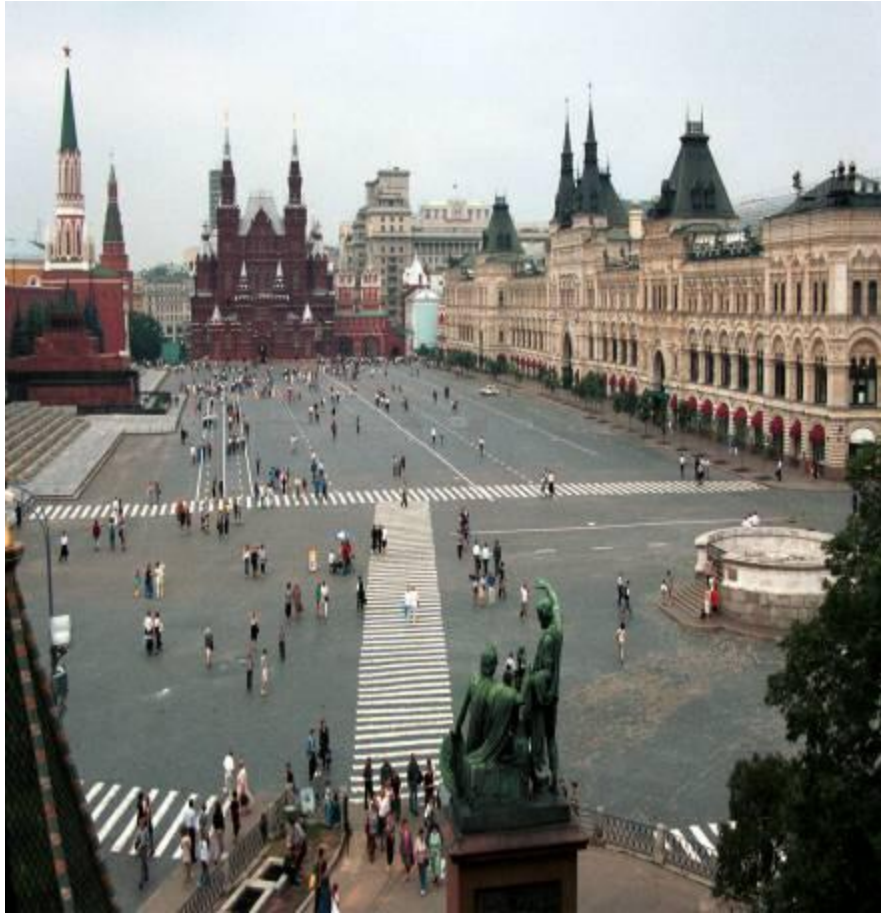
The Tower of London was built by William the Conqueror in 1078.

The London Underground.

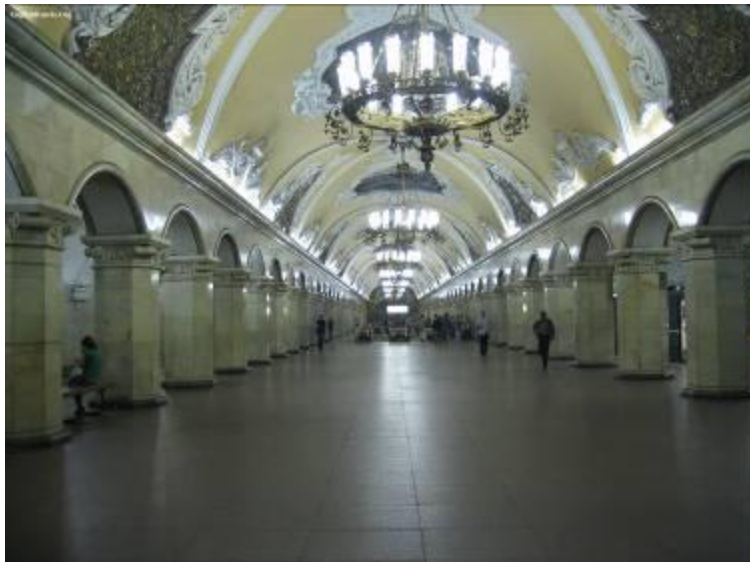
- It is the oldest and the longest in the world.

- There are 27 sq. meters of parks per person in Moscow.



- There are 7.5 sq. meters of parks per person in London.
