# Learning Objective

The stapler weighs **4** marbles.

The pencil case weighs <u>6</u> marbles.

The stapler is **lighter** than the pencil case.





The shoe weighs  $\frac{1}{1}$  marbles.

The book weighs <u>15</u> marbles.

The book is heavier than the shoe.





The bottle weighs <u>12</u> marbles.

The mug weighs <u>12</u> marbles.

The mug is the same as the bottle.





The eraser weighs 2 marbles. The sharpener weighs 1 marble.

The eraser is **heavier** than the sharpener.





The paint tin weighs <u>15</u> marbles.

The tablet weighs <u>18</u> marbles.

The tablet is **heavier** than the paint tin.







The stapler weighs <u>11</u> marbles. The laptop weighs **16** marbles.

The lunch box weighs <u>14</u> marbles.

The stapler is the lightest

The laptop is the **heaviest**
