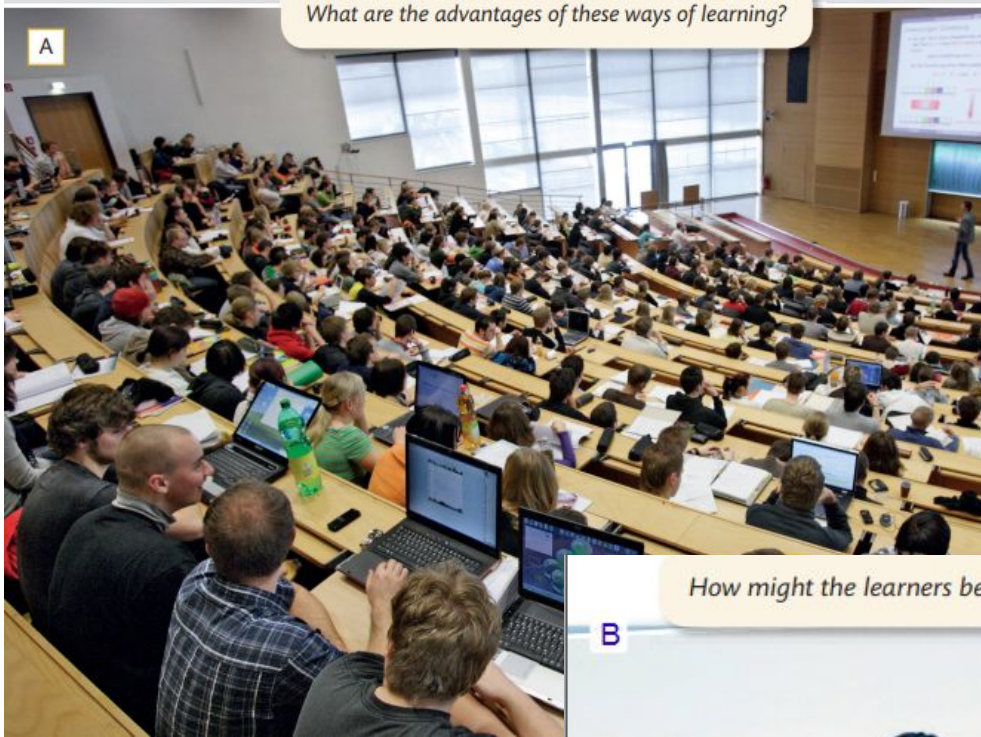

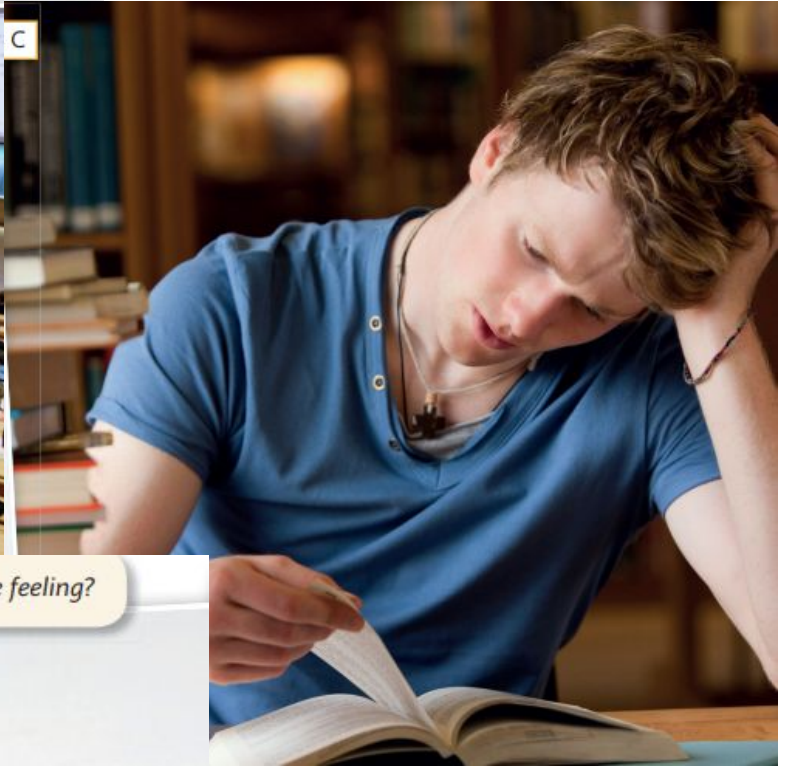
You have to make comparisons and speculate about the situations in the pictures
