


Between Mars and Jupiter

In Russia, astronauts are called *cosmonauts*.


Neil Armstrong (USA)

October 2003




Wang Yaping (China)

Mars Curiosity Rover


Jade Rabbit 2 – On the other side of the moon!


A footprint left on the moon. It is still there today because there is no wind on the moon.








Rosetta – A comet we landed on
