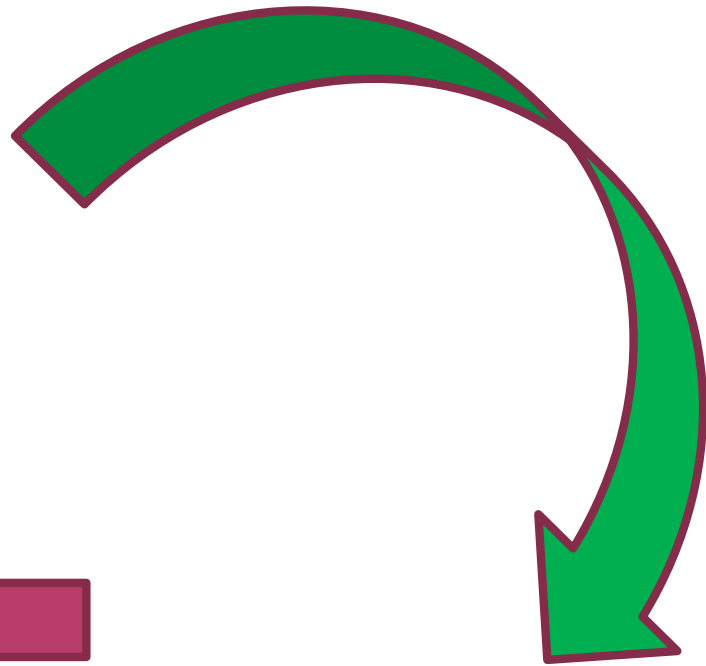


7.5 tonnes of

THE MAIN STAGES OF THE PRODUCTION:

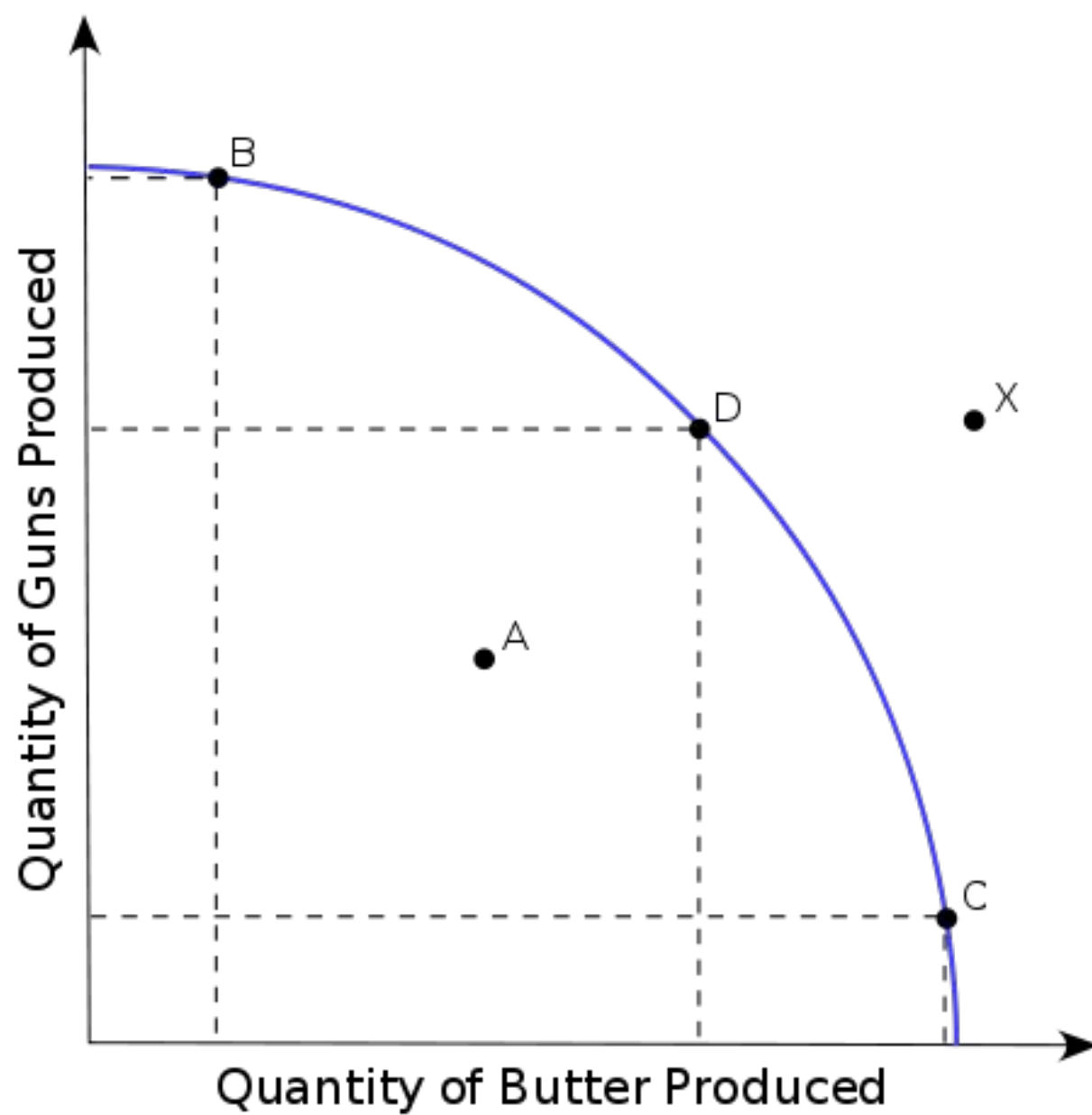
- receipt and storage of workpieces

- packaging and shipping.

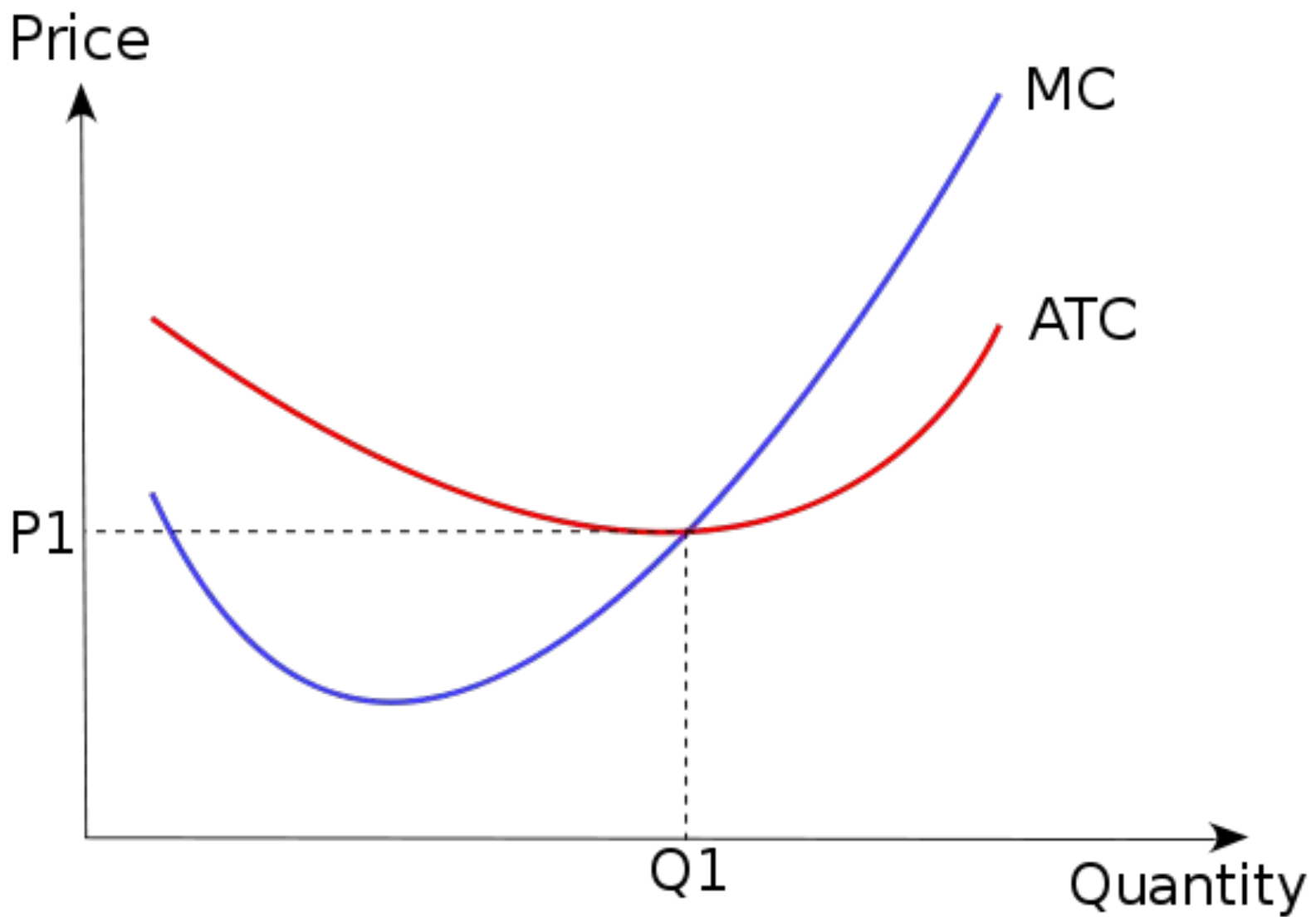
