- ▣ Cambridge has 31 colleges
- ▣ The colleges are self-governing institutions with their own endowments and property, founded as integral parts of the university
- ▣ Undergraduate teaching at Cambridge is organised around weekly small-group supervisions in the colleges
- ▣ Postgraduate teaching is provided predominantly centrally

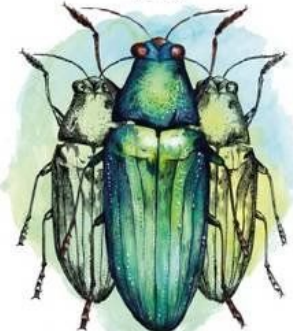
