
The theme of the lesson: "A day's wait"

"Good health is above wealth"


The types of illnesses

- to be flushed by the fever










Conditional 3 = the 3rd conditional


a conditional sentence is composed of 2 parts:

If-clause

Main clause

Conditional 3 is used: to speak about unreal impossible past events





For example:

If I had had enough money, I would have bought the camera yesterday.

If they'd gone by bus, they would have arrived much later.

(They didn't go by bus)

He would have travelled around the world if he had had

more money.

(Impossible to change, because he didn't have the money)
