




CHATAL-HUYUK— large ceramic age settlement of the Neolithic and Eneolithic in southern Anatolia (Turkey)

Unique ancient settlement of Chatal-Huyuk was opened в1962г. English archaeologist D. Mallorca. Scientists believe that Chatal-Huyuk existed in 6500-5400 BC





Brick wall height of four meters, surrounded the building. Houses were built of mud brick. The houses had no doors and Windows. The hosts enter the stairs through the roof, then through the "Chimney"



On the second floor was living room and kitchen. Through the narrow holes they have been on all fours in the bedroom. In the interior there were elevated areas, most likely beds, chairs, tables.

Dead people were buried on the ground floor. Often buried in wicker baskets with jewels, weapons, clothing, covering everything with a cloth.





In the city found 3 temples, which were between the houses. Inside the temple was a large room, where you can meet a lot of people, its walls were painted with rude ornaments and pictures, which you can guess goddesses, bulls, rams, archers.



Here stood one of the oldest cities on the planet.
