(1,200 steaks)

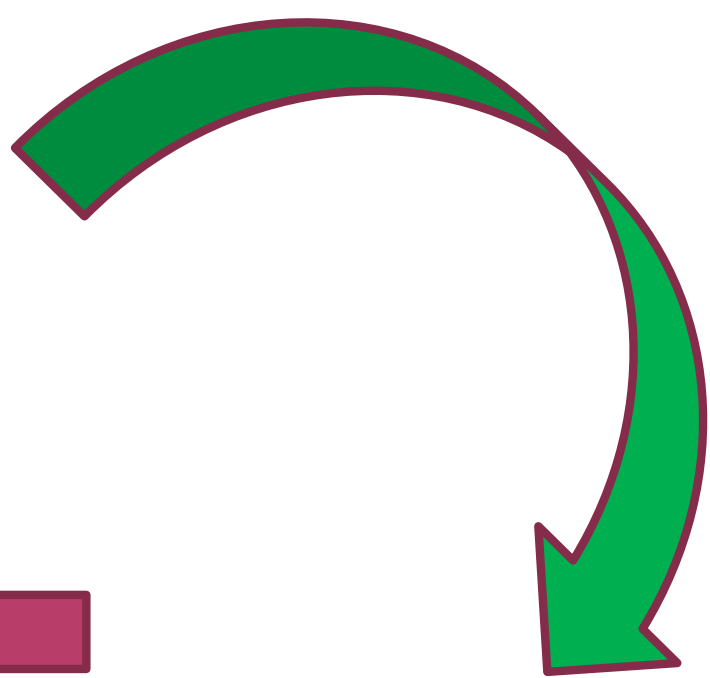

- packaging and shipping.

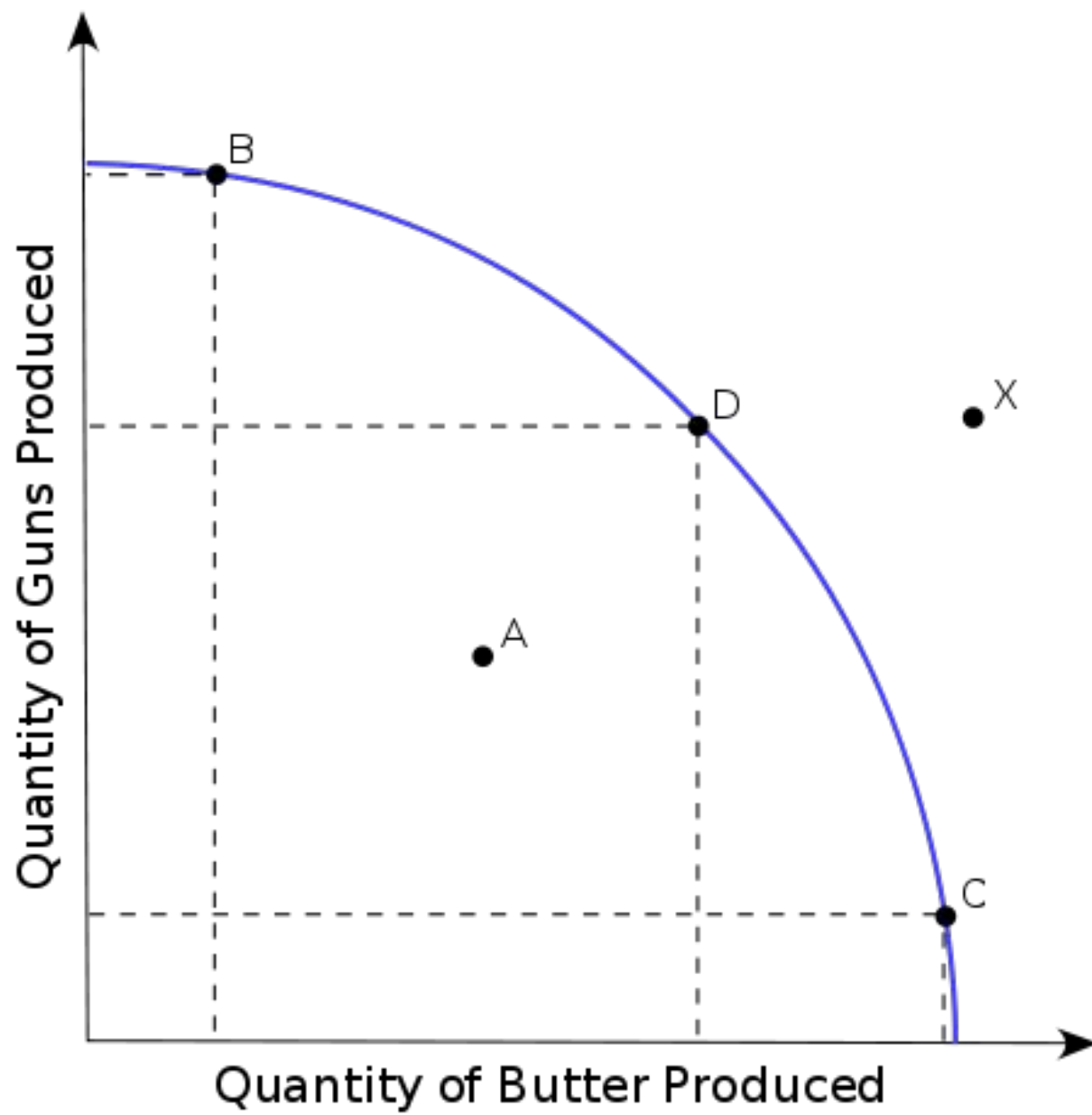


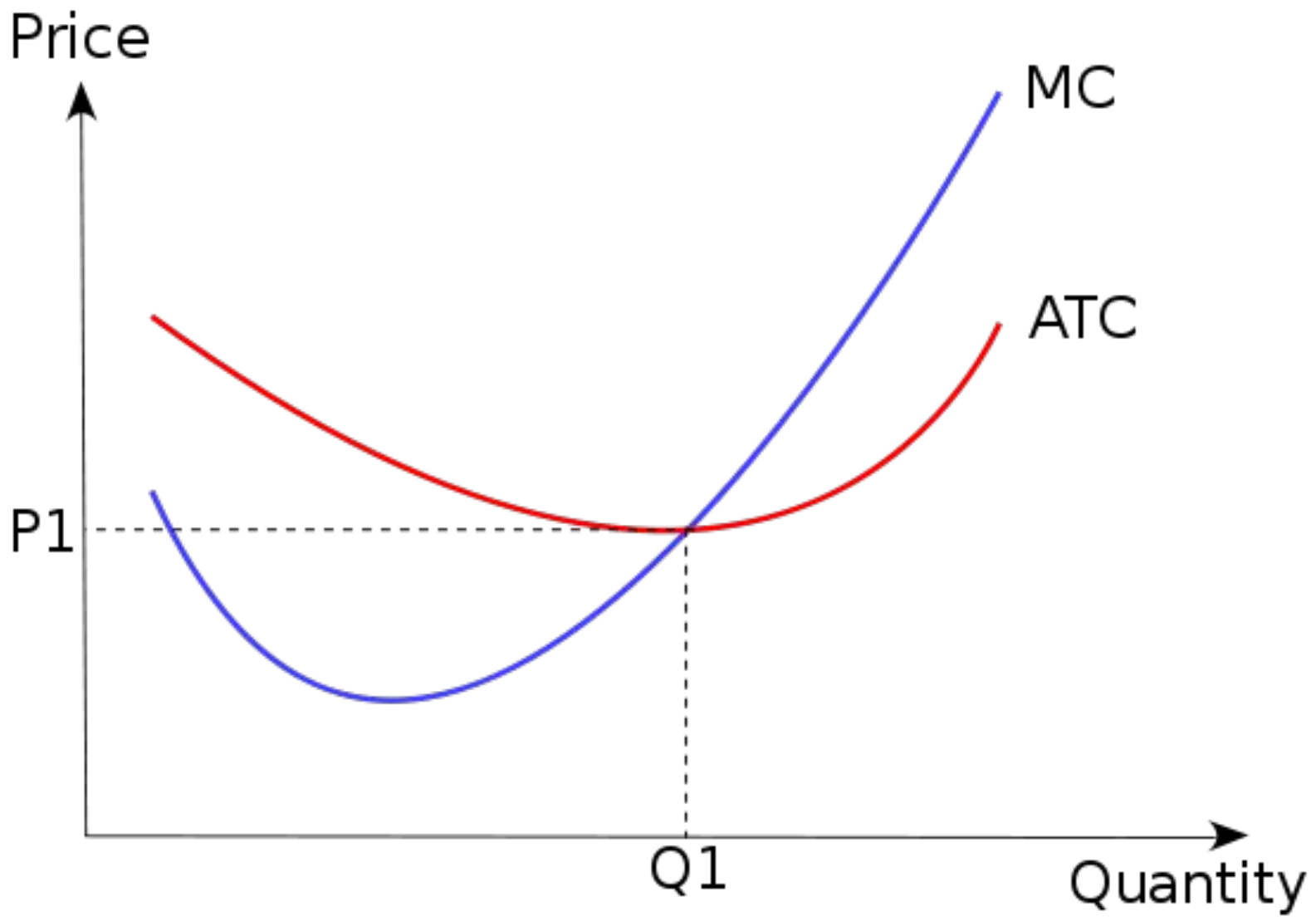
