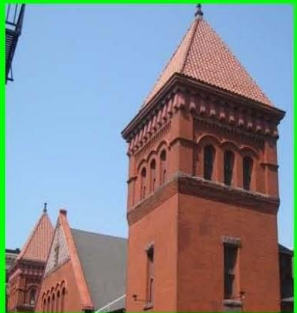

2. Accentuate the features of the European 1880's architecture

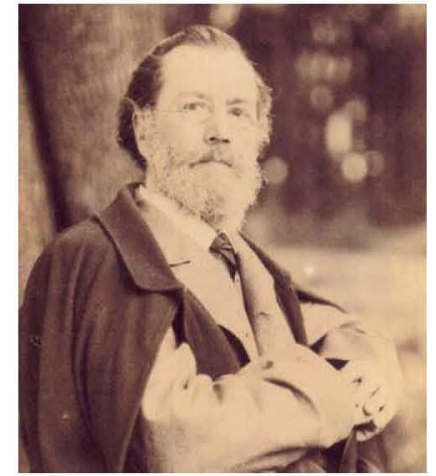

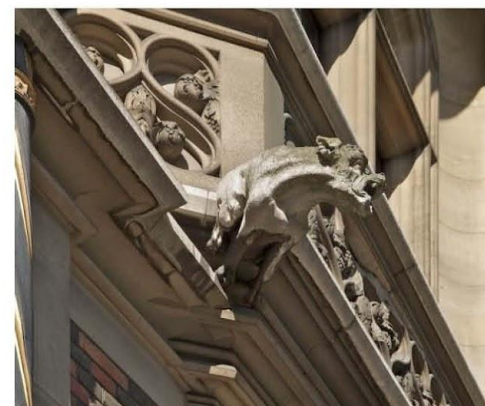

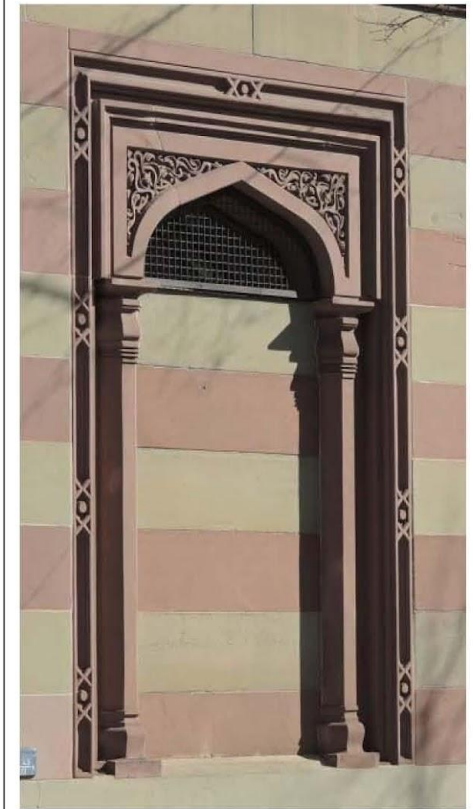

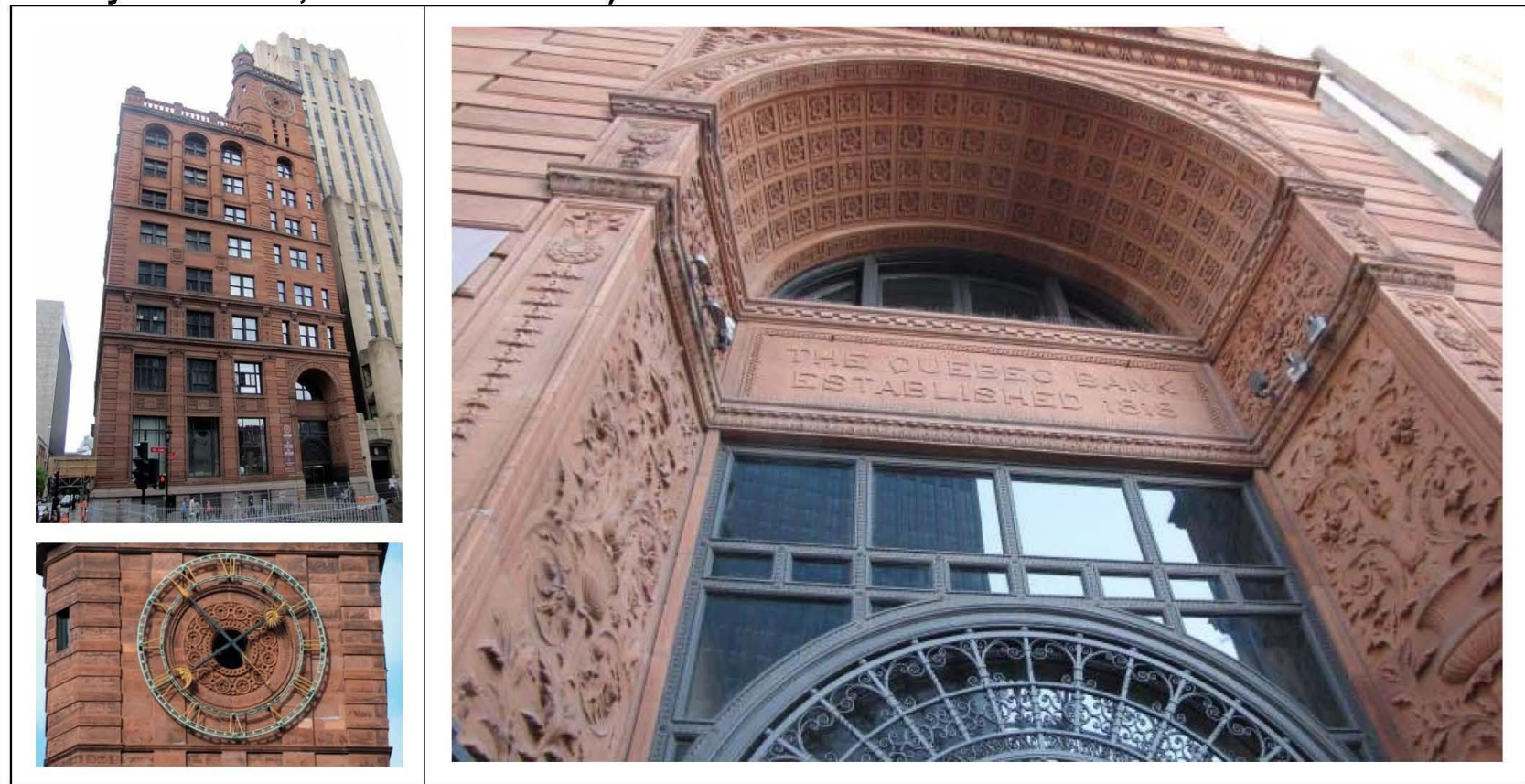

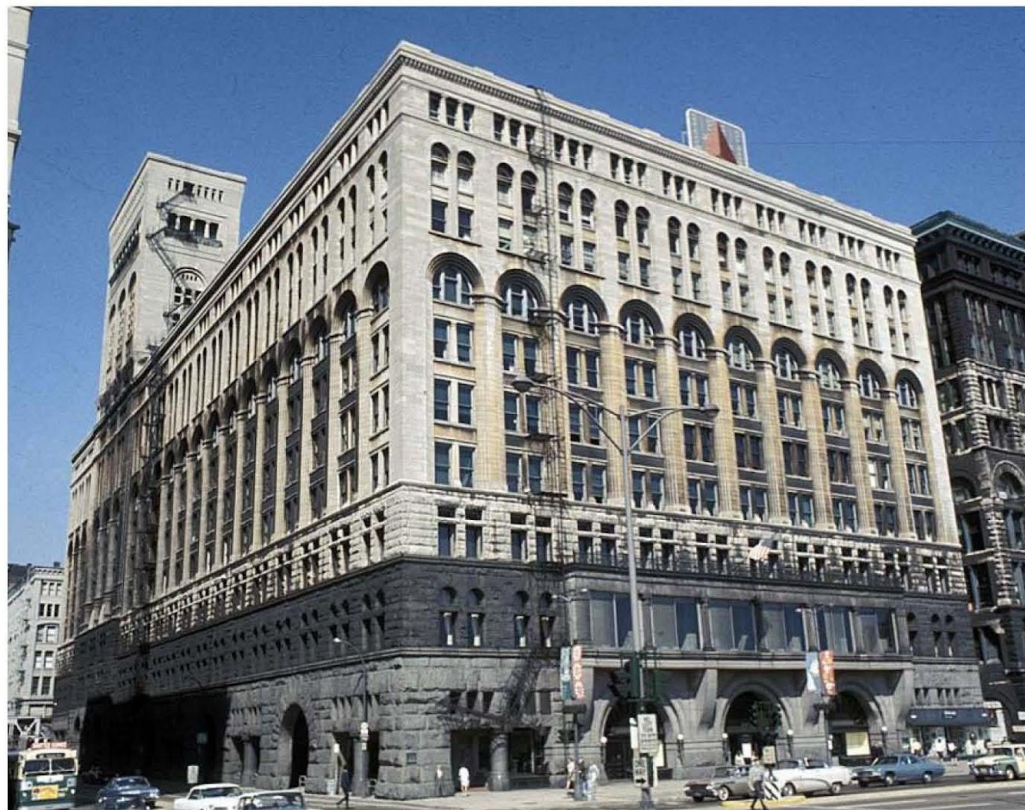
